## Application Guidelines

Attending the 2019 Student Energy Summit is a once in a lifetime opportunity to join a global student community to accelerating solutions for the sustainable energy future. Register today to join a movement of over 50,000 students around the world!

By filling out the registration application you will be entered into the competition to secure a spot as one of 600 official delegates of SES 2019. Please note that you need to be registered as a current undergraduate or postgraduate student to apply. Delegates will have to secure any visa needed and travel funds to attend themselves, but the organisers of SES 2019 will provide guides for how to fundraise for this.

## 1. REGISTRATION

The registration process has two stages; the initial application to be invited as a delegate, and your final registration once you have been invited to attend.

### **Stage 1: Application to attend**

In the initial application you will fill out a form with basic details about yourself and your academic background, as well as your motivation for attending the summit.

You will also submit your CV or resume that will be made available to the organisers of SES 2019 as well as sponsoring companies and organisations who will be looking to hire future employees. You may opt-out of submitting your CV or resume.

Applicants who are successful in their initial application will be contacted through the email provided in batches. Applications are reviewed continuously, and invitations are sent out in the beginning of March, April, and May. If you are not accepted within your batch of submission, then you are still in the running for the next batch. Every applicant will hear back by the end May.

### **Stage 2: Final registration**

Successful applicants will be invited to register for the Summit using a personalised code to access the registration form. Here you will make note of any practical details (diet requirements, assistance needs, etc) so that the organisers can best accommodate you at the Summit.

When completing your final registration the conference fee has to be paid online.

If the applicant has been successful in their application they will have received a payment code in their acceptance email (see Costs and Bursaries for more details) which should be applied before paying the registration fee. All applicants that receive an acceptance email are guaranteed a spot at the event once they've submitted their final registration and the registration fee has been processed. This payment has to happen within 3 weeks of receiving their acceptance email.

Once the final registration is submitted and payment is received the applicant will be formally registered as an official Delegate of SES 2019 and will receive a welcome email with more information about the conference, access to materials on how to fundraise for your travel costs and guides on how to apply for a visa.

## 2. COSTS & BURSARIES

The full registration fee of attending SES 2019 is £1700, which includes;

- Access to all plenary and breakout sessions led by global energy experts and leaders
- Accommodation for 3 nights in the heart of London
- All meals for the duration of the Summit
- Access to networking and social events in historical buildings characteristic to London
- Transportation from our provided accommodation to the venue
- Conference kit, booklet and guidebook for Delegates

Bursaries will be allocated based on individual needs and geographic location of the applicant, to encourage a geographic diversity of students at the event.

Costs are subject to vary depending on the allocation of discounts and bursaries. The tables below outline suggested total costs (excluding travel to and from London) for the student to pay.

Note, there is a price difference between EU and Non-EU because travel from anywhere in the EU to the Summit will be much more affordable for EU-based delegates.

Full bursaries are available to students that won't be able to cover the costs otherwise and fulfil criteria from sponsoring organisations. For past summits, the majority of students have received partial bursaries reducing their costs to only the registration fee and accommodation costs. We aim to be able to offer this for SES 2019 as well. We also highly recommend that students approach their academic institution about sponsoring their attendance at the Summit which has been a very effective approach for students attending past summits. Many universities have bursaries available to support students attending external conferences to both support the students academic success and to showcase their academic institution as a leader.

We also encourage delegates to expand fundraising efforts for their registration and travel expenses in their local community. There are many energy and environmental institutions that will support students attending if they attend as an organisation representative and share some of what the organisation is doing to the 650 delegates attending the Summit, and bring back learnings from the Summit to the organisation.
