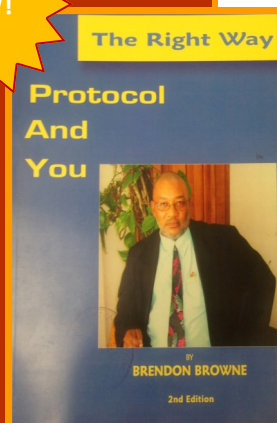

Featured Book. *The Right Way: Protocol and You*

Brendon Calvert Browne was born in Mesopotamia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, on January 5th 1953. He received his early education at the Marriaqua Primary School and the St. Martin's Secondary School. He attended the University of Windsor, in Ontario, Canada, where he obtained a B. A. (Hon) in International Relations and an M. A. in Political Science. He returned to St. Vincent and the Grenadines in 1981 and took up duties as Administrative Cadet in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, where he attained the position of Acting Permanent Secretary.

Mr. Browne is the only Caribbean writer so far who has written on the subject of protocol and is regarded by many as an authority on the subject.

Mr. Brown was appointed Cabinet Secretary in 2001 and served in the position for six years. He was subsequently appointed High Commissioner to Canada for the Organization of Eastern Caribbean States in May 2007.
