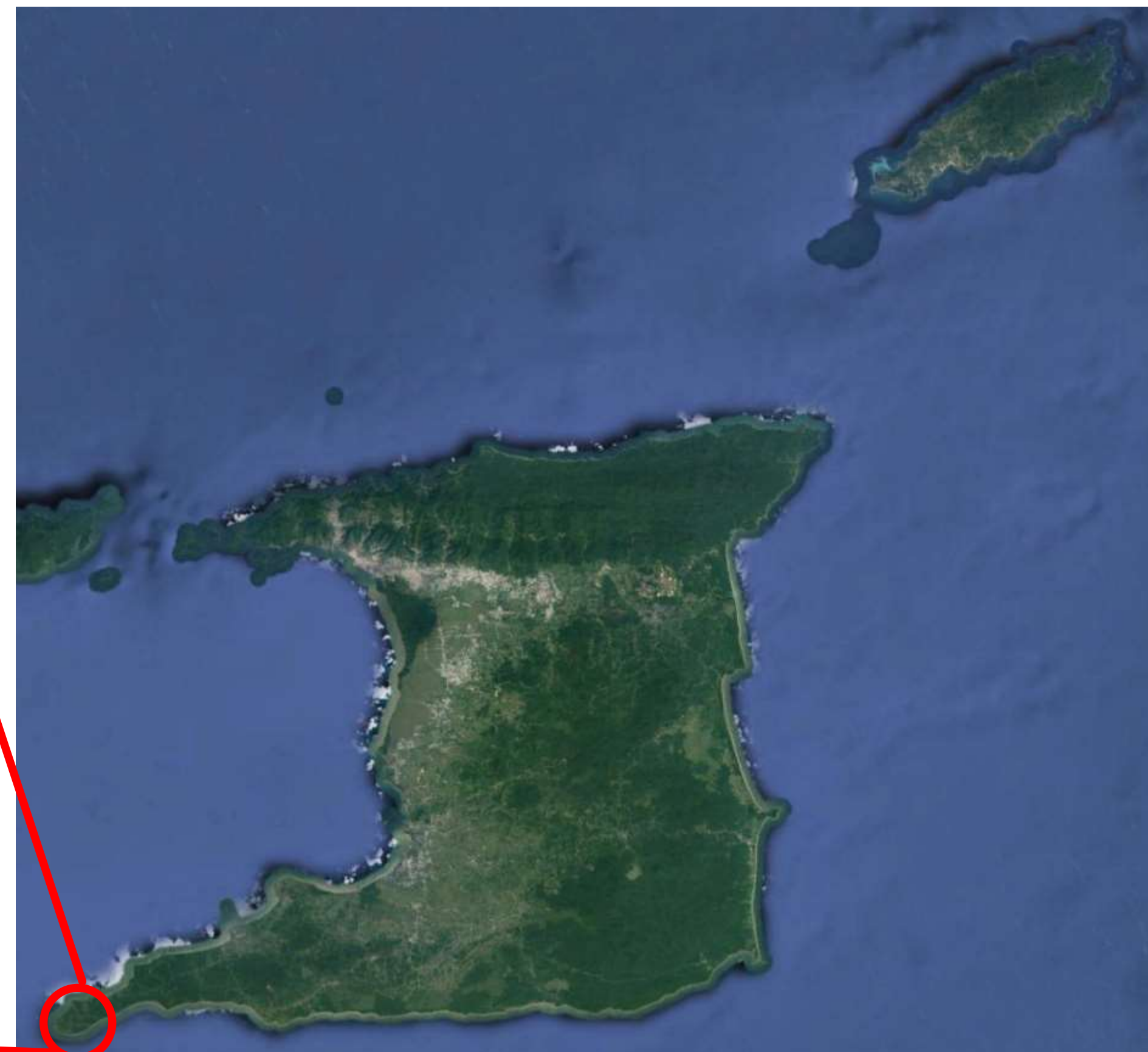




The south-west corner of Trinidad was the site of the sixth T&T bioblitz on 4th-5th November 2017. Teams surveyed the Great Icacos Swamp, Soldado Rock, Cedros forest, Columbus Bay beach and the Icacos mud volcanoes.



Icacos Government Primary School made for a great basecamp, many people came to view the displays and learn more about biodiversity. At the end of the event 769 species had been recorded including the highest numbers of frogs, birds and dragonflies for any T&T Bioblitz so far.
