Graduates of Universities other than UWI, should request that a copy of their Official Transcript be forwarded directly to the Office of Graduate Studies and Research, UWI, St. Augustine immediately upon application.

Please note that The University of the West Indies has moved to **ON-LINE APPLICATIONS** and you will therefore be required to visit our website at www.sta.uwi.edu/postgrad where information on all programmes to be offered for the upcoming academic year and instructions on "How to Apply" are available.

Applicants are reminded that references must accompany all applications in sealed envelopes. Applications **WILL NOT** be considered without the relevant documents itemized in our instructions.
