This is a blended part-time programme. Classes are scheduled at The UWI campus at St. Augustine from September 2025 to May 2026 in face-to-face and online modes, three evenings per week and on 10 Fridays during the school term. Successful applicants must have reliable high speed Internet access.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must satisfy the general University Regulations governing admission to a Higher Degree and,

- must possess at least a first degree in a relevant area
- must be practising teachers at a secondary school for at least two years.
- must NOT be currently enrolled in a postgraduate programme or awaiting final award of a degree by the deadline date.

In addition to general mandatory postgraduate documents, all applications must be accompanied by ALL of the following:

- Principal's Release and Principal's Referee forms (Visit admission link below)
- a copy of the Ministry of Education's assessment letter.
- a letter of appointment from the applicant's employer.
