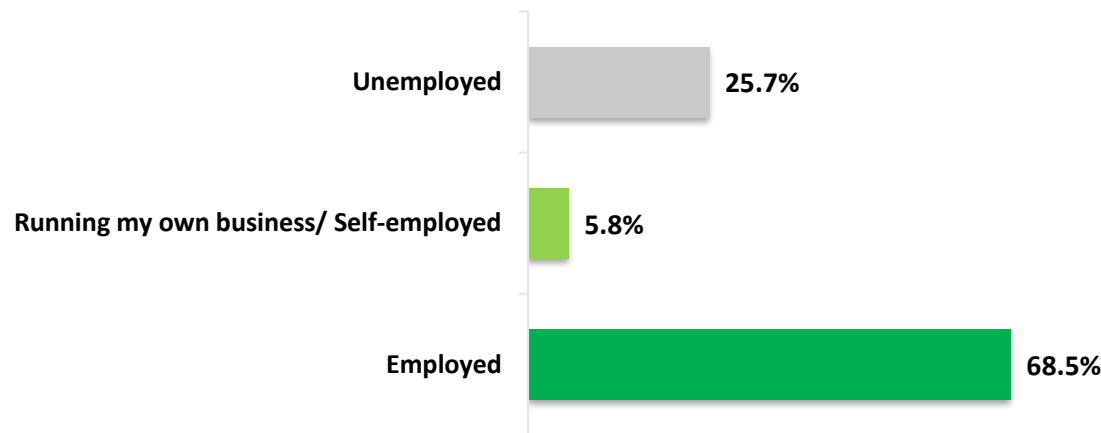
### Graduate Tracer Survey 2022/2023 Highlights

The charts below represent an excerpt from the Graduate Tracer Survey (GTS) 2022/23. The GTS is an annual survey conducted by the Campus Office of Planning and Institutional Research on first degree graduates one year after graduating from The UWI. The study analyses the feedback received on the experience of the graduate in relation to their employment outcomes and their UWI programme and attempts to observe trends on the Institution’s capacity to prepare the distinctive UWI graduate. The survey was responded to by 35% of graduates from the undergraduate class.

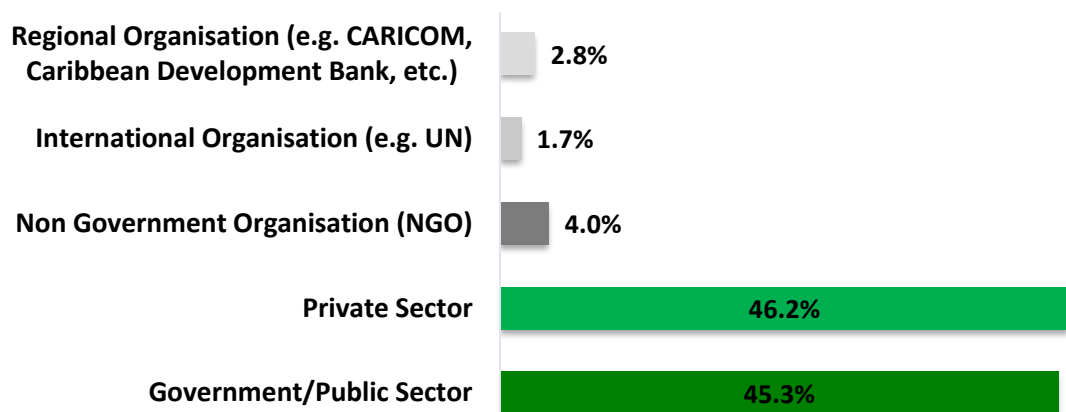
For the 2022/2023 period, survey findings showed that graduate employment was 68.5%, this was a 6.7% increase from the survey of 2020/2021 where the employment was 61.8%. An estimated 25.7% of the respondents reported being unemployed, with the main reasons for unemployment being the pursuit of further studies and lack of work experience.

Approximately 46% of the graduates surveyed reported that they were employed in the private sector and 45% in the public sector. The main areas of employment activity are in the fields of Financial and Insurance activities and Education in 2022/2023. Most of the respondents (42.6%) were employed in the job category of Professional and/or Research Staff. An estimated seventy eight percent (78%) of respondents earned a monthly salary less than \$10,000 and approximately 22% earned \$10,000 and above, with average time taken to find employment being approximately seven months.

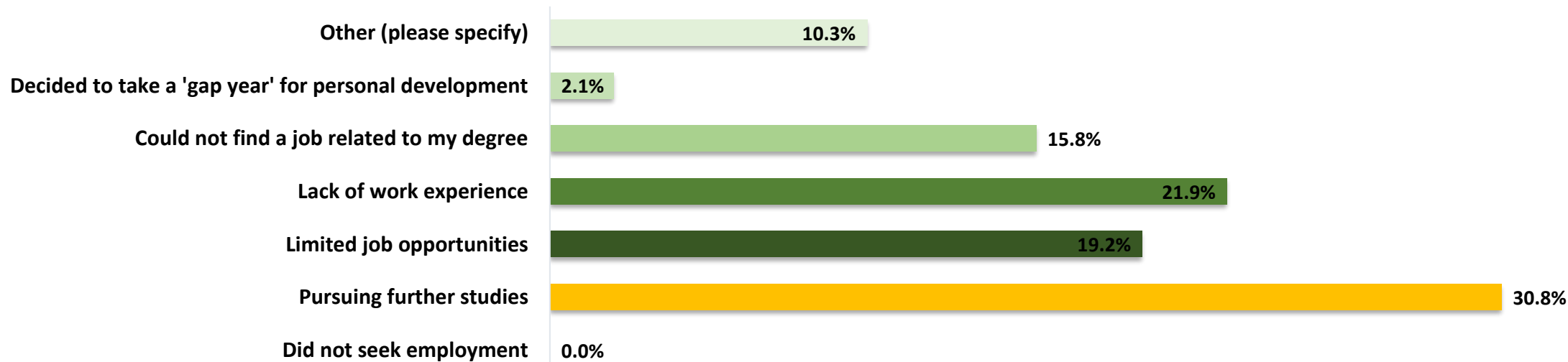
#### Graduates Employment Status



#### Graduates Sector of Employment

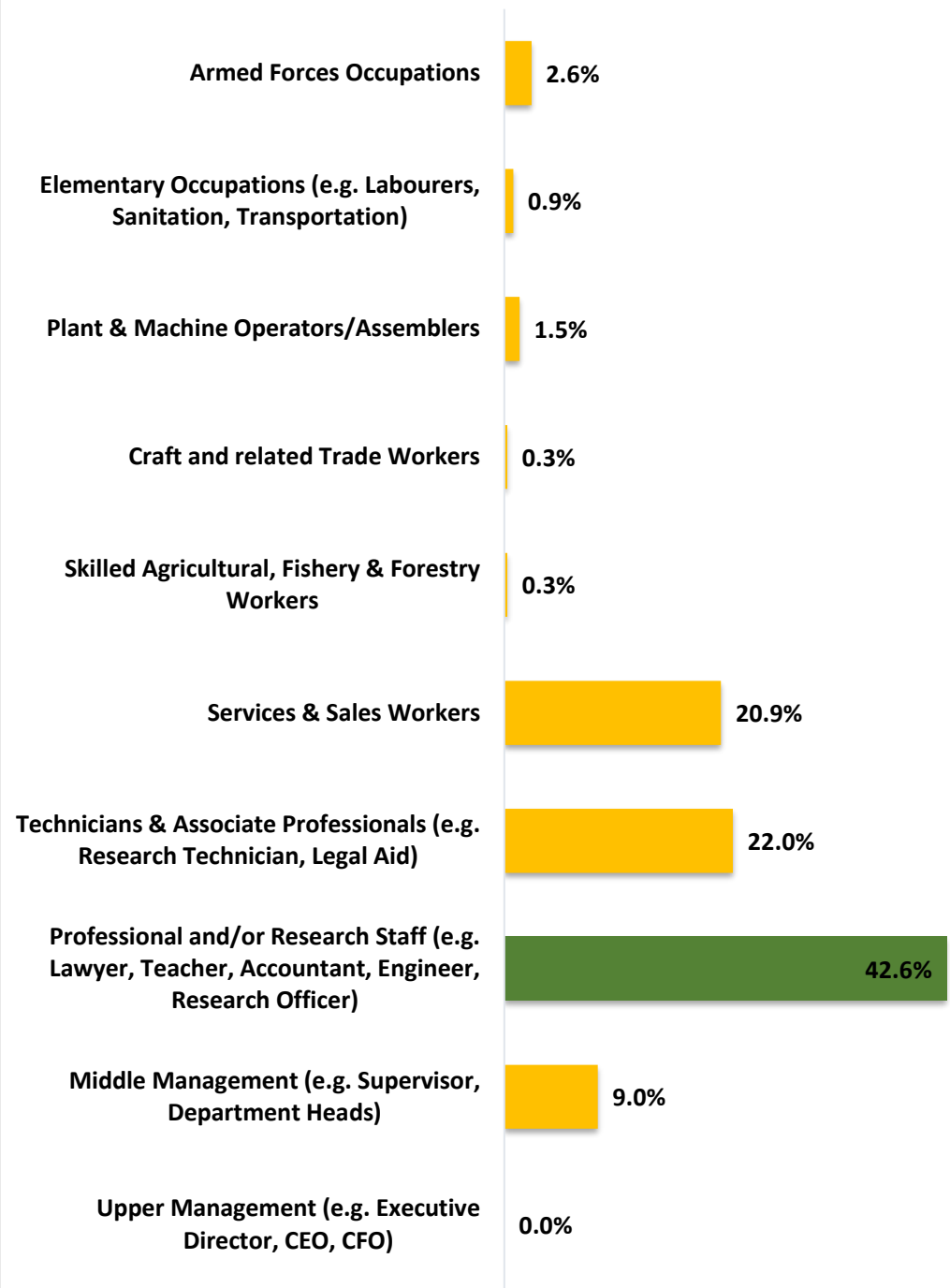


#### Graduates Reason for Unemployment

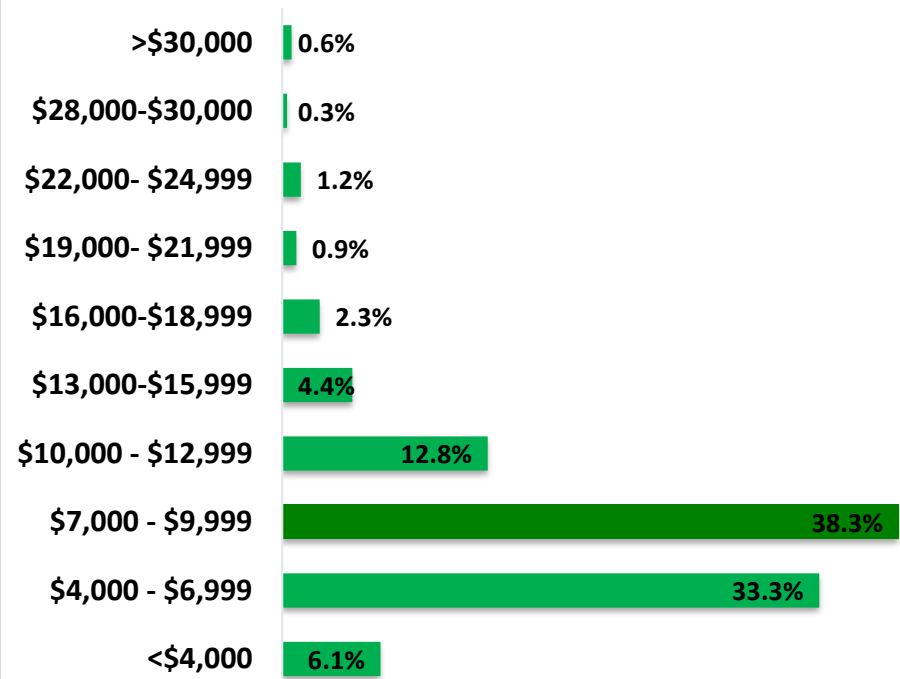
