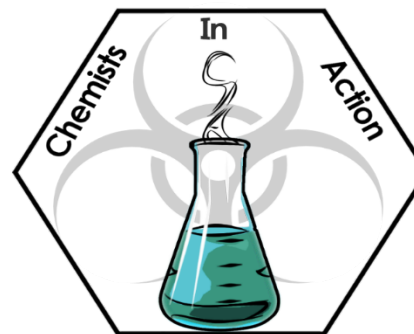

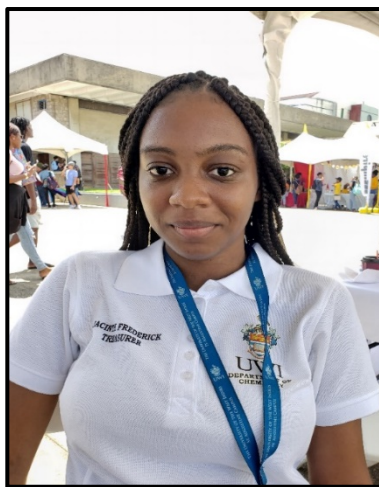

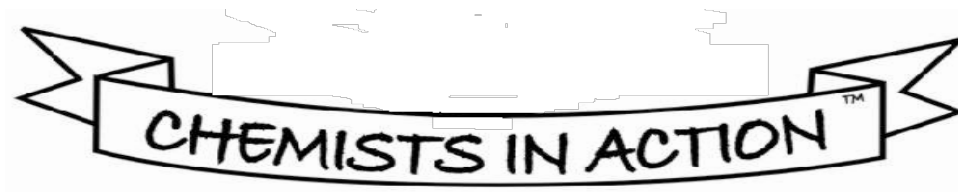


**Hersheys chocolates, red velvet candles, teddy bears and more.....our Valentine's day table had a treat for everyone!!!**

- Per semester: \$120.00

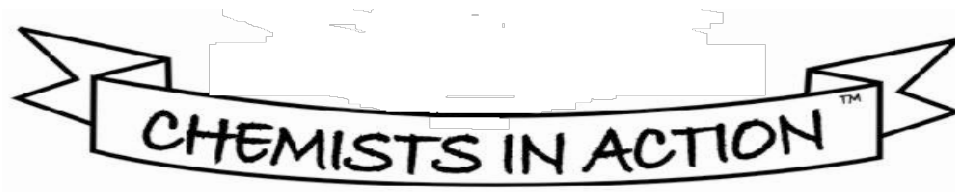
Please be noted that a \$5.00 late fee applies per day if a lab coat is rented and not returned on the stipulated date given.

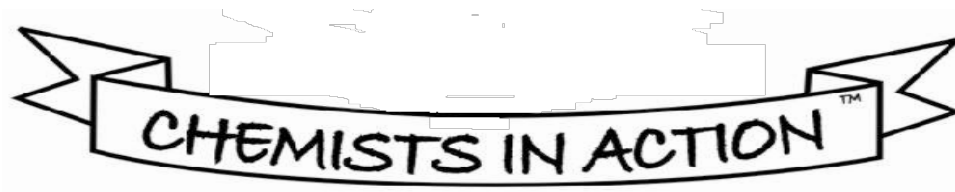
