To all UWI-registered students interested in teaching English in France in 2020-2021

The French Ministry of Education invites UWI students currently in their second or third academic year to apply for an English Assistant position to teach in a primary or secondary school, in Metropolitan France or French Guyana, for 7 to 9 months in the Academic Year 2020-2021 (October 1st 2020-April 30th 2021).

Pay particular attention to the required Language Competence Level (a minimum of B1 is compulsory to apply – explanation on the link). You need to be between 20 and 35 years-old and a citizen of either Trinidad and Tobago, Barbados OR one of the OECS countries and studying in St Augustine).

Students eligible to apply can send a declaration of interest accompanied by a detailed CV (NOT the application forms - those will have to be delivered to the Alliance Française of Port-of-Spain after the UWI selection process is complete) to the following address assistantsinfrance@gmail.com and students will then be contacted individually if necessary.

Please also attach a letter of financial support/commitment from your family that will guarantee that you will leave with enough money (the equivalent of TT\$20,000) on a credit card to support yourselves until your first salary is paid.
