About the Statistical Digest

The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine Campus, presents The Campus Student Statistical Digest for the academic year 2021/2022. The Digest presents a comprehensive collection of official relevant historical and current data on the student population. These statistics cover a five-year academic period (2017/2018 to 2021/2022) and in certain areas, data for Semester 1 of the current academic year 2022/2023. The report examines student admissions, enrolment, graduation, and departmental and faculty trends. Also highlighted, are trends in student applications, offers and admissions. Of interest are some key empirical findings emerging from the annual graduate survey of the first-degree graduating 2020/2021.

This report is the result of a collaborative effort between the Campus Office of Planning and Institutional Research (COPIR) and the Office of the Campus Registrar, with key input from other units namely, the Student Admissions section, the Office of Graduate Studies and Research (OGSR) and the Examinations section of The UWI St. Augustine Campus. We are grateful as well for the support of the Campus Information Technology Service (CITS) and the Faculties.

Introduction

The University of the West Indies is a five-campus tertiary education institution supported by 17 contributing countries. It offers undergraduate and postgraduate degrees in various fields of study to students from around the region and internationally. The St. Augustine Campus in Trinidad was born in 1960 out of the Imperial College of Tropical Agriculture (ICTA) and typically provides higher education to over 16,000 students. The St. Augustine Campus houses eight faculties: Humanities & Education, Social Sciences, Medical Sciences, Law, Science and Technology, Food and Agriculture and Engineering and the newest being the Faculty of Sport. It also hosts a range of research units, centres, and institutes. The UWI, St. Augustine continues to be dedicated to teaching and learning, research, and innovation and to the development of the Caribbean region.

This report on The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine Campus is a presentation to the St. Augustine Campus Council for the academic year 2021/2022. The statistical information presented provides quantitative measures and utilises descriptive statistics to illustrate current and historical data on student participation and performance for the period 2017/2018 to 2021/2022. It also provides a snapshot of student statistics for Semester 1 of the current academic year, 2022/2023. This report delivers information on the following areas:

- a. **Student statistics over a five-year period in respect of Student Applications, Admissions, Enrolment and Graduation**
- b. **Faculty statistical comparisons**
- c. **A demographic profile of students by nationality, age and sex**
- d. **Student enrolment at the programme level**

This document was produced with Enrolment data that was generated on August 2nd, 2022 and Graduation data that was generated on November 3rd, 2022. As such, any updates made to data subsequent to the aforementioned dates would not be reflected in the statistics presented.

Definitions of Key Terms and Concepts

Acceptance Rate	The percentage of applicants who received official offers from the St. Augustine Campus.
Applications	The number of applications received from individuals (head count).
Contributing Countries	Countries included in the UWI 12 + 1 as well as Barbados, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago.
Evening	Students registered in Certificate/Diploma or Degree programmes offered specifically in the Evening University.
First Year Retention	The percentage of students from a specific entry cohort who re-enrol for a second year of study.
Full-Time	Registered students who carry the complete load of course credits associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year.
Nationals	Students whose country of nationality is Trinidad & Tobago.
New Admissions	Registered students who are new first-time entrants and new first-time transfers to the University.
No College Designated	Students who are enrolled in Summer Programmes who are registered with a particular faculty.
Non-Contributing Countries	All nations other than the UWI 12 + 1, Barbados, Jamaica or Trinidad & Tobago.
Not Identifiable (NI)	No data available in the data repository.
Offers	The number of applicants (head count) given institutional acceptance (offers).
Off Campus	Students enrolled in programmes that are administered at UWI-affiliated institutions and are not located in the host country, that is Trinidad & Tobago.
On Campus	On Campus Students who attend classes on the St. Augustine or Mt. Hope campuses and are in pursuit of a degree, certificate, or diploma programme.
On-Time Graduation	The number of students that completed their degree programme within the time frame allotted by the University.
Other Students	Students enrolled in undeclared courses and summer programmes.
Part -time	Registered students who carry less than the complete load of courses associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year.

Postgraduate (PG)	Students enrolled in Higher Degree programmes at the St. Augustine Campus which lead to the acquisition of a qualification beyond a first degree such as the PG Diploma, Taught Master, Master of Philosophy, Doctorate etc.
Pre-University Students	Students enrolled in the Pre-Science, Pre-Health and Pre-Engineering programmes.
Programme	The course of study for which the student has been admitted into the University. This pertains to Certificates, Diplomas, Undergraduate (BSc, BA, BEd), Postgraduate Diplomas and Higher Degrees (MA, MSc, MPhil, PhD, etc.).
Qualifying	A student reading for courses to qualify for entry to a postgraduate programme.
Registration/Enrolment	The process by which students, upon acceptance into a given faculty and programme at the University, give written notification of the courses which they wish to pursue during the current semester/academic year. Various aspects of the registration data are represented in the tables. For this document, this includes both on and off campus students. Students categorised as Other (see definition above) are represented in separate tables.
Specially Admitted/Specially Admitted (Stand Alone)	Persons may register to read a course or courses within the UWI, without being registered in an Undergraduate or Postgraduate degree programme. These persons are considered for entry as "Specially Admitted students". Under the University's rules, such persons may read up to total of 24 credits in this category or registration. A maximum of nine (9) relevant credits obtained through special admission can be counted towards UWI certification and Graduate Diplomas and Degrees of The UWI.
Student Session	Students enrolled in a full-time, part-time, evening, or summer basis.
Summer	Students enrolled to pursue courses during the summer semester, which occurs, from June to July of the academic year.
Undergraduate (UG)	Students enrolled at the St. Augustine Campus in programmes, which lead to the award of a Certificate, UG Diploma or First Degree.
Undeclared	At UWI 'Undeclared' is a level, in addition to UG, PG, CT, etc. used to differentiate students in a non-degree or certificate programme, such as the Pre-Science (N1) programme or Pre-Health Professions Programme (PHPP).
Yield Rate	The percentage of students that, upon receipt of an offer, choose to be enrolled at the St. Augustine Campus. The rate is commonly used as a measure of selectivity indicating interest in a particular institution.

Section 1 –Trends in the Number of Applications, Offer and New Admissions

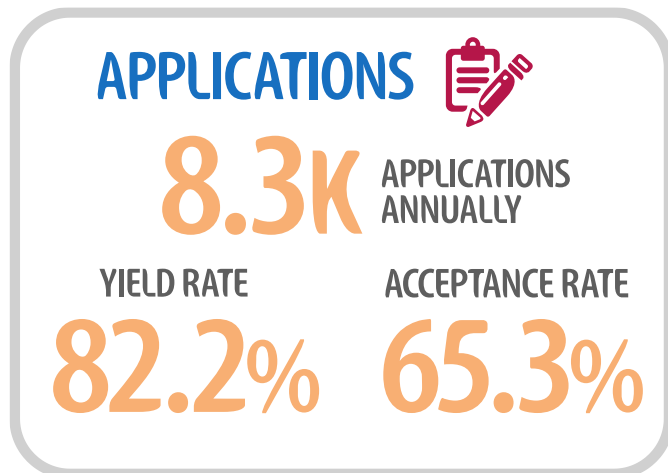


Figure 1.1: Trends in Applicants, Offers and New Admissions 2013/2014 - 2022/2023

Figure 1.1 below illustrates undergraduate and postgraduate trends for applications, offers and new admissions over a ten-year period. The number of applications to the St. Augustine Campus has been declining since 2013/2014. In 2016/2017 applications peaked at 12,174 but since then applications have declined to 8,346 in 2022/2023 representing a 31.4% decline since the academic year 2016/2017. Offers made have shown marginal increases over the time-period 2013/2014 to 2016/2017, thereafter, offers made have been on the decline indicating a 36.8% decline from 2016/2017 to 2022/2023. Annual new admissions to the campus have also declined by 35.2% from 2013/2014 to 2022/2023.

In terms of acceptance rates (offers/applications), there has been an increasing trend from 2017/2018 to 2019/2020, however there have been decreases over the time-period 2020/2021 to 2022/2023. This is mainly attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic which created a degree of uncertainty amongst applicants. This however did not have an impact on yield rates (new admissions/offers) as there was an increase from 71.9% in 2021/2022 to 82.2% in 2022/2023. This may be attributed to the post covid period and the return to physical or face to face learning.

Figure 1.2: Trends in Acceptance Rates 2013/2014 to 2022/2023

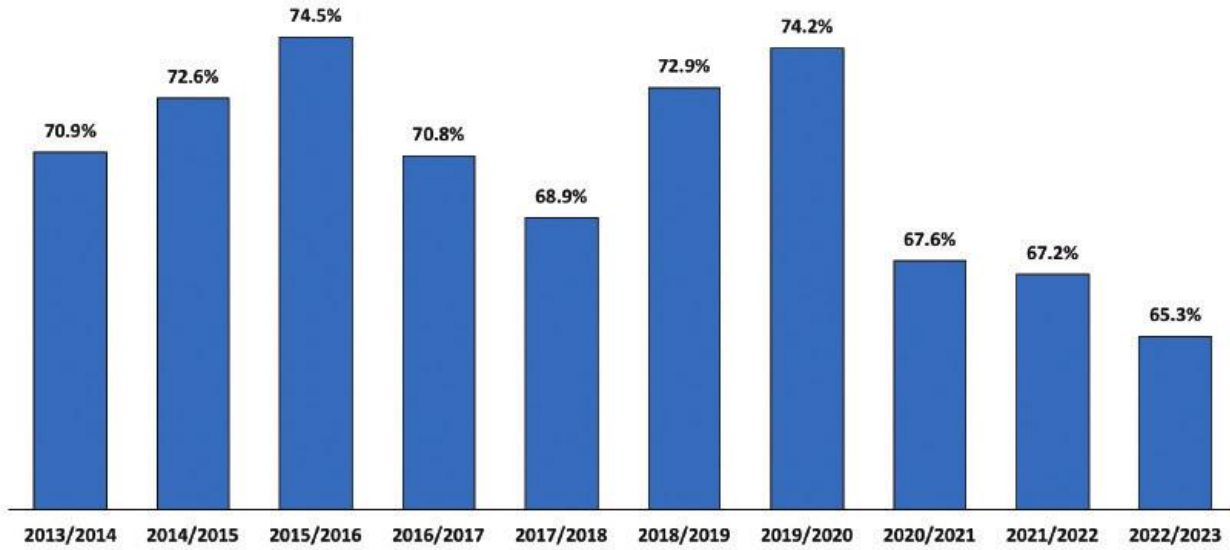
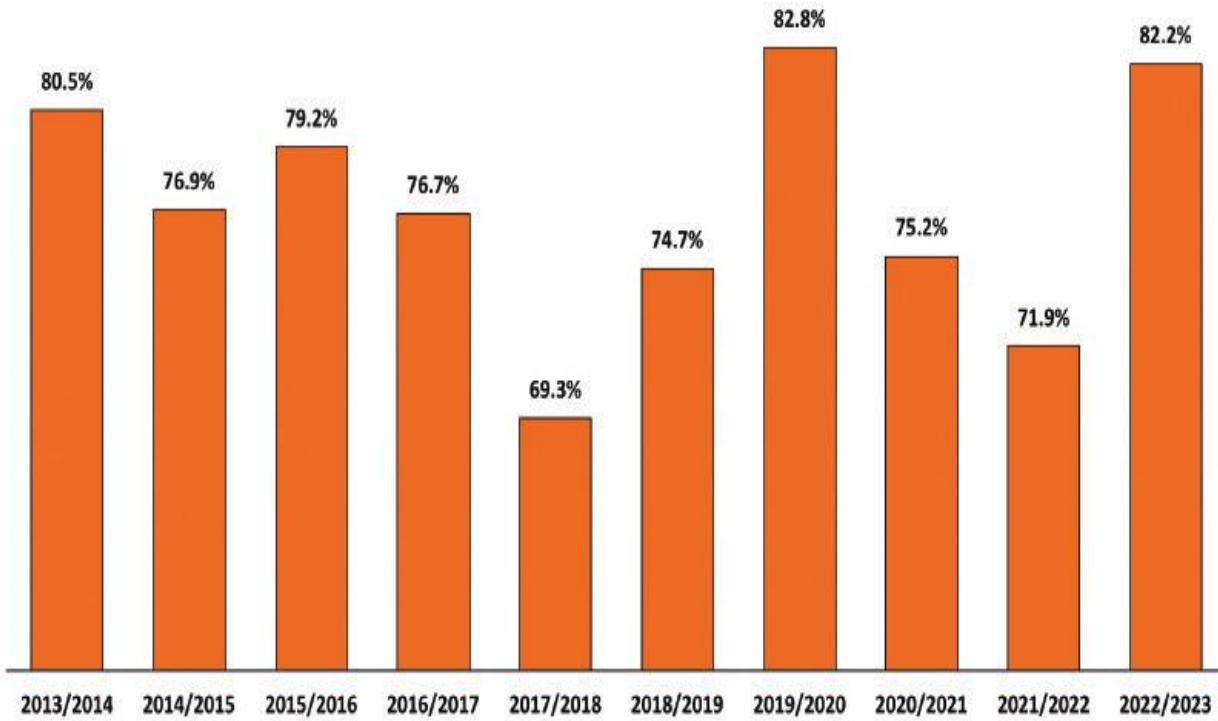


Figure 1.3: Trends in Yield Rates 2013/2014 to 2022/2023

2 – Total Enrolment Trends for UG and PG Students

2017/2018 to 2021/2022

Student enrolment is representative of new and continuing students at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels in the eight (8) faculties of Engineering, Food and Agriculture, Humanities and Education, Law, Medical Sciences, Science and Technology, Social Sciences and Sport. In 2021/2022, the undergraduate population and postgraduate population constituted 69.2% and 27.3% respectively of total enrolment.

A review of the total enrolment trends indicates a continuous decline of 20.9% over the last ten-year period and an average annual growth rate of -2%.

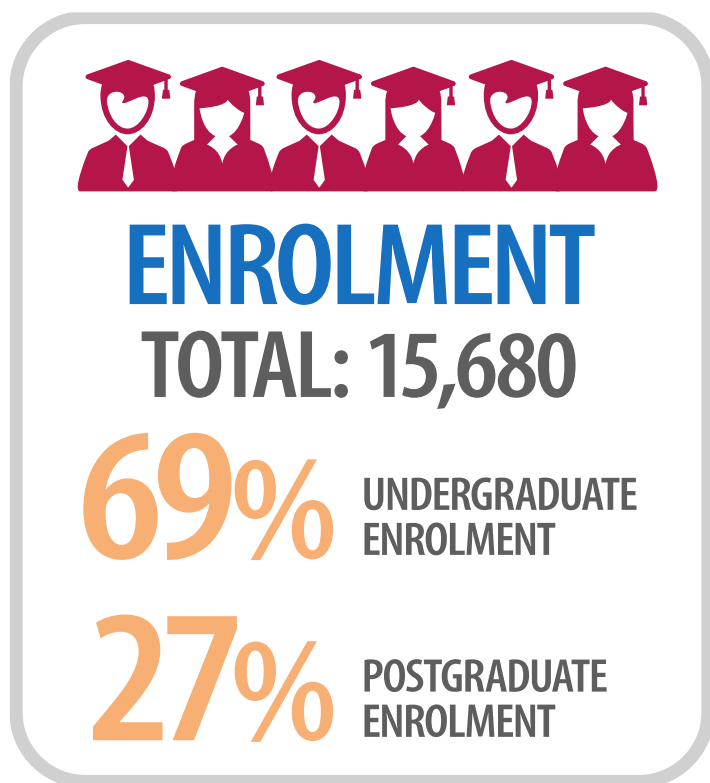


Figure 2.1: Enrolment Trends for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Students 2012/2013 – 2021/2022

In particular, the trends have indicated a progressive decline in student enrolment between the period 2016/2017 to 2021/2022 (See Figure 2.1). This is a result of a decline in postgraduate enrolment by 27.7% and an undergraduate decline of 7.4%.

Table 2.1 shows that Pre-University and Other Students comprise 3.5% of student enrolment. In this table, the figure for Total Enrolment, situated at the top of the table comprises both Pre-University students and Other Students. All other tables in this section will provide statistics for the Undergraduate and Postgraduate student populations only.

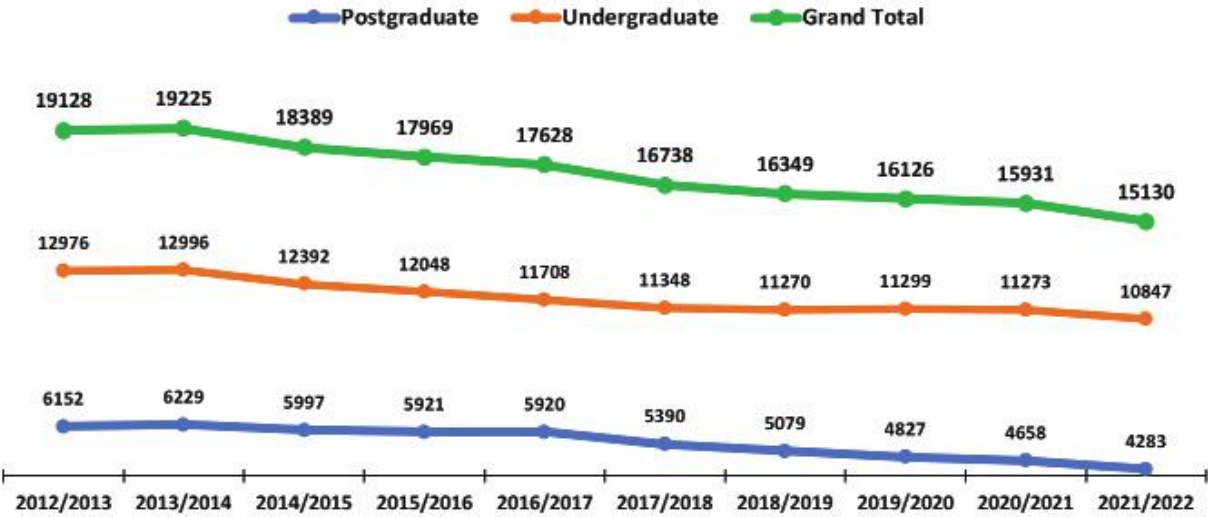

Section 3 – Student Demographic Trends for UG and PG Students 2017/18 to 2021/2022

In terms of overall trends in the demographic profile of the student population, for the academic year 2021/2022, approximately 63% are females. Most of the Undergraduate student population is in the age cohort of 18 – 24 years. Over the five(5) year period, at the undergraduate level, 39% entered the institution at the age of 19. However, at the postgraduate level the majority of new entrants are age 22. This suggests that most students are transitioning into the postgraduate level immediately after graduation.

In terms of nationality, 92.7% of the student population were represented by nationals of Trinidad & Tobago, 4.85% were from the contributing countries, while those from non-contributing countries represented approximately 2.3%.

In Table 3.1 below, the figure for Total Enrolment, situated at the top of the table comprises of both Pre-University students and Other Students. All other tables in this section will show analysis for the Undergraduate and Postgraduate student populations only.

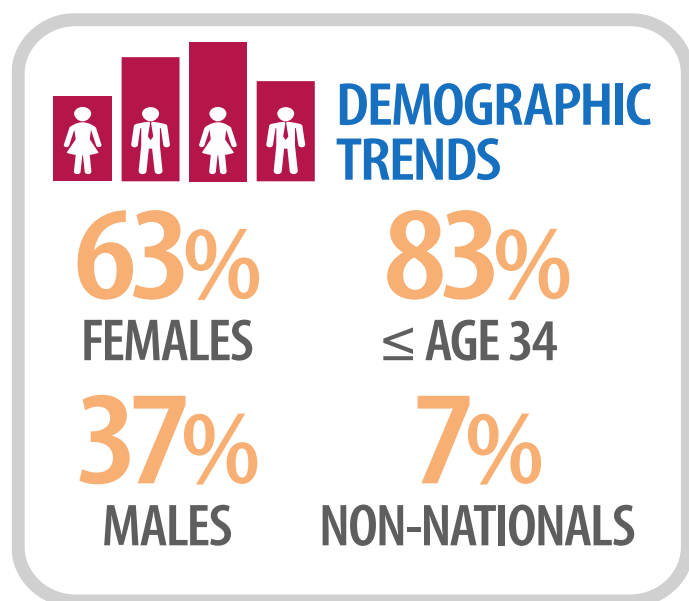

Figure 3.1: Postgraduate Enrolment by Nationality 2017/2018 to 2021/2022

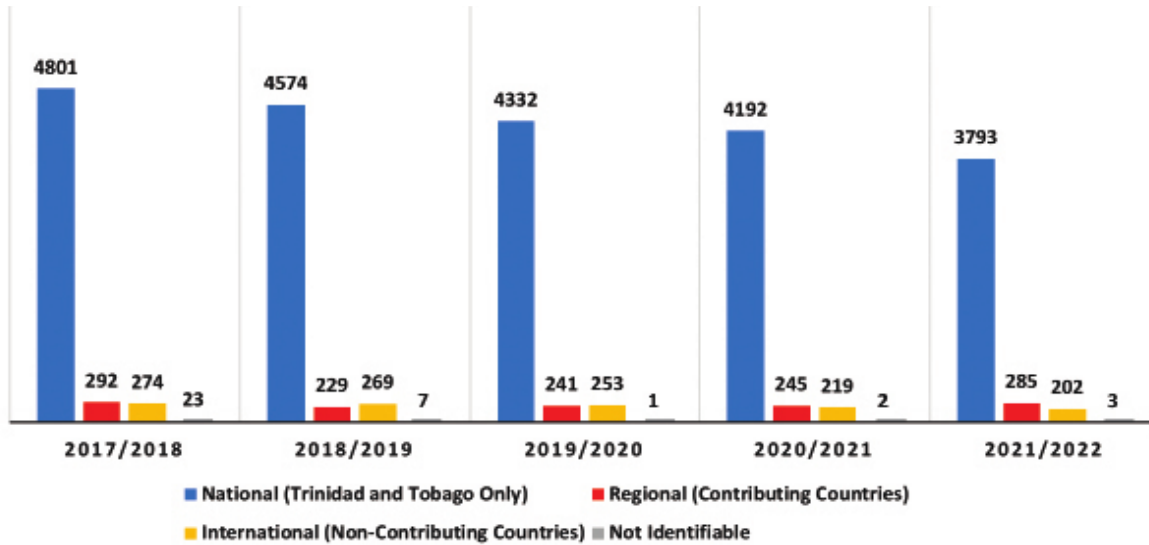


Figure 3.2: Undergraduate Enrolment by Nationality 2017/2018 to 2021/2022

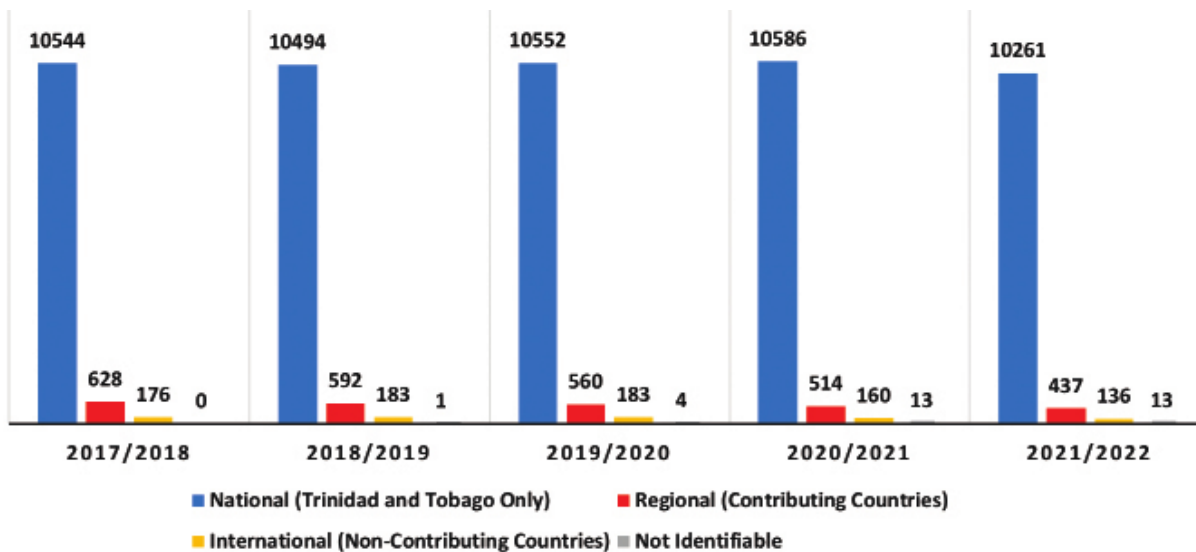

Figure 3.3: Postgraduate Enrolment by Age Group at Entry 2017/2018 to 2021/2022

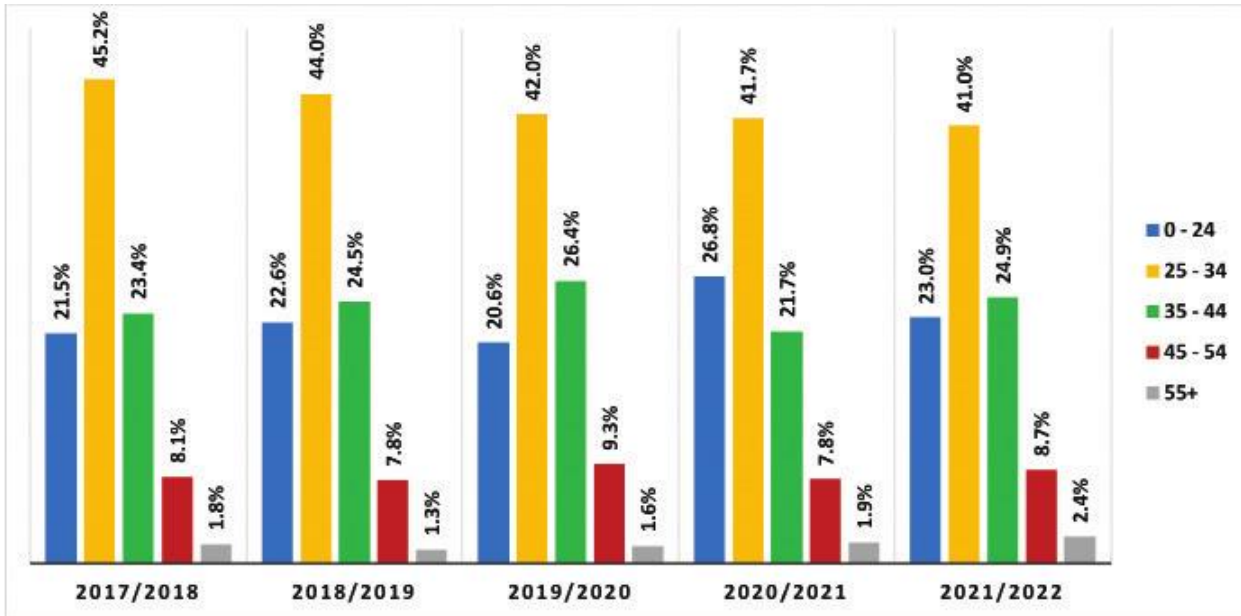


Figure 3.4: Undergraduate Enrolment by Age Group at Entry 2017/2018 to 2021/2022

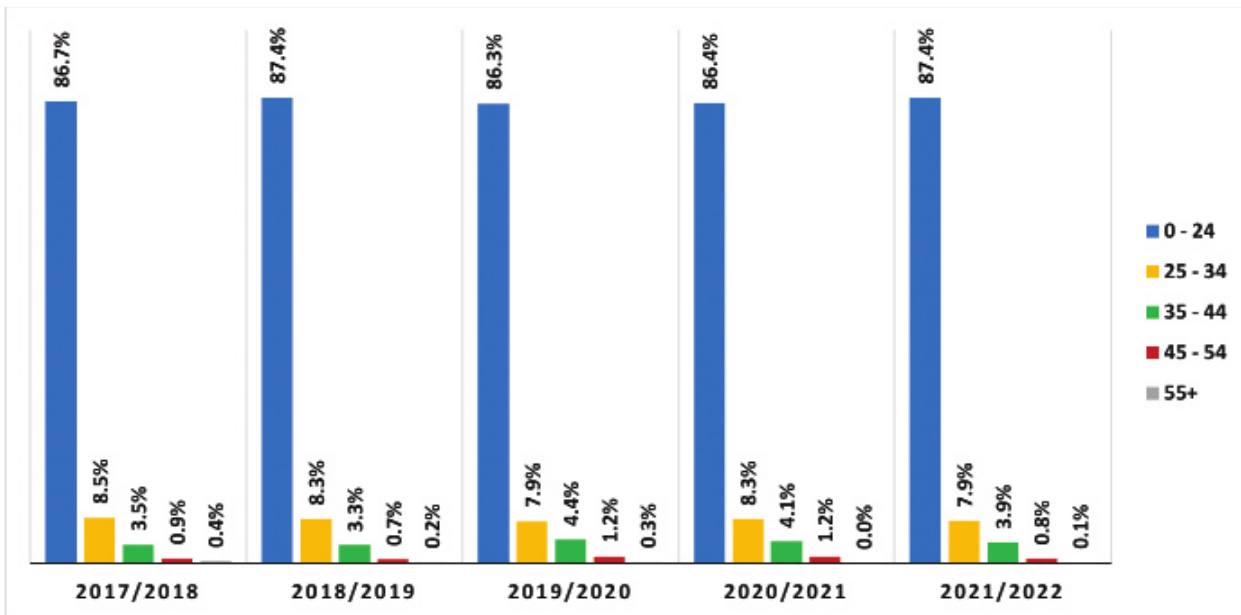

Section 4 – Undergraduate and Postgraduate Faculty Trends 2017/18 to 2021/2022

The Faculty of Social Sciences continues to be the largest faculty, accounting for approximately one third of the student population. The faculties which follow include Medical Sciences and Science & Technology at 19.3% and 19.8% respectively. In the academic year 2021/2022, the highest proportion of Postgraduate enrolment is in the Faculty of Social Sciences at 37.8%, which include those enrolled in the Arthur Lok Jack Global School of Business. The Faculty of Humanities and Education is the second highest postgraduate enrolment at 16.7%, followed by Engineering at 16.5%.

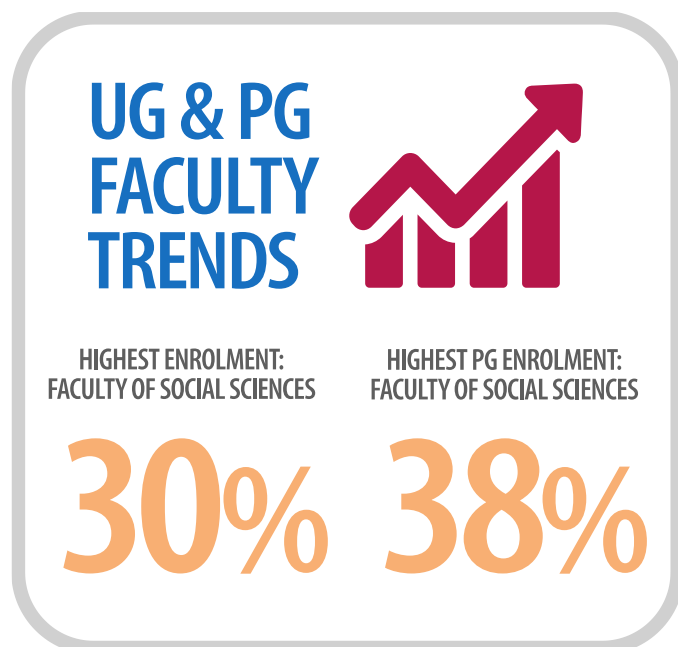




Figure 4.1: Postgraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2017/2018 to 2021/2022

■ 2017/2018 ■ 2018/2019 ■ 2019/2020 ■ 2020/2021 ■ 2021/2022

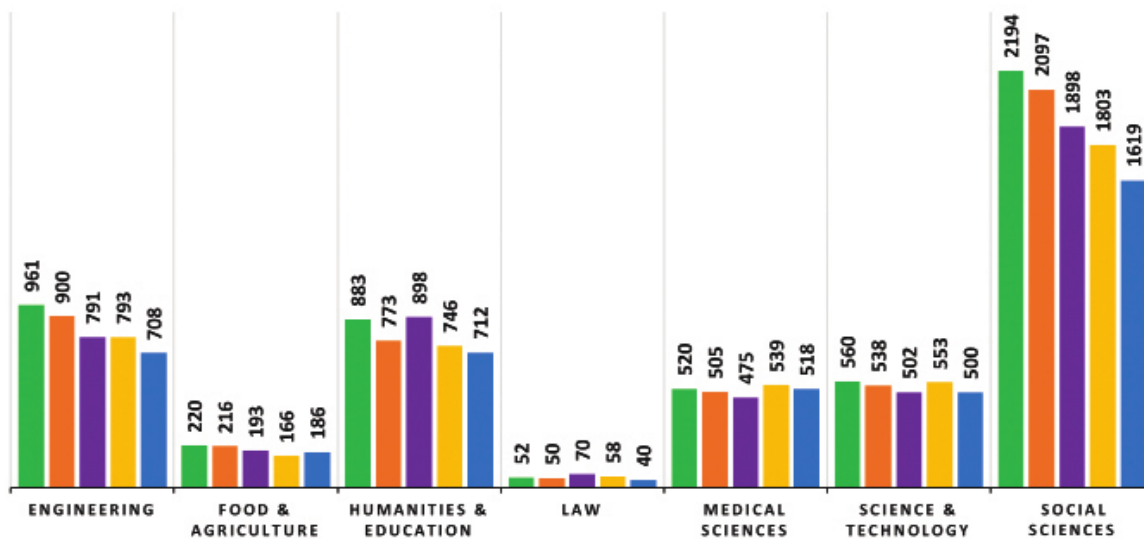


Figure 4.2: Undergraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2017/2018 to 2021/2022

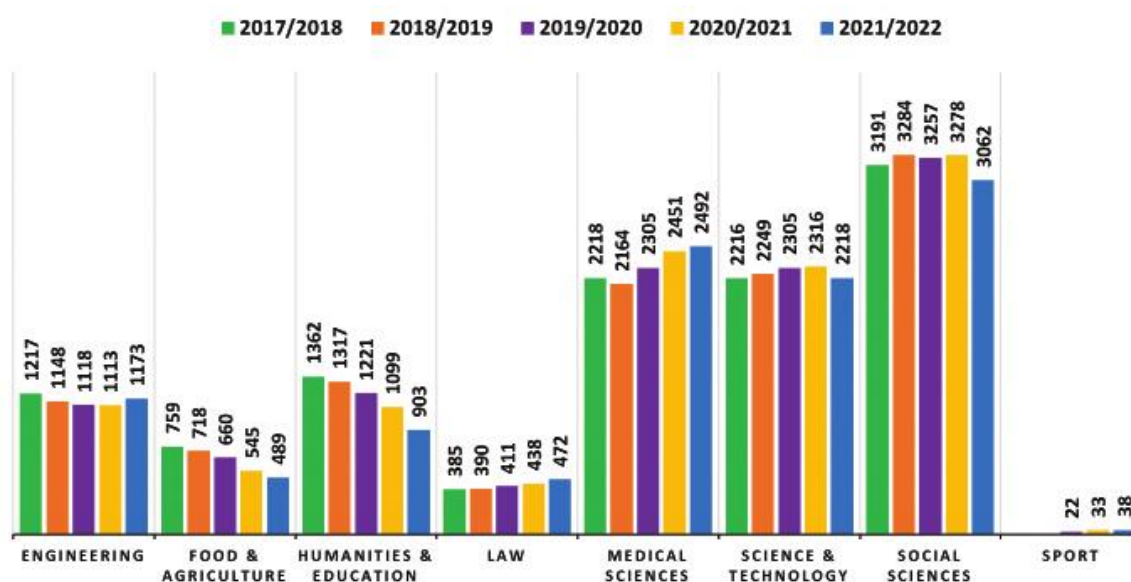

Section 5 – Undergraduate and Postgraduate Graduation Trends

This section provides data on graduate output in respect of demographics, faculty, degree honours and graduate throughput.

A total of 3688 persons graduated in 2021/2022 with 75% being undergraduate and 25% being postgraduate degrees. This stood for a decrease in the number of graduates in comparison to 2020/2021 where there were 3926. Of the degrees awarded in 2021/2022, 68.9% were first degree graduates and 22.2% were higher degree graduates. This represented an increase in the proportion of first degrees, which was at 62.2% in 2020/2021.

The programmes which awarded the highest number of graduates in 2021/2022 included Bachelor Management Studies; Bachelor of Laws; Bachelor of Nursing; Bachelor of Psychology and BSCE Mechanical Engineering at the first-degree level. Included at the postgraduate level are the Master of Business Administration; Master of Management Studies; Master of Strategic Leadership & Management; Master of Education and Master of Laws at the graduate taught master's level.

Information extracted from the annual Graduate Tracer Survey of first-degree graduates of 2020/2021 are presented below in Figures 5.1 to 5.5. The feedback received from the graduates are captured one year post graduation and presents an indication of the sectors of their employment, the main areas of economic activity of their employers, the time taken to find employment and the salary ranges earned.

Figure 5.1: Graduate Trends for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Students 2012/2013 to 2021/2022

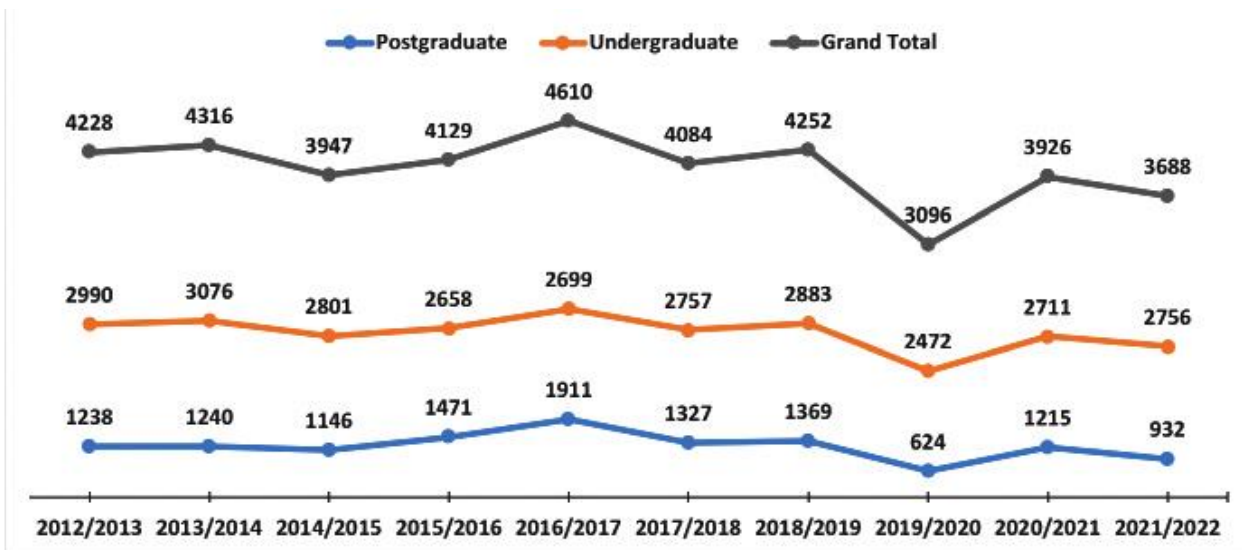


Figure 5.2: Respondents by Sector of Employment for 2020/2021

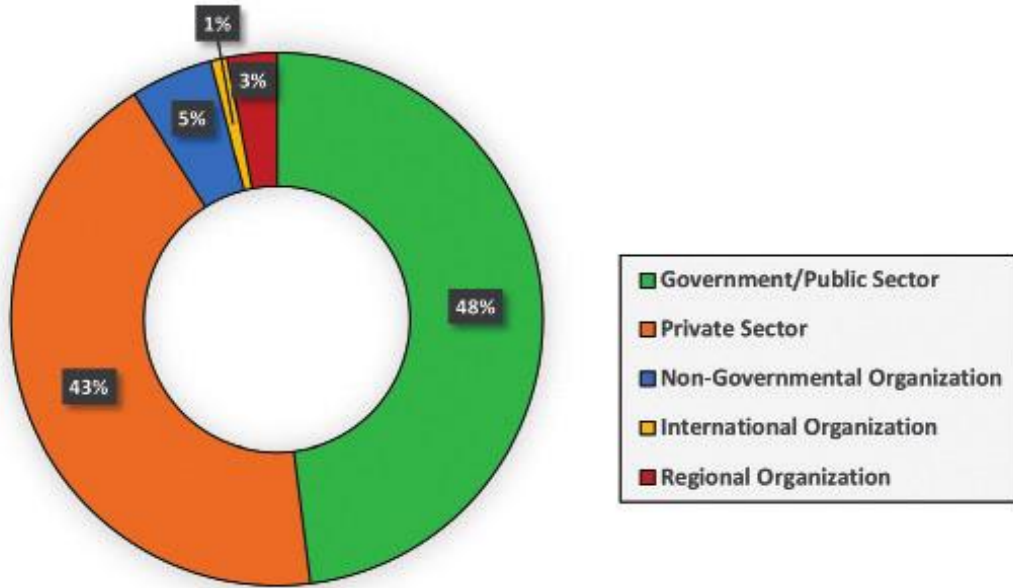


Figure 5.3: Respondents by Employers Area of Economic Activity 2020/2021

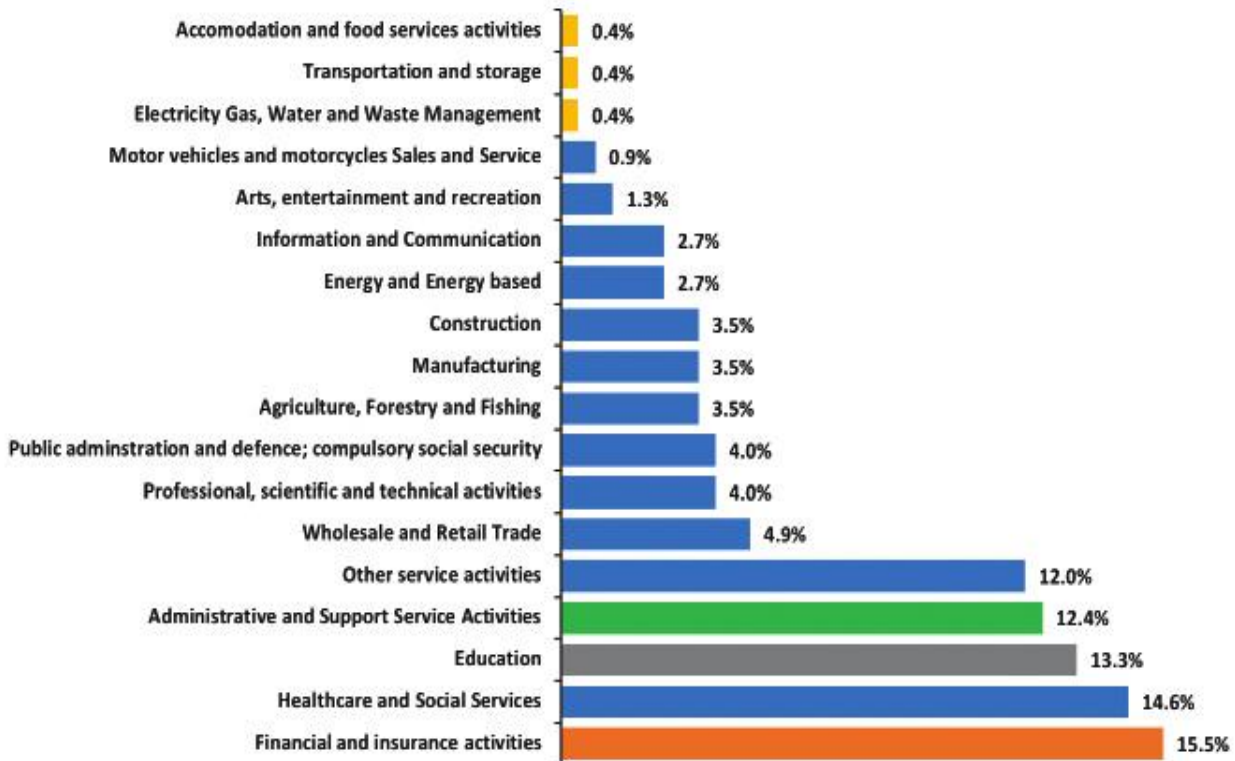


Figure 5.4: Respondents' Mean Time taken to Find Employment (In Months) for 2020/2021

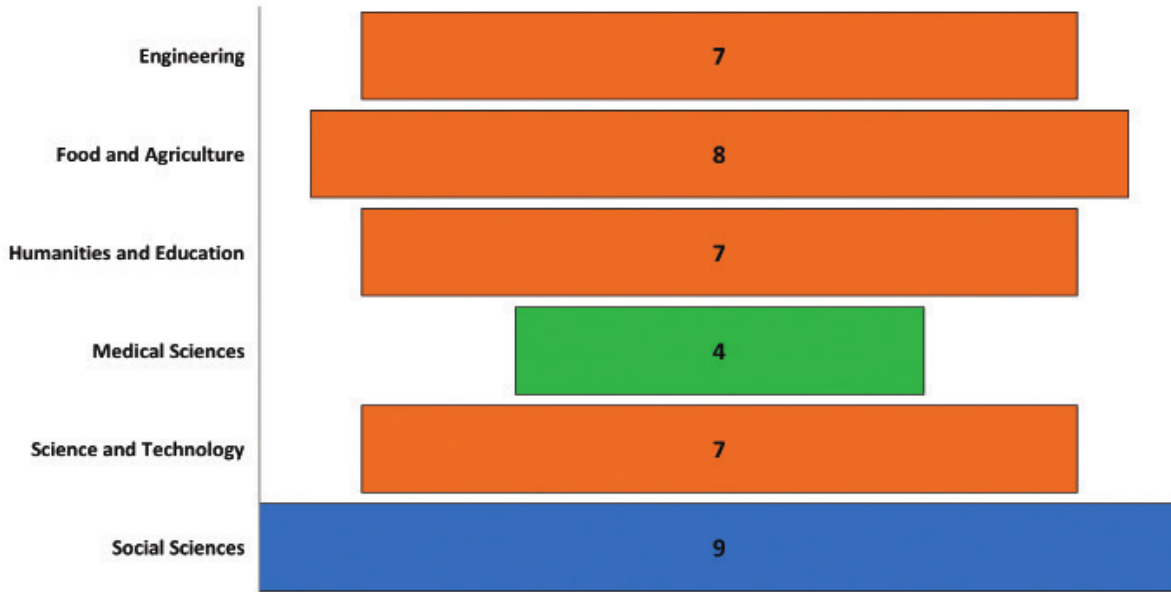


Figure 5.5: Respondents' Salary Range (TT\$) for 2020/2021

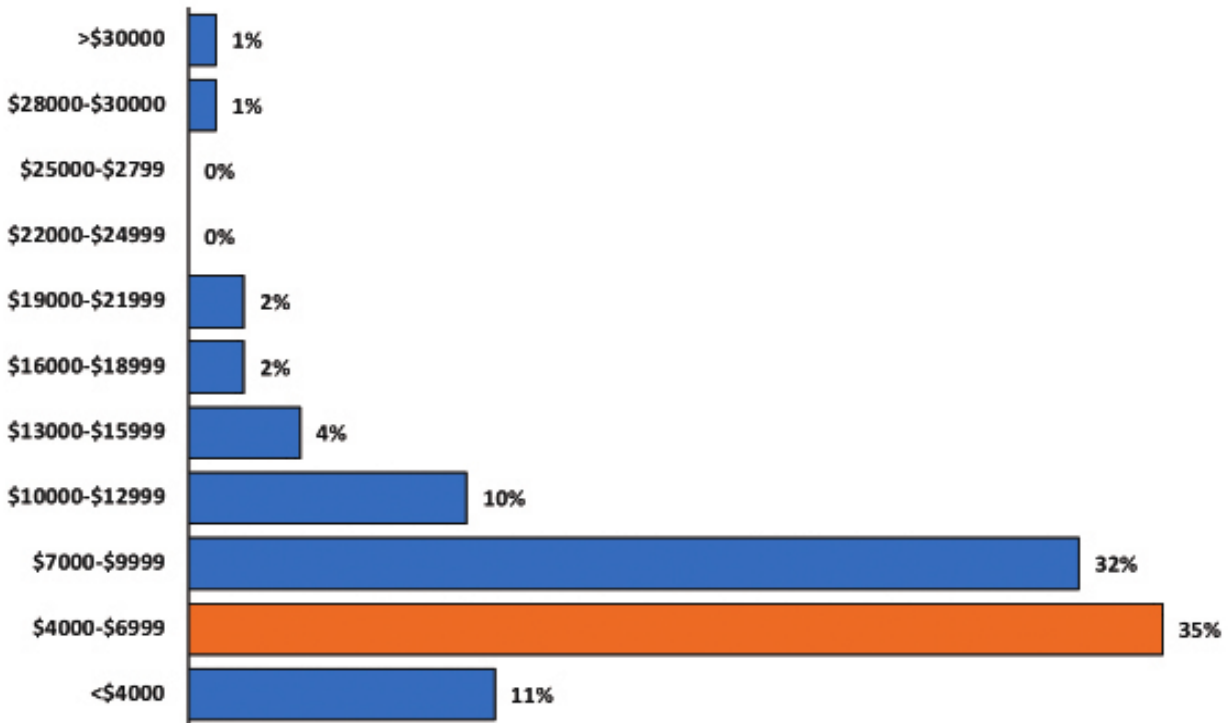
