WHAT IS A DEAN'S HOLD?

- If your GPA falls **below 2.0** in a Semester, a **Dean's Hold** is placed on your record.
- You are then placed on **Academic Warning** in the next semester.
- If your GPA remains **below 2.0 for two consecutive semesters**, you will be placed on **RTW (Required to Withdraw)** and must sit out for one year.
- You must apply for readmission when applications reopen.
- To appeal the RTW, complete the appeal form and submit it for consideration.
