Thanks to all our PEERSS who participated in the Needs Assessment exercise. It was designed to capture the perspectives and approaches to evidence use in policymaking within social sector Ministries. This process utilised a mixed methods approach: in-depth interviews and a survey.

We are currently analysing the data and preparing the reports which will be shared with each Ministry. The findings will be used to customise the training and coaching material for each Ministry.
