## “REFLECTIONS OF A RESEARCHER”

In this lecture, Prof. Ramkissoon takes you on his own personal journey from a humble rural beginning in Trinidad, to being a prolific researcher in Applied Mathematics and an internationally well-known scientist, sharing with you his research experiences. This expedition has taken him to many centres of excellence, including the Universities of Cambridge and London (UK), the Massachusetts Institute of Technology - MIT and Princeton University (USA), the Universities of Gottingen and Karlsruhe (Germany), the Indian Institute of Science and Indian Institutes of Technology (India), the Chinese Academy of Sciences (China) and the University of Malaya (Malaysia).

Professor Emeritus Harold Ramkissoon, the first West Indian to receive a Personal Chair in Mathematics at the St. Augustine Campus of the University of the West Indies, is the recipient of numerous awards and three (3) prestigious Fellowships – An Alexander von Humboldt Foundation Fellowship (Germany), A Senior Fulbright Fellowship (USA) and a World Academy of Sciences (TWAS, China) Fellowship. A former Independent Senator, Professor Ramkissoon serves on the Council of TWAS and on the Board of UNESCO’s International Science, Technology and Innovation Committee (ISTIC) based in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.
