Master of Education (M.Ed.) Degree in Inclusive and Special Education

Two Years/ Part Time/ September 2012

APPLICATION DEADLINE: JULY 15, 2012

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for admission to the Master of Education (M.Ed.) degree in Inclusive and Special Education on a part-time basis in September 2012.

The programme targets in-service graduate teachers who have completed the Bachelor of Education (Special Education) and are desirous of enhancing their qualifications and skills. The programme also targets persons who are working in the field Special Education and/or graduates with bachelor's degrees in related areas such as primary education; secondary education; psychology; or speech and language.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

This part-time programme will be delivered over the course of two academic years (two semesters in each year). Students will be required to complete 42 credits in pursuing the following course components:

- Three compulsory core courses for M.Ed. programmes
- Four compulsory specialization courses
- One elective
- Research Seminars
- Research Project

The programme will be delivered in the blended mode- a mix of face-to-face and online sessions.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission, applicants

- (a) Must have obtained a bachelor's degree in Inclusive/Special Education from an approved university with at least a lower second class standing; **OR**
- (b) Must have obtained a bachelor's degree with at least a lower second class standing in a related area such as primary education or secondary education; psychology; speech and language **OR**
- (c) Must possess any other qualifications deemed equivalent to (a) or (b).

All applications must be made **ONLINE**. Applicants must ensure that ALL relevant information is included.
