Boolean Operators

Boolean Operators are simple words (AND, OR, NOT) used as conjunctions to combine or exclude key-words in a search, resulting in more focused and productive results.



Use **AND** to narrow a search and retrieve records containing all of the words it separates.

Example: *Caribbean AND crime* will only find records containing both these words.



OR

Use **OR** to broaden a search and retrieve records containing any of the words it separates. Example: *adolescents OR children* will find records containing adolescents only, children only, or both words.



Use **NOT** to narrow a search and retrieve records that do not contain the term following it. Example: *adolescents NOT*

children will find records that contain adolescents, but do not contain the word children.
