This tour offers an experience with the endangered Leatherback Turtles of Matura. Its focal point is learning how to tag turtles. Here you will have the great opportunity to participate in the turtle conservation efforts by tagging turtles yourself.

Howler Monkey Tour

Duration: 3.5hrs.

Group Tour Cost: \$448.00 TT (Maximum 15 Persons)

Time: 3hrs. (Starts 2:30am or 5:30pm)

This tour offers an experience viewing the red howler monkey as they feed and socialize in their family. The monkeys are most active in early morning and late afternoon. Therefore you will be almost certain to observe these animals while they are active, possibly feeding.

Matura Waterfall Tour

Duration: 4 1/2 hrs

The Matura River hike is tailored for individuals who have a great interest in hiking and who are looking for a challenge. On this 11/2 hour hike (one way), you will be rewarded with wonderful sights of rare species of plant and animal life. At the end of the hike you will bathe in the mountain waters of the beautiful Matura River.

Rio-Saco Waterfall Tour

Duration: 5 hrs

Group Tour Cost: \$1050.00 TT (Maximum 25 Persons) Price can be reduced for a smaller number of persons.

Highlights: Bath in the Rio Seco Waterfall – participants on this tour will enjoy a popular location for interaction or for solitary reflection. Whichever you chose, we can ensure that you will be satisfied and rejuvenated after this trip.

You will be accompanied by knowledgeable and friendly guides who will be able to identify and give information on the various types of flora and fauna that will be seen on the trail. The Nature Seeker guides are also certified in first aid training ensuring your safety.
