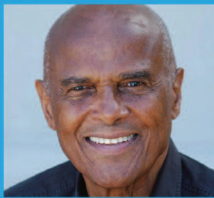

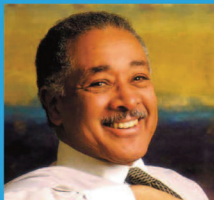

The UWI comprises a 16-member country community of the English-speaking Caribbean and boasts an enrollment of almost 44,000 students. UWI's graduates continue to make an impact in the United States and around the world in a wide range of areas, including business, science, arts & culture, sports, and politics.

In the past four (4) years, AFUWI has given approximately \$400,000 in scholarships to assist students who face dire financial circumstances. Our efforts benefit students and faculty on the four (4) campuses serving the region. Currently the average cost for tuition for one (1) school year is US\$3,000.00. We also provide grants, computer equipment and books. One of the goals of the Foundation is to establish a \$1M fund within the next three (3) years which will provide full, four-year tuition for 100 students.
