



ONLINE COURSE REGISTRATION FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

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1. What courses are currently on offer?

All courses are subject to minimum student enrolments. Our language courses for this semester are:

- Chinese Levels 1A, 2A, 2B, 3A
- French Levels 1A, 1B, 2A, 3A
- Japanese Levels 1A, 1B, 2A, 3A
- Portuguese Levels 1A, 2A
- Spanish Levels 1A, 1B, 2A, 2B, 3A
- Yoruba Levels 1A, 2B

2. What are the pre-requisites for the language courses?

- There are no pre-requisites to enter the first part of Level 1 courses, e.g.: Level 1A Chinese, Level 1A Spanish, etc.
- Students wishing to register for the second course in a level or a course at a higher level must have successfully completed the preceding course.
 - o Example 1: to register for Level 1B Chinese a student must have successfully completed Level 1A Chinese.
 - Example 2: to register for Level 3A French a student must have successfully completed Level 2B French.

3. When does registration for this semester end?

• Registration ends on August 30th 2024.

4. What are the dates for this semester?

• Classes will take place during the period **September 2**nd – **November 30**th **2024**.

5. Can I do more than one course?

• Yes, depending on the semester and the level for which you are registering.

6. Can I do levels A and B of the same language course?

• No.

7. Can the course for which I am registering be cancelled?

• Yes, class offerings are subject to demand. If an insufficient number of students register for a particular course, this course will be cancelled.

8. How can I choose my course level?

9. What fees do I have to pay?

- All courses are subject to a <u>TT\$75.00*</u> non-refundable registration fee, in addition to the cost of tuition (which varies according to student status) and course textbooks.
- The following fees apply to language courses offered this semester:
 - o UWI St. Augustine students TT\$775.00
 - o UWI St. Augustine staff TT\$475.00
 - o Member of the Public TT\$775.00
 - \circ 60+ TT\$575.00

10. How soon do I have to pay tuition fees?

- After receiving payment instructions, you will have **1 business day** to pay tuition fees.
- Course fees **do not** include the cost of textbooks.

11. Where do I pay tuition fees?

• Fees can be paid online via credit card, subject to a 2.5% surcharge; via direct transfer through online banking; or direct deposit at a local bank. Send an email to CLL.FHE@sta.uwi.edu to request payment instructions.

12. Do I have to purchase my textbook(s) when I pay tuition fees?
