## Introduction

The University of the West Indies is a five-campus tertiary education institution supported by 17 contributing countries. It offers undergraduate and postgraduate degrees in various fields of study to students from around the region and internationally. The St. Augustine Campus in Trinidad was born in 1960 out of the Imperial College of Tropical Agriculture (ICTA) and typically provides higher education to over 16,000 students. The St. Augustine Campus houses eight faculties: Engineering, Food & Agriculture, Humanities & Education, Law, Medical Sciences, Science & Technology, Social Sciences and Sport. It also hosts a range of research units, centres, and institutes. The UWI, St. Augustine continues to be dedicated to teaching and learning, research, and innovation and to the development of the Caribbean region.

This report is a presentation to the St. Augustine Campus Council for the academic year 2023/2024. The statistical information presented provides quantitative measures and utilises descriptive statistics to illustrate current and historical data on student participation and performance for the period 2019/2020 to 2023/2024. It also provides a snapshot of student statistics for Semester 1 of the current academic year, 2024/2025. This report delivers information on the following areas:

- a. Student statistics over a five-year period in respect of Student Applications, Admissions, Enrolment and Graduation
- b. Faculty statistical comparisons
- c. A demographic profile of students by nationality, age and sex
- d. Highlights obtained from the annual Graduate Tracer Survey
- e. Student enrolment at the programme level.

This document was produced with Enrolment data and Graduation data that were generated on November 4th, 2024. As such, any updates made to data after the dates mentioned would not be reflected in the statistics presented.



## Definitions of Key Terms and Concepts

<b>Acceptance Rate</b>	The percentage of applicants who received official offers from the St. Augustine Campus.
<b>Applications</b>	The number of submitted applications from individuals (head count).
<b>Certificate of Achievement</b>	The certificate received after completing short courses administered by the faculty of Food & Agriculture.
<b>Contributing Countries</b>	Countries included in the UWI 12 + 1 as well as Barbados, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago.
<b>Continuing Professional Education (CPE)</b>	Continuing and Professional Education (CPE) is a range of credit and non-credit courses located within a lifelong learning and workforce development framework.
<b>Evening</b>	Students registered in Certificate/Diploma or Degree programmes offered specifically in the Evening University.
<b>Bachelor's Degree First Year Retention</b>	The percentage of students from a specific entry cohort who re-enrol for a second year of study.
<b>Full-Time</b>	Registered students who carry the complete load of course credits associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year.
<b>Nationals</b>	Students whose country of nationality is Trinidad & Tobago.
<b>New Admissions</b>	Registered students who are new first-time entrants and new first-time transfers to the University.
<b>No College Designated</b>	Students who are enrolled in Summer Programmes who are registered with a particular faculty.
<b>Non-Contributing Countries</b>	All nations other than the UWI 12 + 1, Barbados, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago.
<b>Not Identifiable (NI)</b>	No data is available in the data repository.
<b>Offers</b>	The number of applicants (head count) given institutional acceptance (offers).
<b>Off Campus</b>	Students enrolled in programmes that are administered at UWI-affiliated institutions and are not located in the host country, that is Trinidad & Tobago.
<b>On Campus</b>	On Campus Students who attend classes on the St. Augustine or Mt. Hope campuses and are in pursuit of a degree, certificate, or diploma programme.
<b>On-Time Graduation</b>	The number of students that completed their undergraduate first degree programme within the minimum time frame allotted by the University.
<b>Other Students</b>	Students enrolled in undeclared courses, summer programmes, pre-university programmes, certificate of achievement and CPE short courses.
<b>Part-time</b>	Registered students who carry less than the complete load of courses associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year.
<b>Postgraduate (PG)</b>	Students enrolled in Higher Degree programmes at the St. Augustine Campus which lead to the acquisition of a qualification beyond a first degree such as the PG Diploma, Taught Masters, Master of Philosophy, Doctorate etc.
<b>Pre-University Students</b>	Students enrolled in the Pre-Science, Pre-Health and Pre-Engineering programmes.
<b>Programme</b>	The course of study for which the student has been admitted into the University. This pertains to Certificates, Diplomas, Undergraduate (BSc, BA, BEd), Postgraduate Diplomas and Higher Degrees (MA, MSc, MPhil, PhD, etc.).
<b>Qualifying</b>	A student reading for courses to qualify for entry to a postgraduate programme.
<b>Registration/Enrolment</b>	The process by which students, upon acceptance into a given faculty and programme at the University, give written notification of the courses which they wish to pursue during the current semester/academic year. For this document, this includes both on and off campus students. Students categorised as Other (see definition above) are represented in separate tables.
<b>Specially Admitted/Specially Admitted (Stand Alone)</b>	Persons may register to read a course or courses within The UWI, without being registered in an Undergraduate or Postgraduate degree programme. These persons are considered for entry as "Specially Admitted students". Under the University's rules, such persons may read up to total of 24 credits in this category or registration. A maximum of nine (9) relevant credits obtained through special admission can be counted towards UWI certification and Graduate Diplomas and Degrees of The UWI.
<b>Student Session</b>	Students enrolled in a full-time, part-time, evening, or summer basis.
<b>Summer</b>	Students enrolled to pursue courses during the summer semester, which occurs, from June to July of the academic year.
<b>Undergraduate (UG)</b>	Students enrolled at the St. Augustine Campus in programmes, which lead to the award of a Certificate, UG Diploma or First Degree.
<b>Undeclared</b>	At The UWI 'Undeclared' is a level, in addition to UG, PG, Cert., etc. used to differentiate students in a non-degree or certificate programme.
<b>UG/PG Credit Bearing Certificate</b>	The certificate received upon completion of courses administered by the CPE Unit.
<b>Yield Rate</b>	The percentage of students that, upon receipt of an offer, choose to be enrolled at the St. Augustine Campus. The rate is commonly used as a measure of selectivity indicating interest in a particular institution.

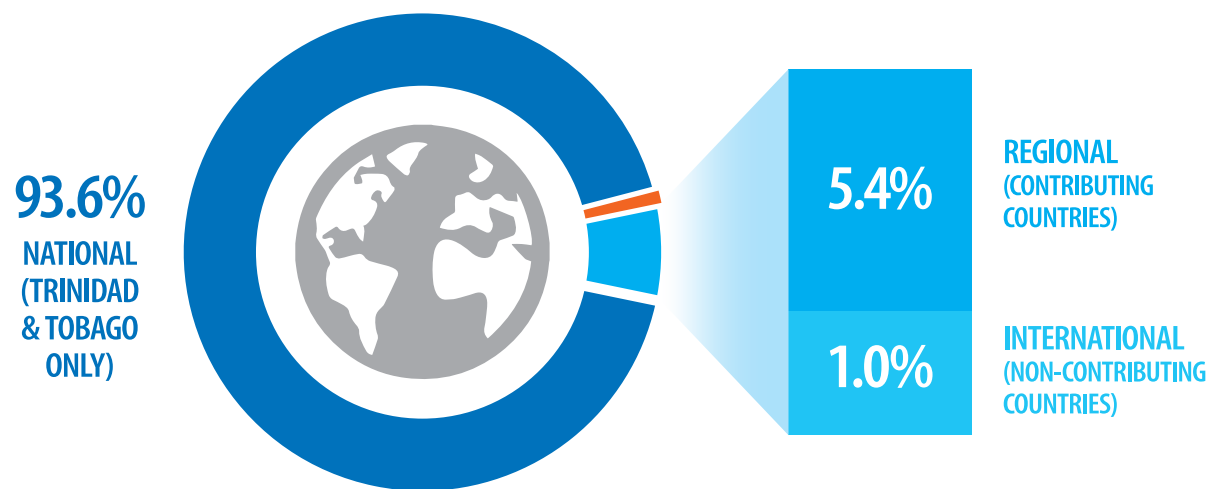




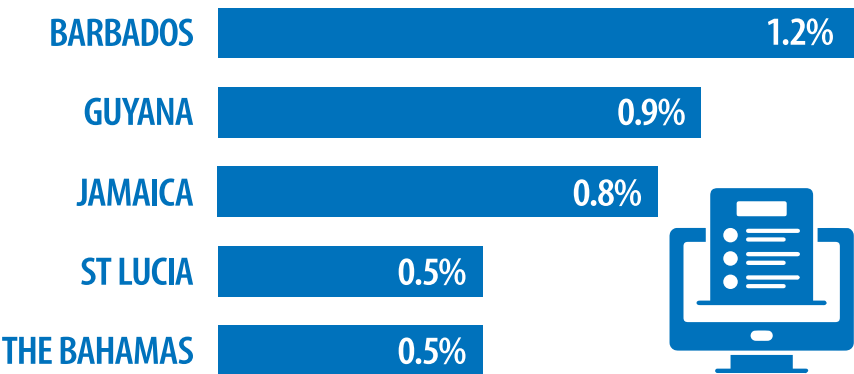




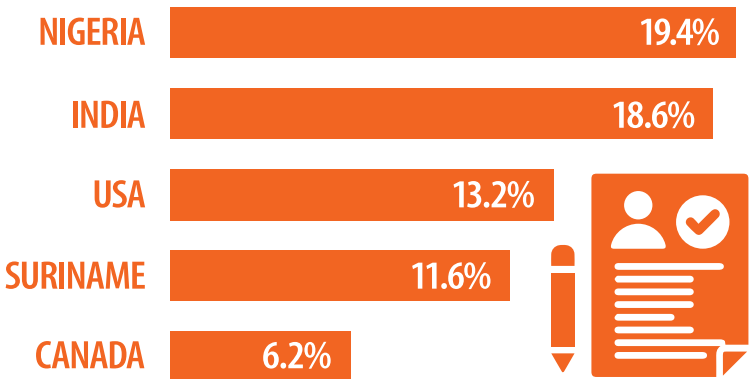
UG & PG ENROLMENT BY NATIONALITY

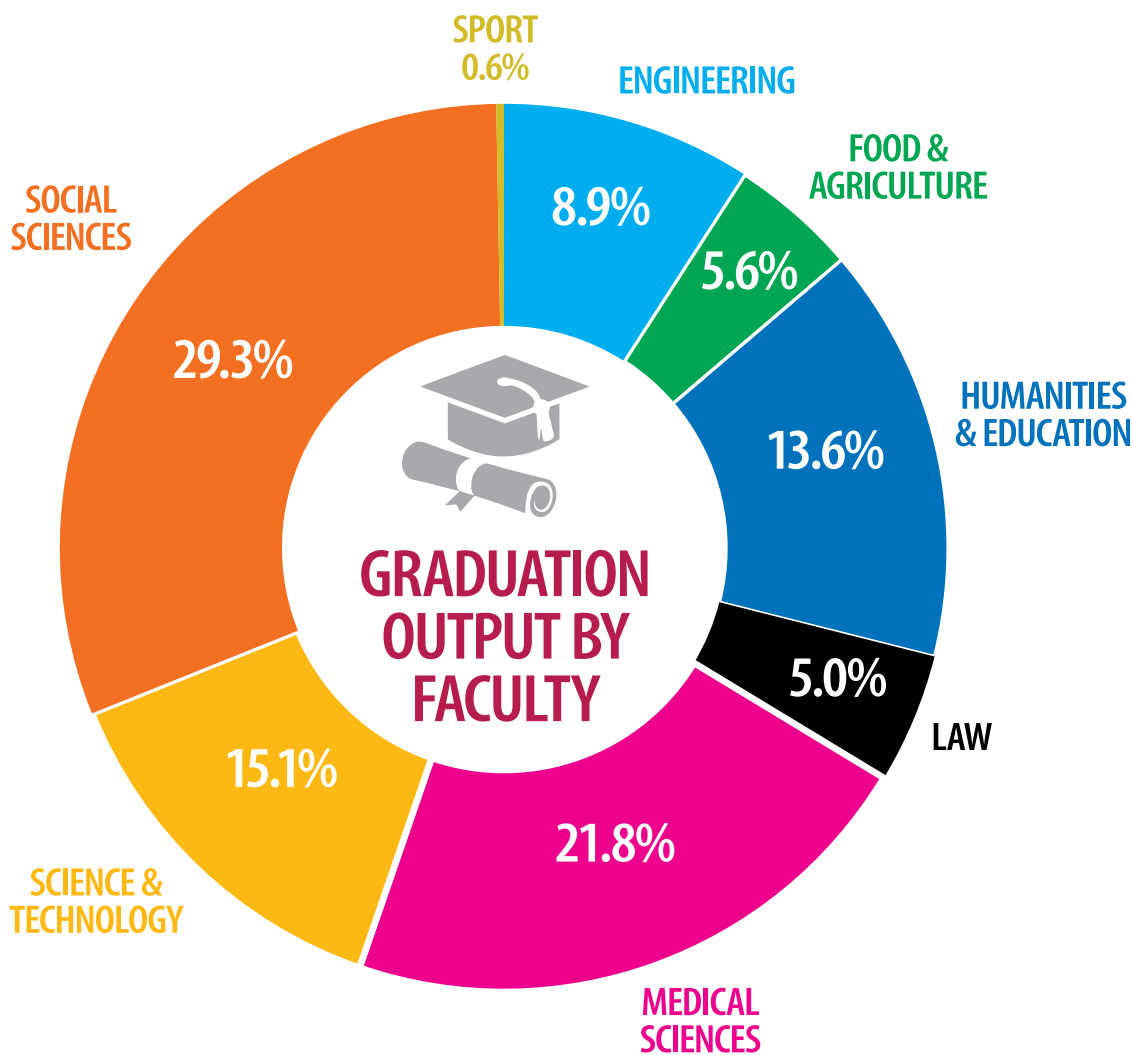
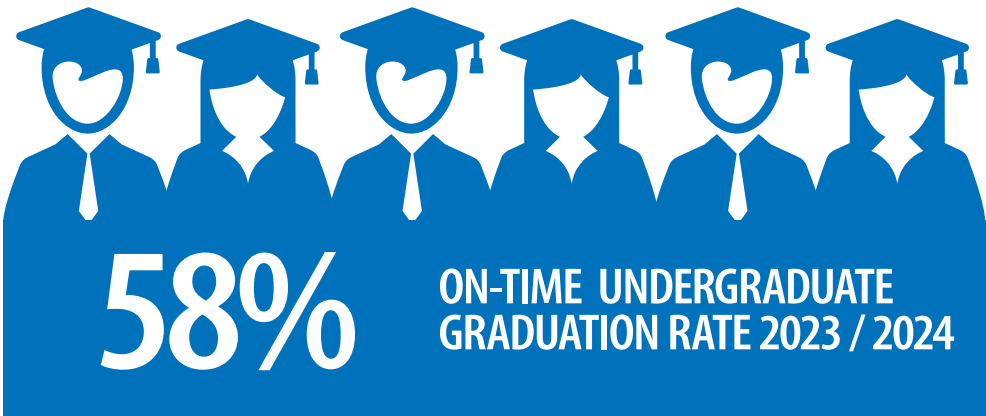


HIGHEST ENROLMENT AMONG REGIONAL (CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES)



HIGHEST ENROLMENT AMONG INTERNATIONAL (NON-CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES)

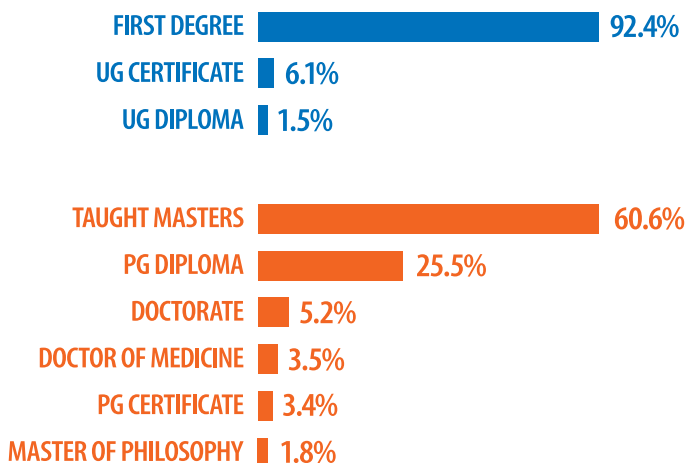
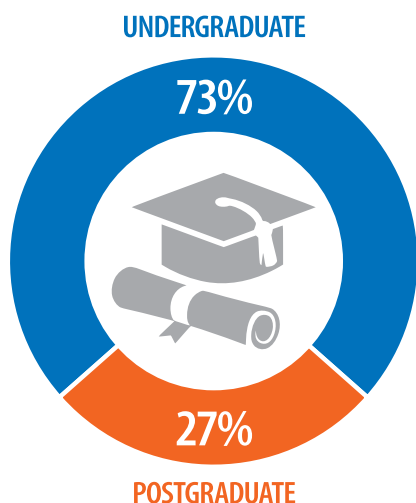

## Section 1: Trends in the Number of Applications, Offers and New Admissions

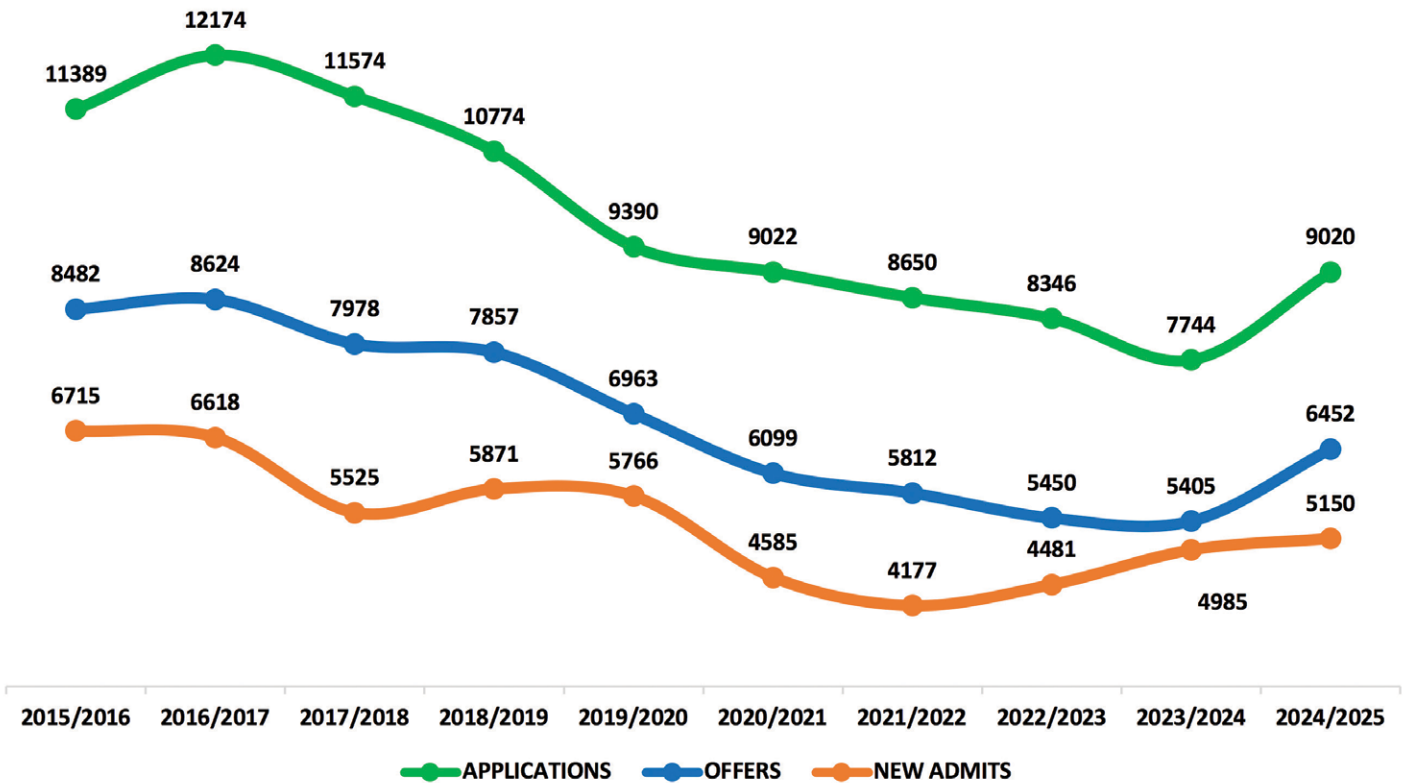
The data below in Figure 1.1 illustrates undergraduate and postgraduate trends for applications, offers and new admissions over a ten-year period. It is observed that over the period 2016/2027 to 2023/2024, there has been a decline in the number of applications of 36%. There has been a notable shift in 2024/2025 where applications increased to 9020 representing an increase of 17% from the previous year. The number of offers has also trended downwards since 2016/2017 from 8,624 to 5,405 representing a 37% decline. Also, the rate of new admissions declined by 37% between the period 2016/2017 and 2021/2022. However, there have been indications of an upward trend over the past two (2) years.

Regarding acceptance rates (Offers/Applications), Figure 1.2 shows fluctuating trends, averaging 70% over the past ten (10) years. There has been a notable decline since 2020/2021 where acceptance rates hovered between 65% and 70% for each year.

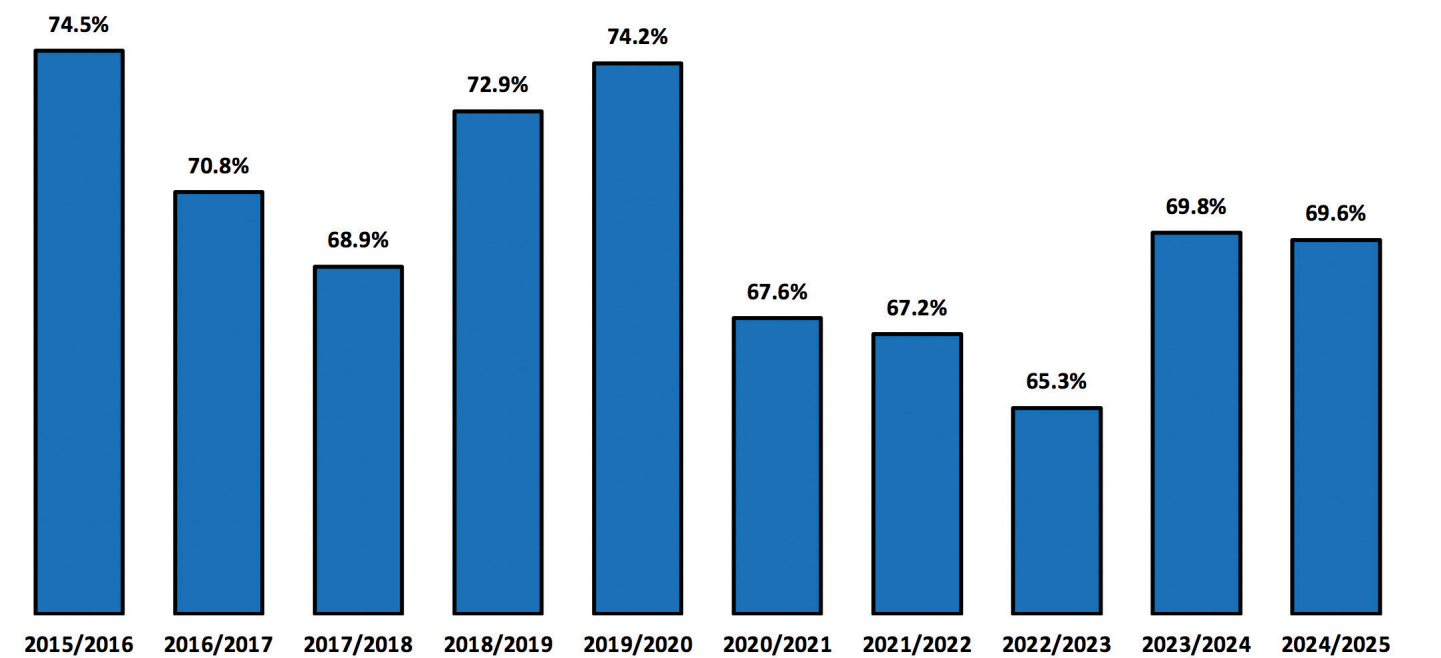
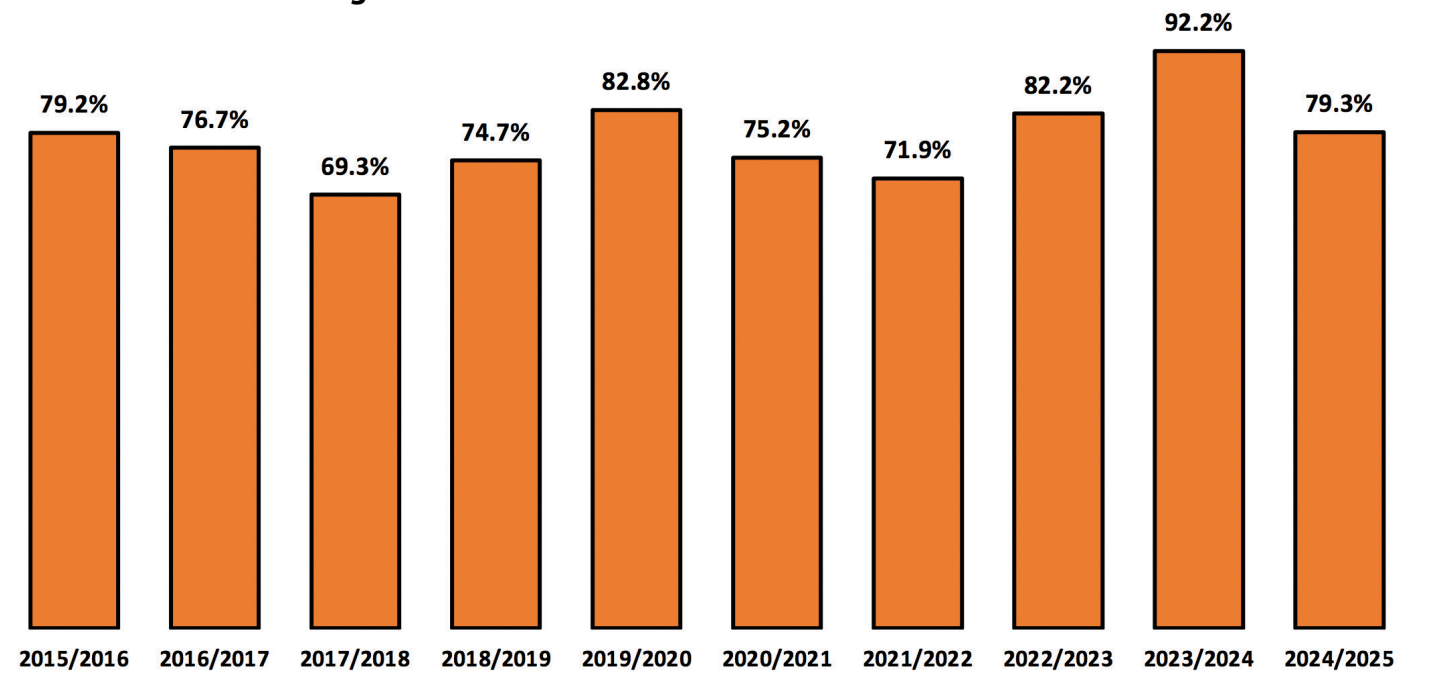


Figure 1.3 Trends in Yield Rates 2015/2016 to 2024/2025

There was a consistent trend in Yield rates (new admissions/offers) as shown in Figure 1.3, with an average of 79% over the ten (10) year period. However, a steady increase of approximately 10% has been observed each year since 2021/2022. This represents an increase in yield rates of 20% between 2021/2022 and 2024/2025.

Figure 1.2 Trends in Acceptance Rates 2015/2016 to 2024/2025

## Section 2: Total Enrolment Trends for UG, PG and Other Students 2019/2020 to 2023/2024

In 2023/2024, the undergraduate and postgraduate population constituted 68% and 25% respectively of total enrolment. In the eight (8) faculties of Engineering, Food & Agriculture, Humanities & Education, Law, Medical Sciences, Science & Technology, Social Sciences and Sport, total student enrolment is representative of new and continuing students at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels, as well as Other students. Other students represent students enrolled in pre-university programmes, summer and undeclared programmes and certificates of achievement.

The data with respect to total enrolment indicates a marginal increase between 2022/2023 and 2023/2024 of 2%. This is attributed to growth at the undergraduate level and other student enrolment. Enrolment at the postgraduate level however, decreased by 6% from the previous year 2022/2023. New student admissions has increased by approximately 13% at the undergraduate level but decreased by 11% at the postgraduate level.

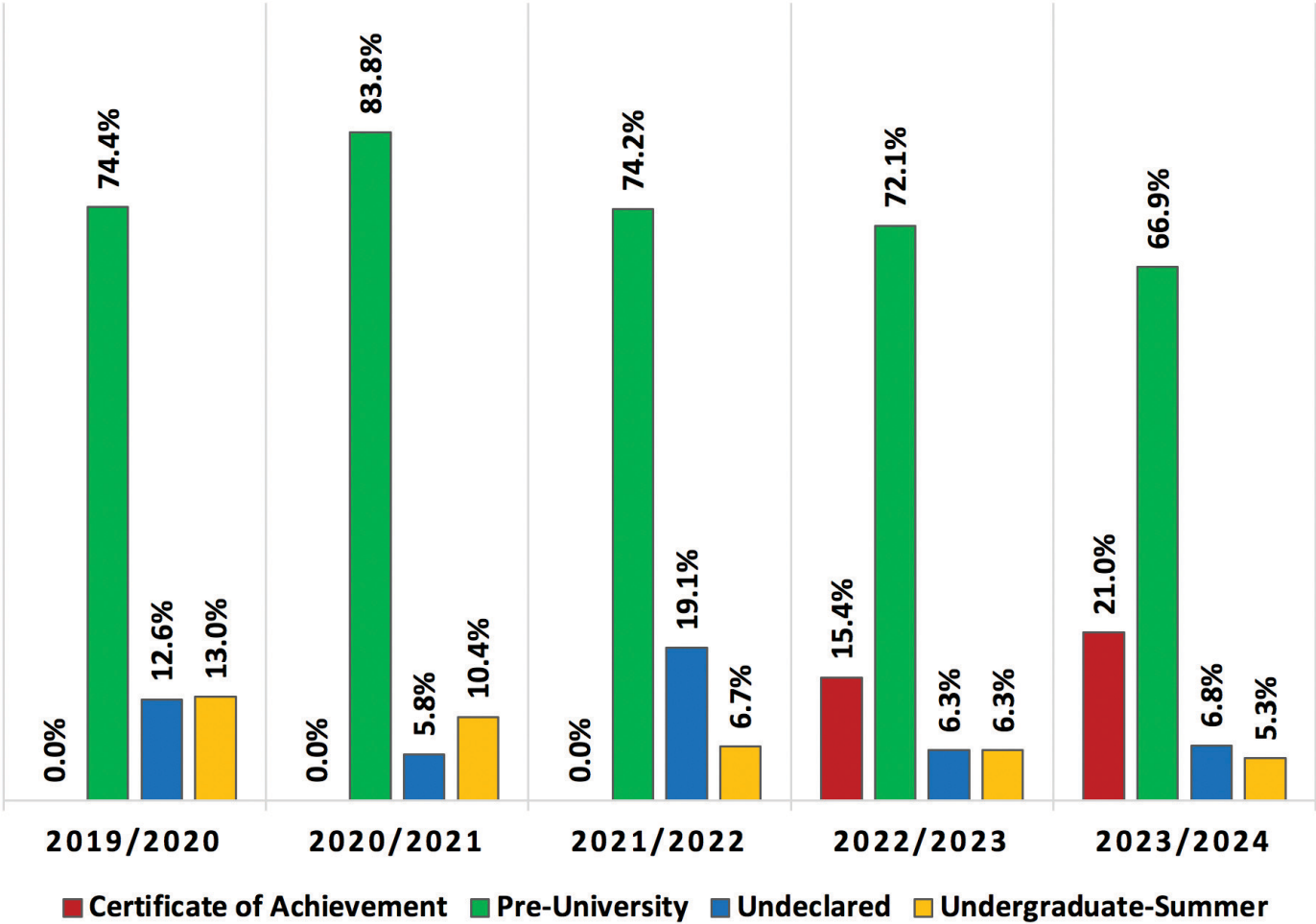

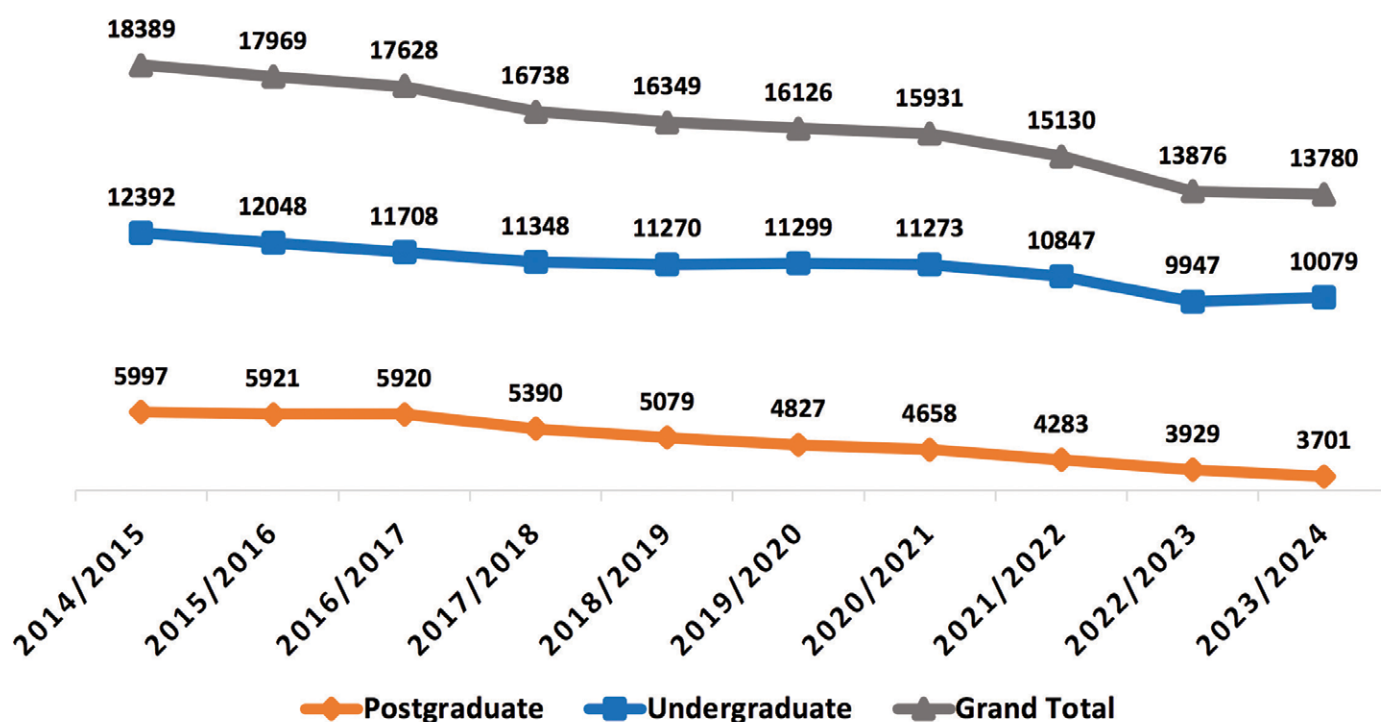

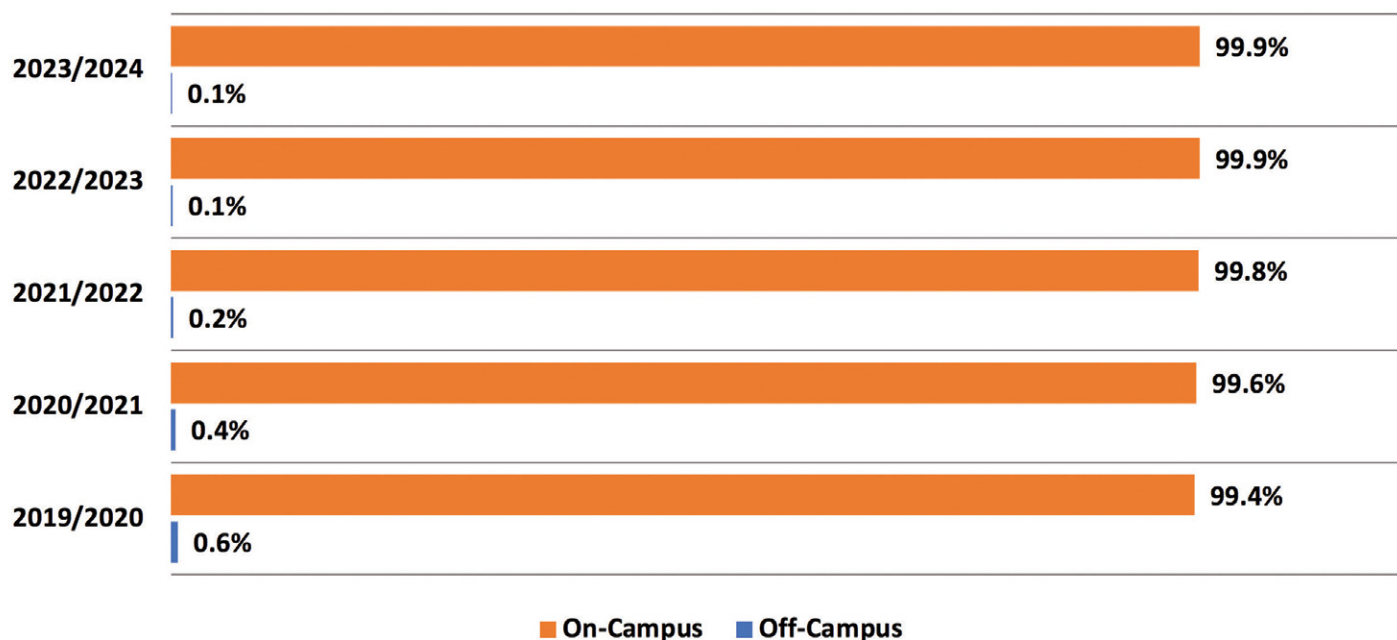
**Figure 3.1: Enrolment Trends for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Students

## Section 4: Student Demographic Trends for UG and PG Students 2019/2020 to 2023/2024

In terms of demographics the trend is consistent where there is a predominance in the female population. In the academic year 2023/2024, approximately 62% are female and 38% are male.

Observing the undergraduate trends, a significant proportion of the undergraduate student population is within the 18 – 24 age group. This group accounts for 89% of the undergraduate new admissions. Also, over the five (5) year period the median age of newly admitted undergraduates was 20 years.

In respect of postgraduate new admissions, over the past five (5) years, there is a smaller proportion of students entering postgraduate studies. Most new entrants are in the 25 – 34 age group with the median age being 33 years old which represents 44% of all new entrants.

In terms of nationality, 93% of the student population were nationals of Trinidad & Tobago, 5% were from the contributing countries, and 2% were from non-contributing countries.

In Table 4.1 below, Total Enrolment includes all undergraduate, postgraduate and other students. All other tables in this section will show analysis for the Undergraduate and Postgraduate student populations only.

Figure 4.1: Postgraduate Enrolment by Age Group at Admission 2019/2020 to 2023/2024

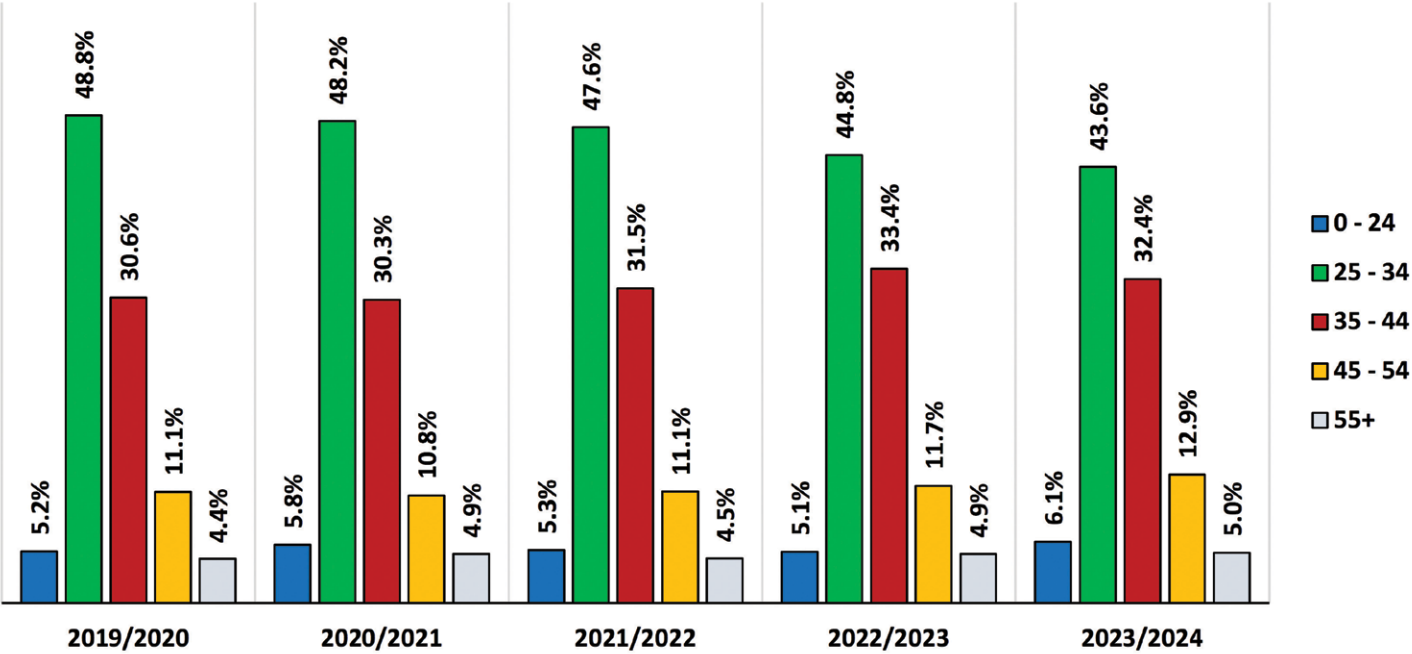
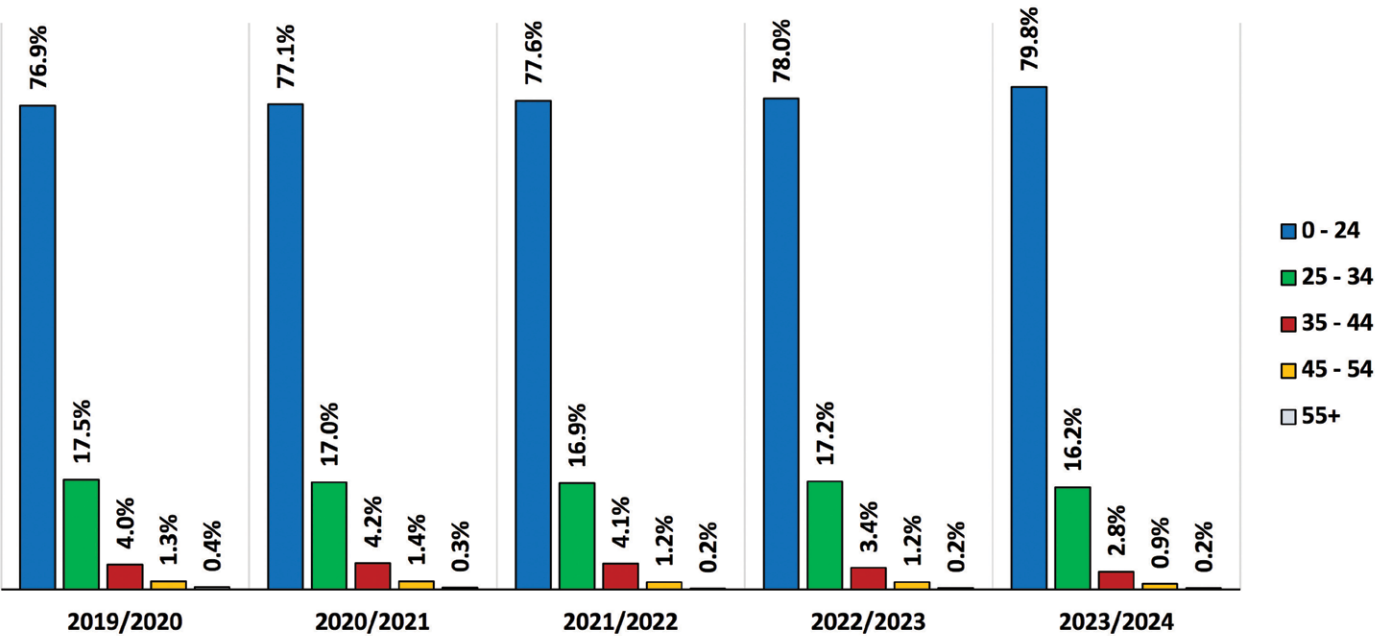


Figure 4.2: Undergraduate Enrolment by Age Group at Admission 2019/2020 to 2023/2024

Figure 4.3: Postgraduate Enrolment by Nationality 2019/2020 to 2023/2024

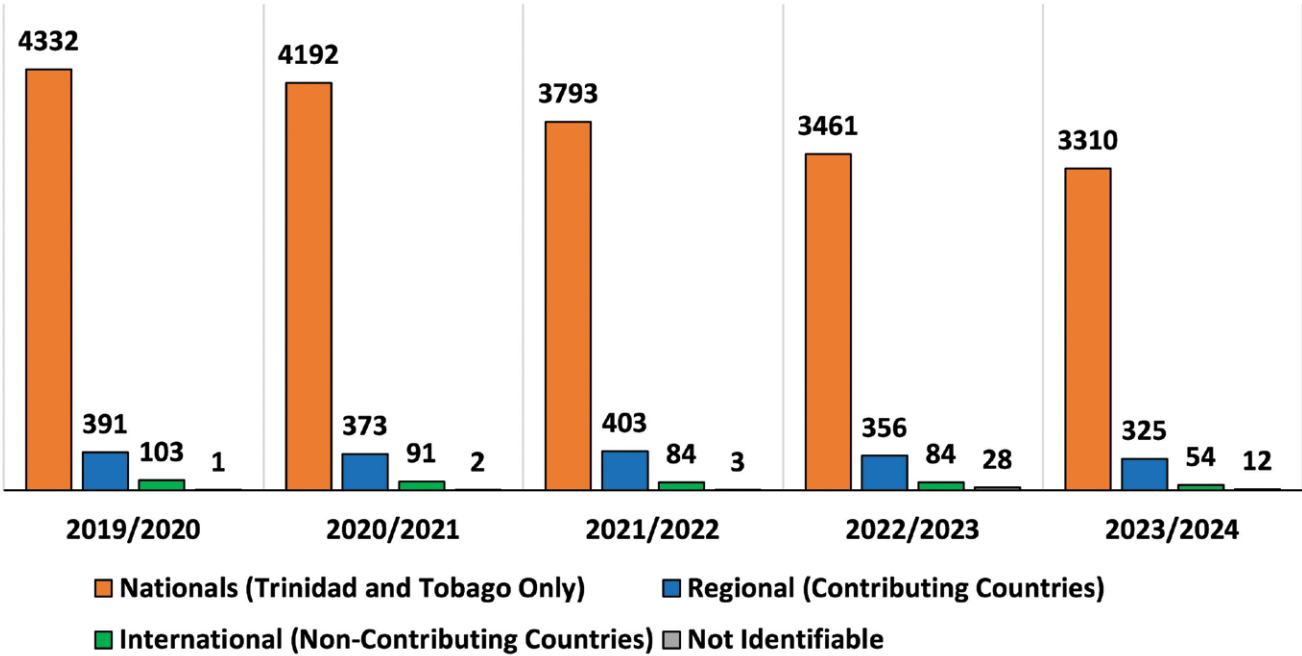
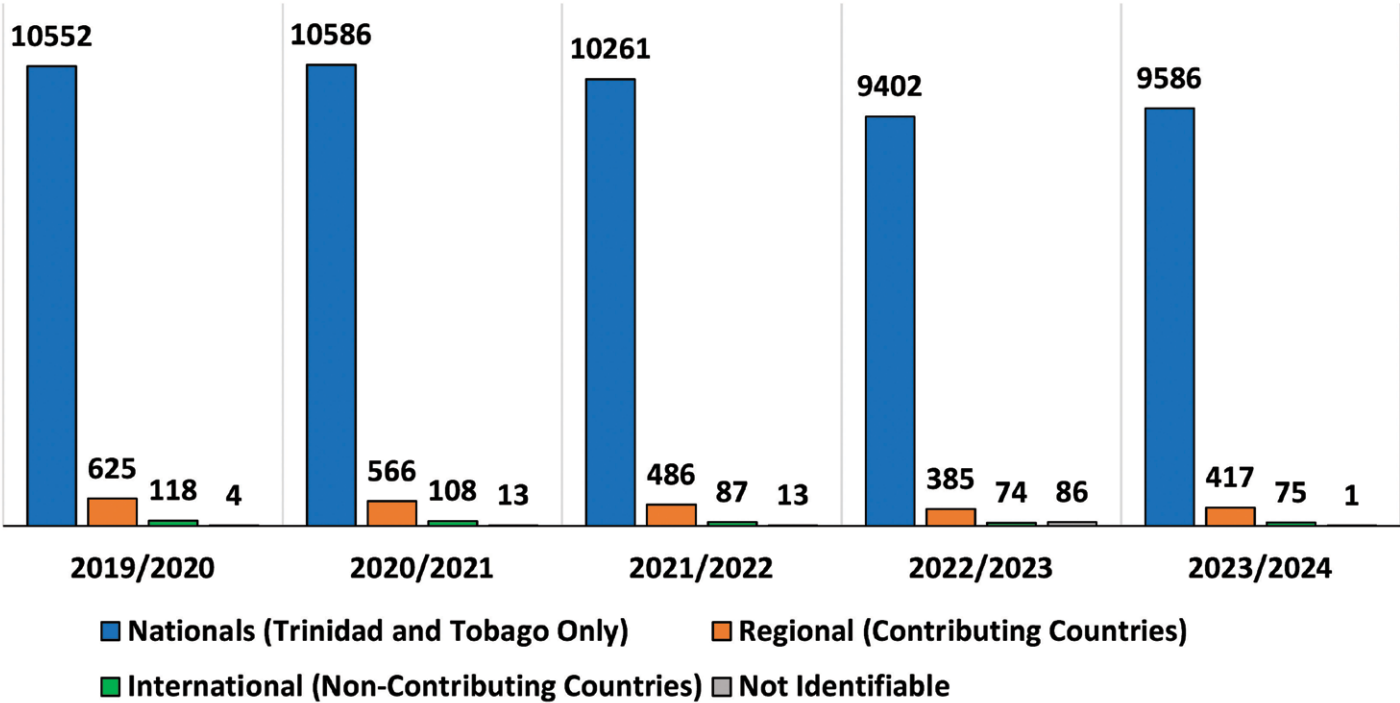


Figure 4.4: Undergraduate Enrolment by Nationality 2019/2020 to 2023/2024

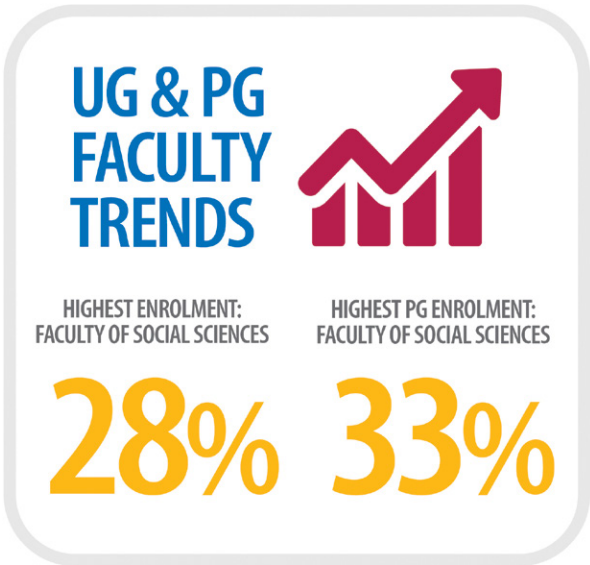

# Section 5: Undergraduate and Postgraduate Faculty Trends 2019/2020 to 2023/2024

Faculty enrolment trends indicated that Social Sciences continued to be the largest faculty, accounting for 28% of the UG & PG student population. The faculties which followed were Medical Sciences and Science & Technology at 22% and 19% respectively. In the academic year 2023/2024, the highest proportion of Postgraduate enrolment was in the Faculty of Social Sciences (33%) including those enrolled in the Arthur Lok Jack Global School of Business. The Faculty of Humanities and Education had the second highest postgraduate enrolment (19%), followed by the Faculty of Engineering (15%).

Between 2019/2020 and 2023/2024, the faculties of Social Sciences and Food and Agriculture have experienced the most significant decline in enrolment of 26% and 25% respectively. Moreover, at the postgraduate level, the faculties of Social Sciences and Engineering experienced the highest decline in enrolment of 36% and 28% respectively.

Figure 5.1: Postgraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2019/2020 to 2023/2024

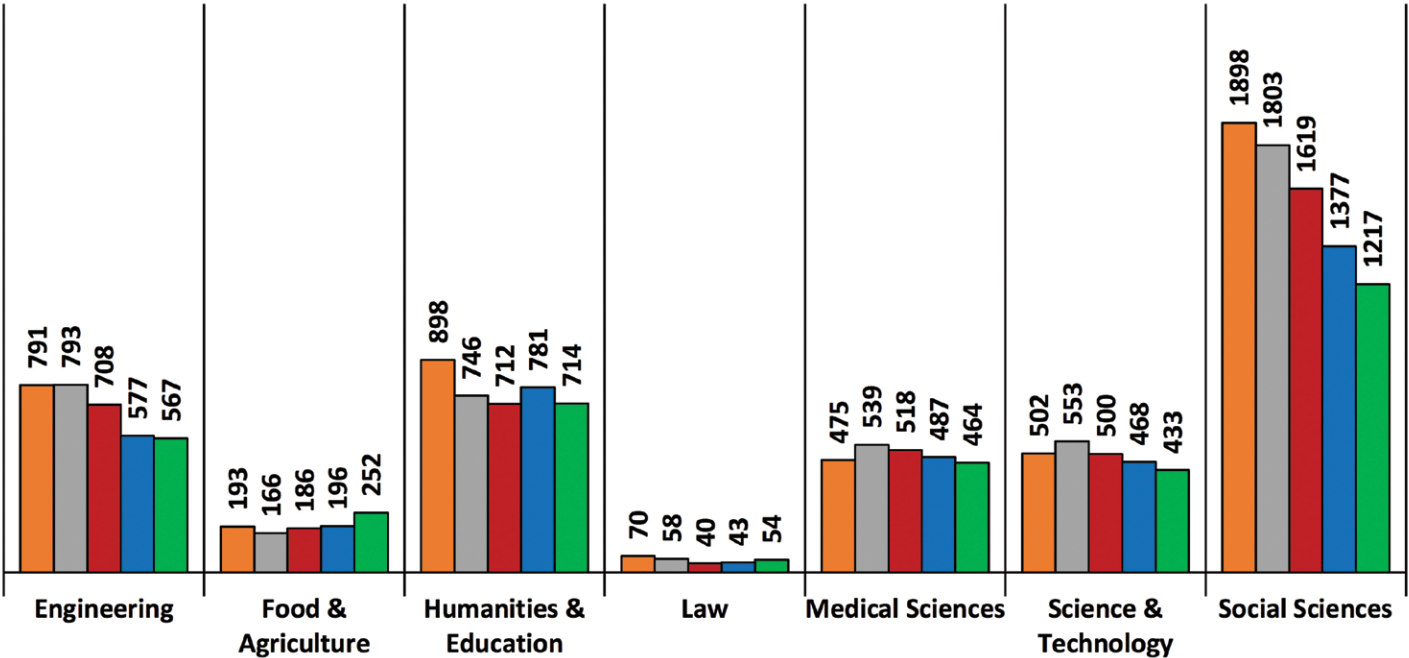
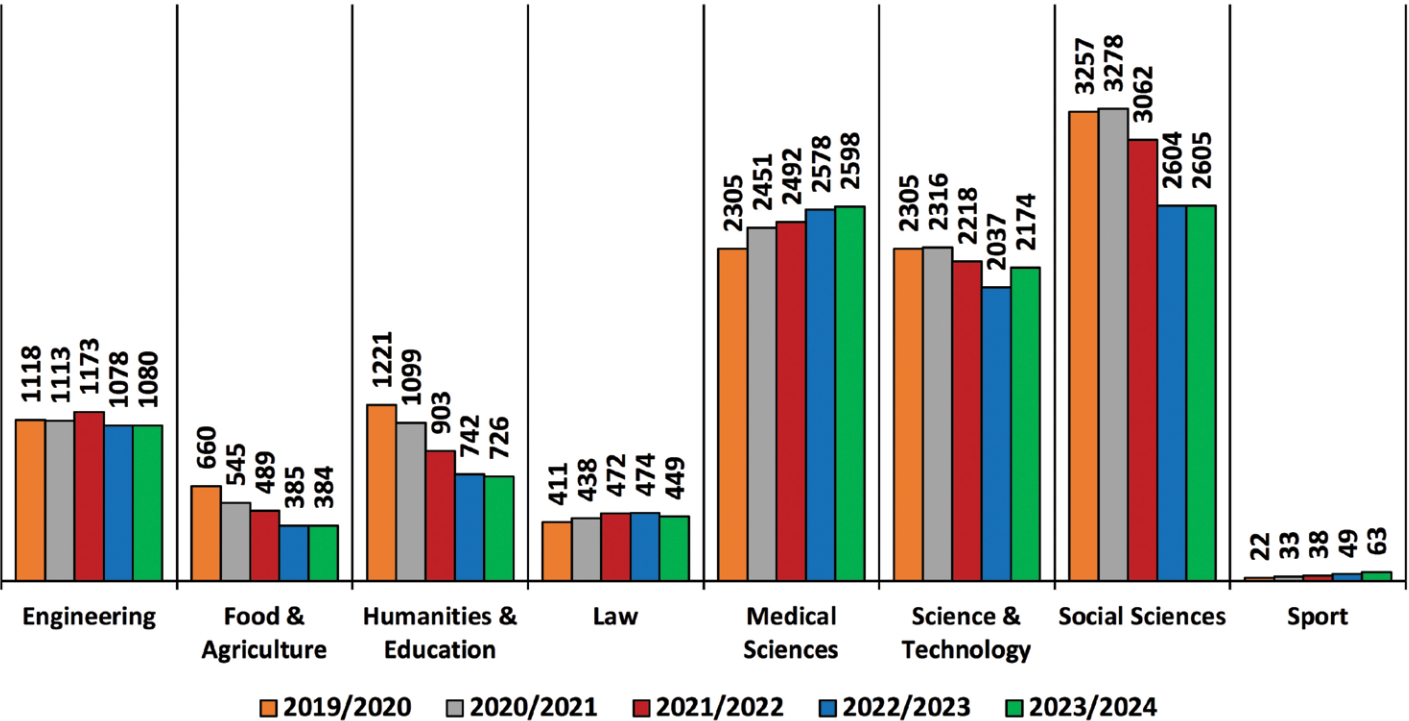


Figure 5.2: Undergraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2018/2019 to 2022/2023

## Section 6: Undergraduate and Postgraduate Graduation Trends

This section provides data on graduate output in respect of demographics, faculty, degree honours and graduate throughput. A total of 3278 persons graduated in 2023/2024 with 73% and 27% at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels respectively. This represented a decline in the number of graduates when compared to 3591 in 2022/2023.

Of the degrees awarded in 2023/2024, 67% were first degree graduates and 19% were higher degree graduates. This represents a decrease of approximately 5% and 18% in the proportion of graduates with first degrees and higher degrees respectively, when compared to 2022/2023.

The highest number of degrees were awarded at the undergraduate level in the following programmes: MBBS Medicine & Surgery, Bachelor of Law, BSc. Management Studies, BSc. Psychology and BSc. Pharmacy. At the postgraduate level, graduates were mainly awarded taught masters degrees in the following programmes: MBA Business Administration, LLM Law, MSc Strategic Leadership & Innovation, MA Speech-Language Pathology, MSc Project Management.

Figure 6.1: Graduation Trends for UG and PG Student 2014/2015 to 2023/2024

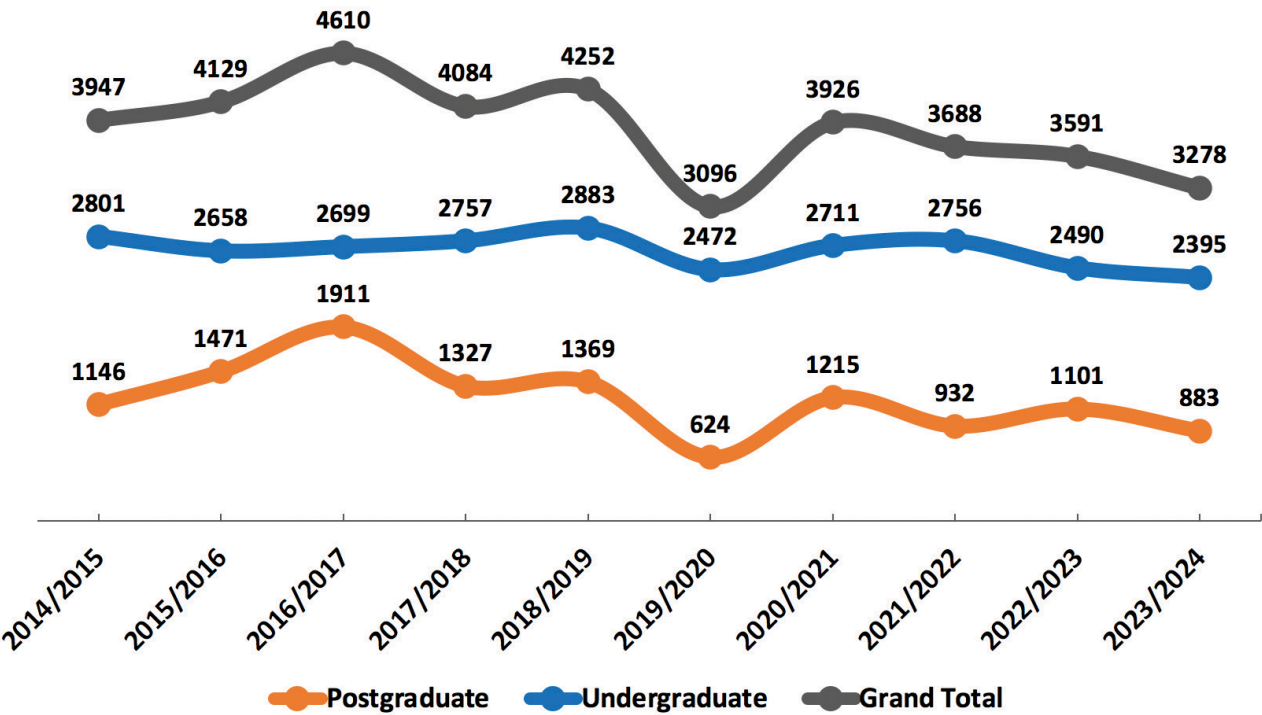
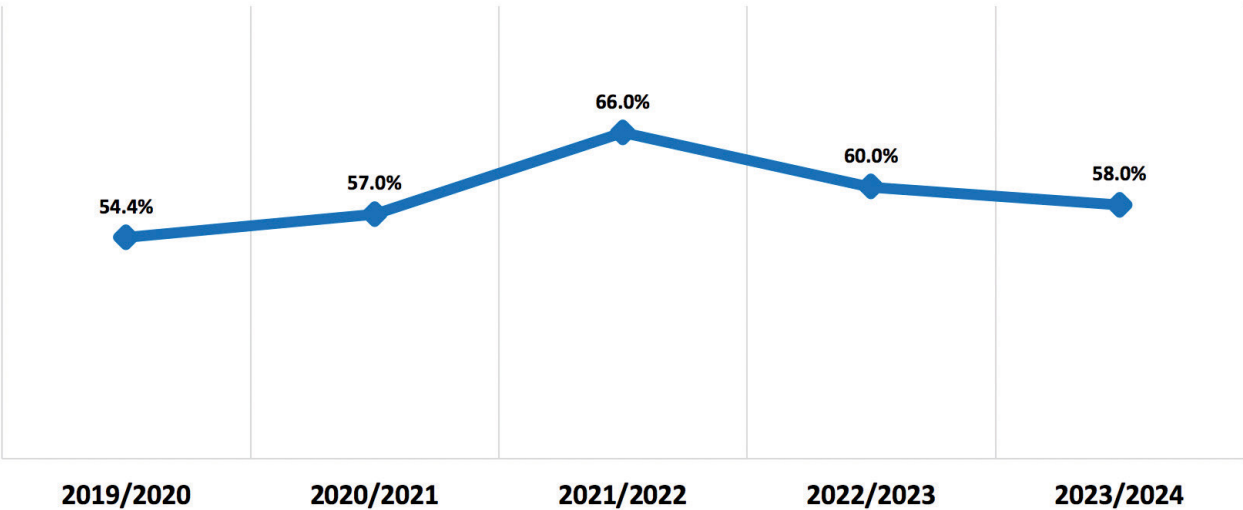


Figure 6.2: UG On-time Graduation Rate 2019/2020 to 2023/2024

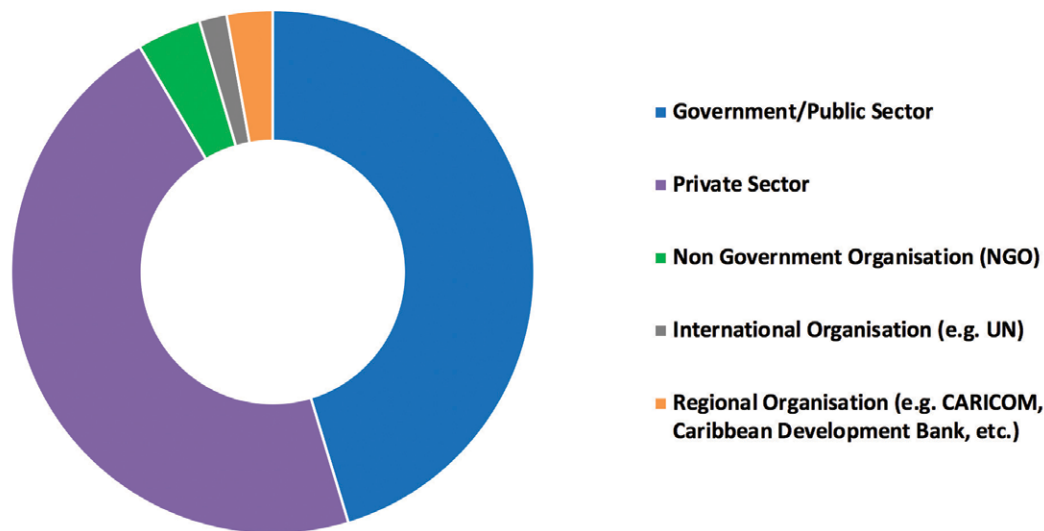

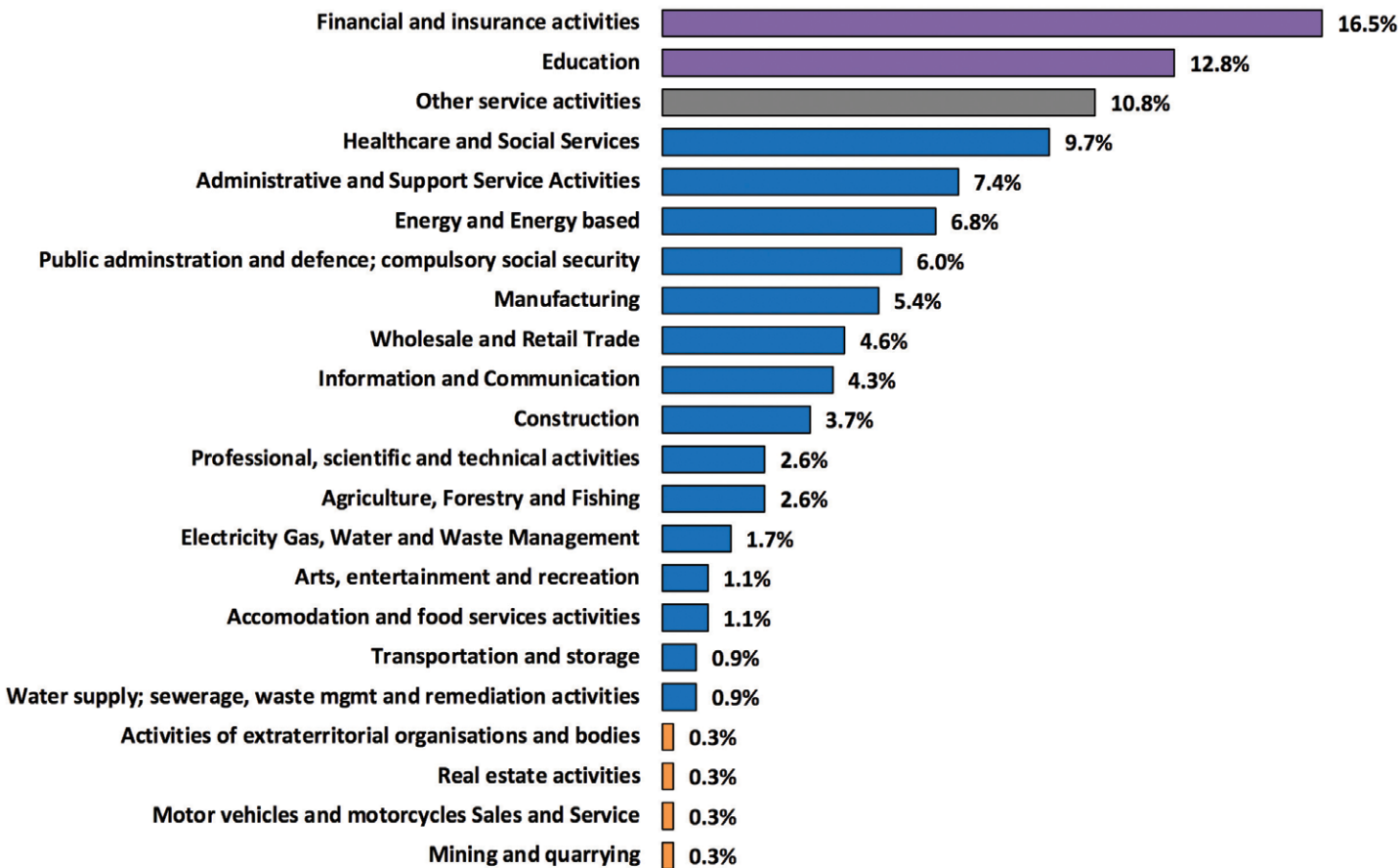

Figure 6.5: UG Respondents’ Mean Time to Find Employment (in Months) 2022/2023

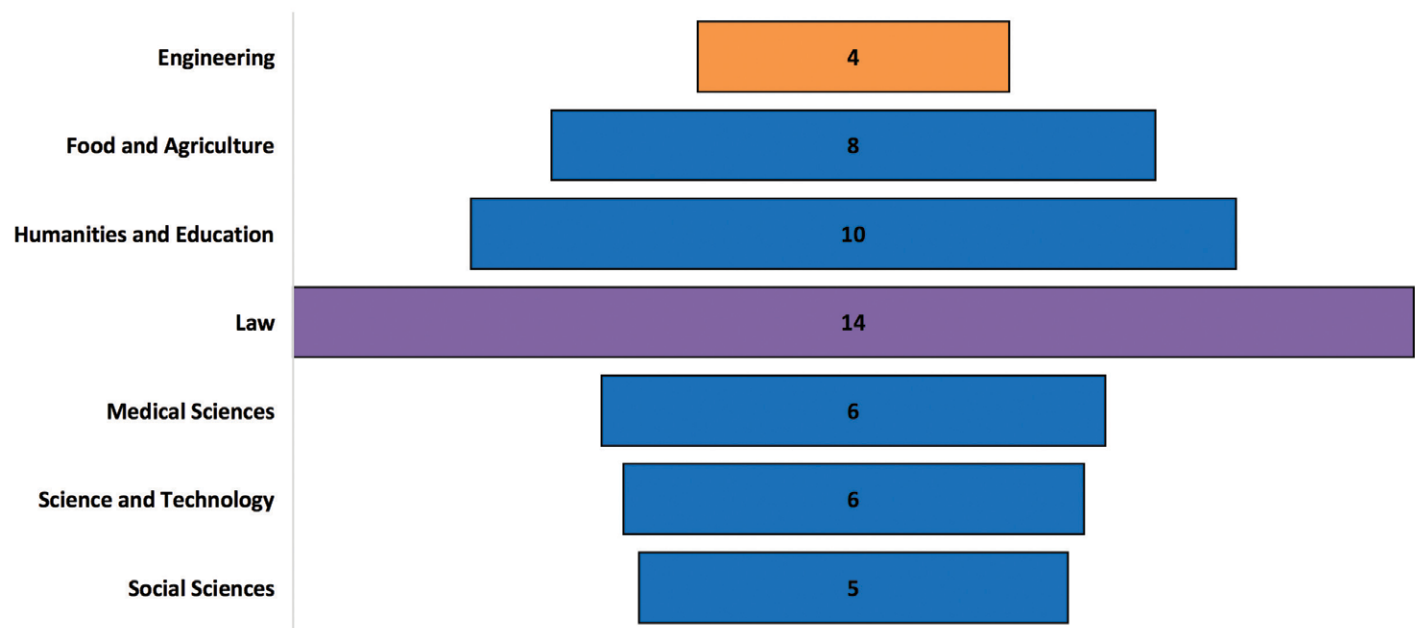
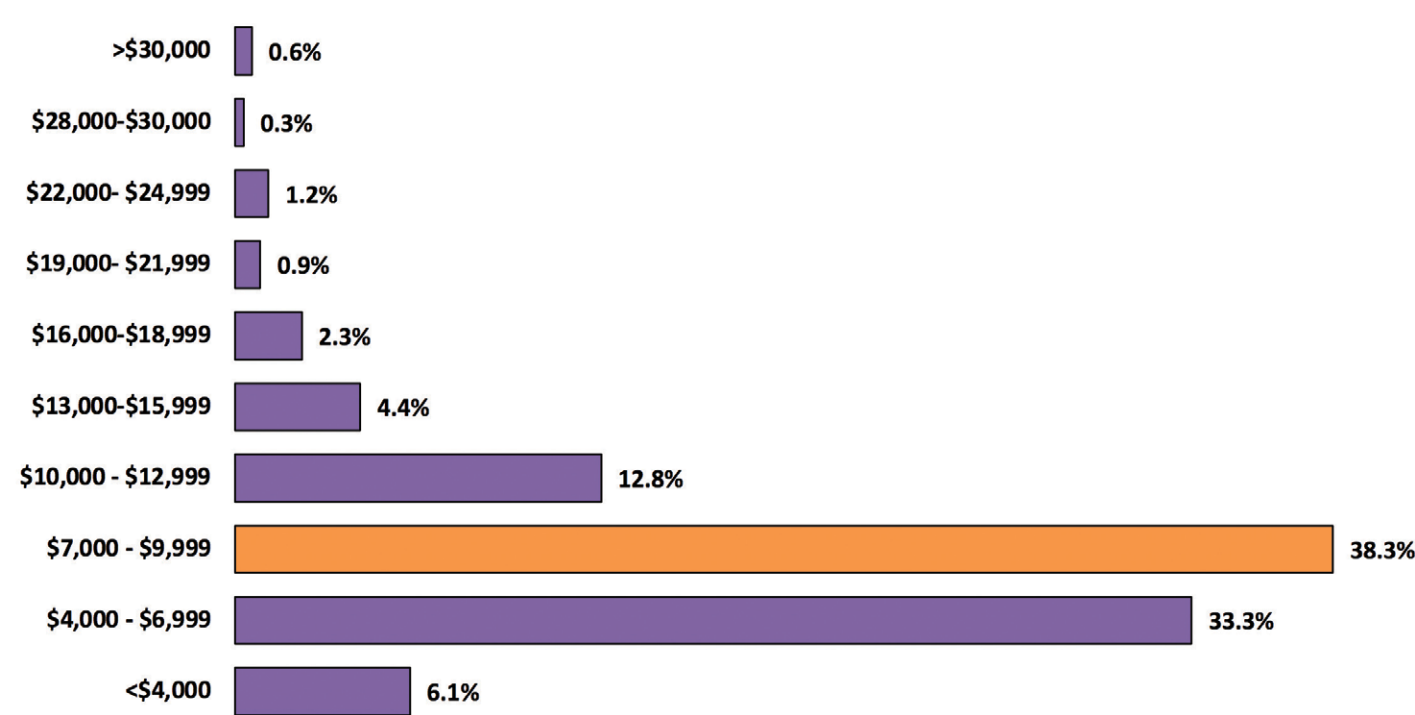


Figure 6.6: UG Respondents’ Salary Range (TT\$) for 2022/2023
