



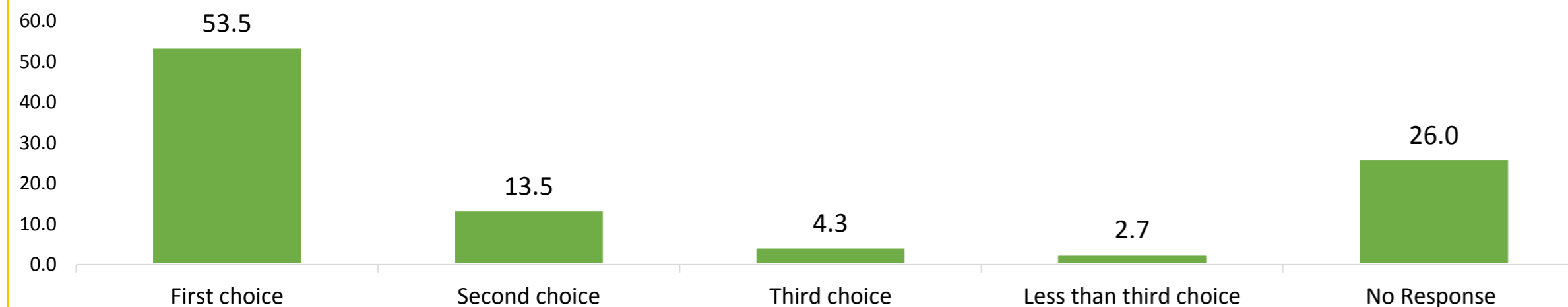
THE ST. AUGUSTINE CAMPUS Highlights of the Incoming Student Survey 2016-2017

The Incoming Student Survey is an effort to explore the pre-university experience and expectations of university experience of incoming first degree students for the 2016/2017 academic year. The data collection process resulted in a response rate of 29.8% and tested variables as it relates to socio economic background, pre-university educational experience, university life expectations and academic performance. All variables were tested in the survey instrument except academic performance which were extracted from the Campus Business Intelligence system.

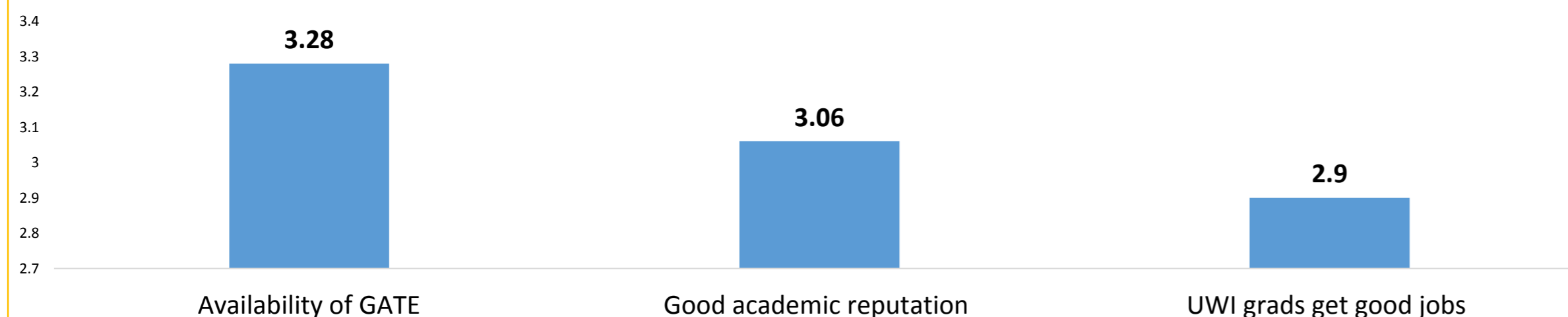
The objectives of this study are:

1. To examine the nature of the socio-economic background, pre-university educational experience and expectations of incoming students.
2. To determine how socio economic background and pre-university factors impact expectations of students 'university experience and academic performance.

54% of respondents say that UWI STA is their first choice institution.



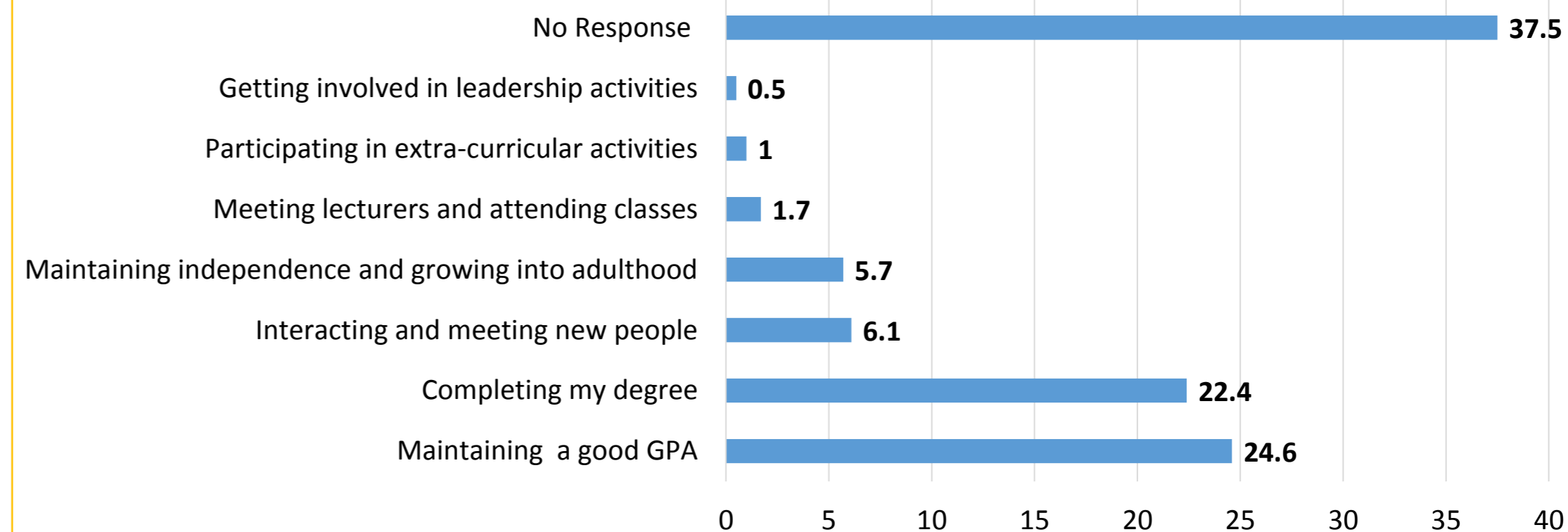
Mean Scores of the Top 3 Influential Factors driving the decision to study at the St Augustine Campus
