

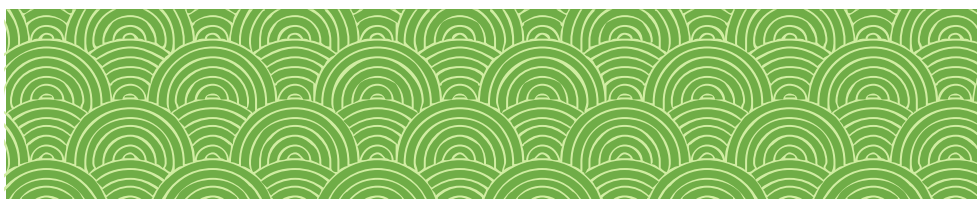
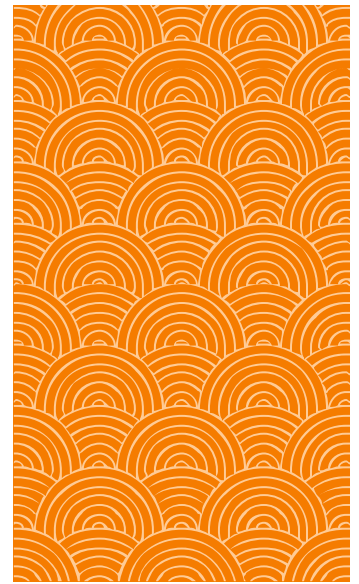

ESSAY COMPETITION

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS: Friday 23rd February 2018.

Primary Level

- **Essay question: “A day in the life of a Trade Unionist.”**
- Standards 1 to 3 → **75 – 100 words.** Standards 4 and 5 → **200-300 words.**
 - Handwritten (pen or pencil) or typed would be accepted
 - If typed - Times New Roman Font, size 12, Double Spaced.

Secondary Level

Forms 1 to 3 → **Essay question: “The role of religion in Trinidad and Tobago”**
Approximately 500 to 800 words

- Typed - Times New Roman Font, size 12, Double Spaced.

Forms 4 to 6 → **Essay question: “To what extent has The University of the West Indies contributed to the development of Caribbean history?”**

Approximately 800 to 1000 words

Typed - Times New Roman Font, size 12, Double Spaced.

PRIZES:

- **Attractive prizes** in the form of **cash, vouchers** and **books** are to be won by the top three performing students in each category
- Special prize for the teacher of the winning student and the school submitting the most entries.
- Essays can be submitted in **hardcopy to the History Office, Department of History**, Faculty of Humanities and Education, The UWI, St. Augustine no later than Friday 23rd February 2018 at 3pm. **Soft copies can be submitted via email to historyfestuwi@gmail.com**

Broad theme – Religion, Education, Empowerment

Guidelines:

- Must be the student's original composition
 - Dialect can be included
 - Historical content
- The piece would be performed on the day of the competition.
- Pieces can either be performed from memory or with written aid.

Primary level: 2 – 4 minutes. Secondary level: 3 – 6 minutes.

- All entries must have a cover page with the following clearly printed:
School's name, Student's name, Student's age, Class, School and/or teacher's email address, School's contact number.
