The information listed below must be included in each submission.

- 1. **Title:** The submission title should be entered in Title Case and be short and specific. The submissiontitle has a character limit of 150 characters, not including spaces.
- Presenting Author Academic Level: The academic level of the presenting author must be indicated.
- 3. **Author Information**: First name followed by surname and academic qualification. Where there are multiple authors, the name of the presenting author should be underlined. The email addresses of all authors should be listed

4. Thematic Track for consideration:

Thematic track: Submitters must indicate the track for their submission:

- i. Consumer practice and perception with implications for food safety and health.
- ii. Climate resilience agricultural practices
- iii. Regional farm-led agricultural practices
- 5. **Body of the abstract:** Submissions must include the following Background, Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions, and Funding Sources. The abstract body has a maximum word count of 300 words.
- 6. The provided abstract template must be used for all submissions.
- 7. Please type your document using Times New Roman, size 11pt.
