Duration of Study

Four (4) years. Full Time only.

General Requirements

Applicants for admission to this course of study will be required to satisfy the minimum standards for entry to the degree programme as set out by the University Regulations governing matriculation as well as the specific requirements of the Faculty.

Special Requirements

Open to applicants who fulfil the following requirements:

- 1. Passes at CSEC (CXC) in English, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics at General Proficiency level (Grades I II pre-1998 and Grades I-III from June 1998) **or** GCE O'level (BGCSE) **or** equivalent qualifications.
- 2. THREE 2-unit subjects at CAPE Units 1 & 2 at Grade II or better **or** GCE A'level **or** approved equivalent. Subjects must include both Physics and Chemistry.

OR

 An appropriate Associate Degree or equivalent certification with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or equivalent from a recognised tertiary level institution.

OR

• Any other appropriate combination of qualifications and experience acceptable to the Faculties of Science & Agriculture and Medical Sciences.

This programme was introduced in keeping with the World Health Organisation's strategic plan for <u>Vision 2020: THE RIGHT TO SIGHT</u>, a global initiative for the elimination of avoidable blindness.
