

COURSE TITLE: ENTREPRENEURIAL LEADERSHIP (SLIN 6004)

SEMESTER 2 (JANUARY - MAY)

NO. OF CREDITS: 4

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Entrepreneurial Leadership is a relevant and modern course that exposes participants to the theory of entrepreneurial leadership and will build competencies in adopting an entrepreneurial approach to solve organizational challenges. The students will also be exploring business model innovation as a means of implementing change in the areas of market share, technology and operations. Therefore, the entrepreneurial leadership skills developed will feed directly into organizational innovation and change.

NO. OF CREDITS: 4

Who can do MAP
Programmes
(also referred to as
Specially Admitted)?

To be considered as a Specially Admitted student, applicants for graduate courses should normally possess an undergraduate degree, but due consideration will be given to maturity, work experience and previous study in the absence of an undergraduate degree.

Will I receive credits for doing these courses in the MAP Programme?

Yes. Once you register for the course and successfully complete the course assessments, the credits will be recorded on your UWI transcript

How many courses can I do under the MAP Programme?

Normally, a specially admitted student should be allowed to take no more than (12) credits in any given year, nor more than a total of 24 credits under this category of registration.

Can I use these MAP courses towards completing a degree at a later date?

Yes. Specially Admitted students may use not more than nine (9) credits from any particular programme towards UWI certification.

How do I apply for the MAP Programme?

We will invite you to complete the formal online application. When you complete the online form and upload all supporting documents (CV Required) based on the prerequisite requirements for the course.
