CALL FOR PAPERS

Tout Moun: Caribbean Journal of Cultural Studies is a peer-reviewed, open-access, academic journal based within the Department of Literary, Cultural and Communication Studies at the University of the West Indies, St. Augustine. The aim of the journal is to foster and showcase cutting-edge research in Cultural Studies produced in and about the region.

The Cultural Studies Programme invites contributions to a special issue of the journal, entitled “Cultural Practice and Policy”. We welcome scholarly articles, review articles, shorter polemic essays and book reviews, as well as creative writing and contributions that explore alternative media. The scholarly and review articles should not exceed 8000 words (excluding bibliography). The recommended length of shorter essays is 3000-5000 words and book reviews, 1500-2500 words.

The contributors are encouraged to reflect critically on cultural theory as it is embedded within relevant frameworks of practice and policy, in and beyond the Caribbean region. Possible themes include, but are not limited to, cultural policy; multicultural policy; media and cultural policy; culture, place and space; and visual arts practice as research. Submissions will be particularly welcome from advanced postgraduate students and staff at the St. Augustine, Cave Hill and Mona campuses of The University of the West Indies and institutions outside of the region.

Contributions should be written in English, double-spaced with a legible font, preferably Times New Roman, at a 12 pt font size. Page numbers should be placed in the upper-right corner. All illustrations and tables should be labelled and captioned accurately. Authors should follow the MLA guidelines for citations. In the interests of the peer review process, only the title should appear at the beginning of the work. Authors are asked to put the following on a separate (cover) page:

- Title of Work
- Abstract of no more than 300 words
- Author Name (s) and Professional/Institutional Affiliations
- Brief Biography (no more than 80 words)
- Contact Information
