The library uses this means to provide an update of the most recent books, serials and multimedia available at the Library .

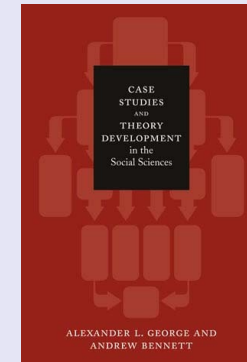
