Why intern at the Organization of American States (OAS)?

The OAS is the main political forum of the region that promotes and supports democracy, human rights, security and integral development in the Americas. The OAS seeks to prevent conflicts and to bring political stability, social inclusion and prosperity to the region through dialogue and collective action.

Requirements to Apply

- Have a minimum grade average of 3.0 out of 4 on an American scale or equivalent, depending on the country
- Students and professionals may apply. However, those who are students must at least have completed their second year of undergraduate studies
- Master two of the four official languages of the OAS (Spanish, French, English and Portuguese)
For Country Offices you must speak at least the language of the office you are applying to

Documents to Apply

- Electronic Application Form, available in our website during the applications period
You may separately apply for the internship at Headquarters (Washington, DC) and Country Offices
- Official transcripts issued by your university
- Resume with Cover letter

Applications and supporting documents will be received through our website until September 16, 23:59 EST (Washington, D.C. time)
