GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

The Sir Arthur Lewis Institute of Social and Economic Studies (SALISES), The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine, in partnership with the Canadian Fisheries, Oceans and Aquaculture Management (C-FOAM) at The University of Ottawa, Canada, is currently executing an International Community-University Research Alliance (ICURA) project entitled “Managing Adaptation to Environmental Change in Coastal Communities: Canada and the Caribbean.”

Applications are invited from persons applying for, or enrolled in, approved graduate programmes of the University of the West Indies for scholarships for up to one (1) year tenable at the University of the West Indies. The scholarship may be extended beyond the period of one year pending satisfactory performance.

Approved Graduate Programmes

Scholarships are available for graduate study in any of the following specialized areas, with special emphasis on coastal communities: Urban and Regional Planning*, Geoinformatics*, Coastal Zone Engineering and Management, Science and Management of Tropical Biodiversity, Environmental Engineering, Environmental Economics and any other related discipline.

Requirements

Applicants should be full time students and normally have completed all course work and be at the research stage of their programme. Applicants must be able to demonstrate strong research capabilities, analytical skills and initiative in sourcing relevant literature and in data acquisition and processing.

*GIS mapping skills would be an asset.

Letters of application, with accompanying CV, should be sent to the **Director, SALISES, The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine**, or by email to salises@sta.uwi.edu. CVs must provide full particulars of qualifications, experience and names and addresses of two (2) referees, at least one of whom must be an academic.
