Boolean Operators

Boolean Operators are simple words (AND, OR, NOT) used as conjunctions to combine or exclude keywords in a search, resulting in more focused and productive results.



Use **AND** to <u>narrow</u> a search and retrieve records containing all of the words it separates.

Example: *Caribbean AND crime* will only find records containing both these words.



OR

Use OR to broaden a search and retrieve records containing any of the words it separates. Example *adolescents OR children* will find records containing adolescents only, children only, or both words.





Use **NOT** to <u>narrow</u> a search and retrieve records that do not contain the term following it. Example: *ado*lescents NOT

children will find records that contain adolescents, but do not contain the word childre *n*.
