The Department of Mathematics and Statistics, UWI, St. Augustine, has begun a collaborative research project with the National Insurance Board of Trinidad and Tobago to create a Mortality Table specific to Trinidad and Tobago. The signing of the Memorandum of Understanding between the two parties occurred on Wednesday 19th September. The data that the Department of Mathematics and Statistics will have access to due to the MOU will facilitate conducting a Mortality Study that will estimate the life expectancy of nationals in Trinidad and Tobago and will assist in improving the accuracy of insurance pricing models used in the insurance industry.
