
CONSIDER A MINOR IN GENDER STUDIES OR GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT STUDIES

- ◆ Prepare for graduation by making sure that your minor is completed and will appear on your degree.



A minor comprises 15 credits. A student pursuing a major, in any faculty across campus, can use the 10 elective courses at level II/III to pursue up to two minors. One of these can be a minor offered by the IGDS.
