Duration of Study Normally two (2) years of full-time study.

General Requirements

Candidates must satisfy the lower level matriculation requirements of the University of the West Indies (UWI) of five (5) GCE O' Level or CSEC subjects, including English Language and Mathematics, and have at least one science subject, which may include Agricultural Science (both the single and double awards count as one subject), Biology, Chemistry, Geography, Integrated Science, Environmental Science or Physics.

About the Programme

This diploma programme is designed to equip graduates with the necessary competencies, skill sets and knowledge to become modern-day farmers and agricultural entrepreneurs (e.g. Horticulturists, Aquaculturists, etc.).

Our graduates can go on to become specialists in agricultural technologies; start careers in the agriculture sector as entry level technical or support personnel; or become agricultural extension agents.

Graduates can also pursue degree level training in agricultural science and technologyoriented programmes or serve as teachers of agriculture at the primary school level.
