## MSC PROJECT MANAGEMENT

*Blended / 2 Years Part-Time*

This programme is directed at young graduates as well as professionals from all backgrounds who are seeking to reinforce their knowledge, skills and potential as highly effective project leaders with a grasp of project management concepts and techniques. The MSc programme has 8 core modules and 4 elective modules and a research project.

### Entry Requirements:

Either a first degree from an approved University or sufficient related work experience.

## MPHIL PROJECT MANAGEMENT

*2 Lecture-based Courses / 2 Research Seminars | Thesis*

This programme offers technical deepening and broadening knowledge beyond the level covered by the taught MSc degree in Project and Programme Management. It provides practical research skills into specific problems that arise in a wide range of industries and sectors in the economy.

Students can choose courses from the list of Core and Elective courses. Out of Department courses can also be chosen as electives.

### Entry Requirements:

Either a first degree with Second Class Honours in Project Management, Civil Engineering, Construction Engineering, and Management or an equivalent qualification in the field of Management Studies.

## PHD PROJECT MANAGEMENT

*3 Lecture-based Courses / 3 Research Seminars | PhD Thesis*

This programme offers students:

- Opportunities to gain first hand contact with the many challenges in project and programme management.
- Exposure to advanced theoretical and applied analysis in the field of project and programme management.
- The intellectual environment to conceptualise real challenges into a problem format, then apply rigorous analysis within the context of the project management discipline to be able to produce a theoretical formulation to problem solutions.
- An understanding of how to generate new and innovative solutions to real problems encountered by project management practitioners.

Students can choose courses from the list of Core and Elective courses. Out of Department courses can also be chosen as electives.

### Entry Requirements:

Either an MPhil Degree in Project Management or an MSc in Project Management with Distinction
