ADMISSION TO POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION PROGRAMME: 2024-2025

FACULTY OF HUMANITIES AND EDUCATION

The School of Education is inviting applications from suitably qualified persons (Secondary Level) to pursue the **In-Service Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PG DipEd)** in the following concentrations:

- ❖ Educational Administration for Secondary Schools
- ❖ Teaching of English
- ❖ Teaching of Modern Foreign Languages
- ❖ Teaching of Information Technology
- ❖ Teaching of Mathematics
- ❖ Teaching of Science (Chemistry; Biology; Physics; Integrated Science; Environmental Science; Physical Education)
- ❖ Teaching of Social Sciences (Business Studies, including Entrepreneurship; Geography; History; Social Studies)
- ❖ Teaching of Visual and Performing Arts (Music; Drama; Visual Arts; Dance)
- ❖ Teaching of Competency-Based Education & Training for Technical and Vocational Educators (CBET/TVET) (E.g. Building Construction; Electrical; Home Economics; Clothing & Textiles; Mechanical; Technical Drawing; Agricultural Science)

This is a blended **part-time** programme. Classes are scheduled at The UWI campus at St. Augustine from September 2024 to May 2025 in face-to-face and online modes, three evenings per week and on 10 Fridays during the school term. Successful applicants must have **reliable high speed Internet access**.

Applicants to the PG DipEd concentrations listed above must be **assessed and appointed** to teach the subject for which they are applying for at least 15 periods or equivalent.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must satisfy the general University Regulations governing admission to a Higher Degree and,

- must possess **at least a first degree** in a relevant area
- must be practising teachers at a secondary school for at least two years.
- **must NOT be currently enrolled in a postgraduate programme or awaiting final award of a degree by the deadline date.**

APPLICATION DETAILS:

In addition to general mandatory postgraduate documents, all applications must be accompanied by **ALL** of the following:

- Principal's Release and Principal's Referee forms
- a copy of the Ministry of Education's assessment letter.
- a letter of appointment from the applicant's employer.

Applications will NOT be processed without all these [documents](#).

Graduates of Universities other than The UWI (St. Augustine Campus) should request that a copy of their official transcript be **emailed** directly to the Office of Graduate Studies and Research via PGTranscripts@sta.uwi.edu
