Three (3) academic years - Full-time

Entry Requirements

Applicants for admission to the Bachelor of Science General Major in Environmental Science & Sustainable Technology degree programme must possess the following qualifications:

- Passes in five (5) CSEC (CXC) General Proficiency subjects including Math and English Language. Grade III is only accepted from 1998; AND
- 2 subjects at GCE A-levels or passes in at least two 2- Unit CXC (CAPE) subjects

OR

An Associate Degree, Diploma or Certificate from an approved tertiary educational institution; these include the following qualifications:

- Chartered Insurance Institute (CII), Diploma in Insurance
- Association of Business Executives (A.B.E.) U.K., Diploma
- Fellow of The Life Management Institute (FLMI)
- Royal Bank Institute of Business And Technology (ROYTEC), Associate Degree
- Teacher Training College of Trinidad And Tobago, Teachers Diploma
