About the Organizer	<p>The International Cooperation and Exchange Center is an institution directly under the administration the Department of Commerce of Hainan Province. Through theoretical learning and case studies, participants will acquire skills in marine conservation, pollution prevention and control, biodiversity maintenance, and gain an understanding of the challenges and opportunities faced by developing countries in marine governance. The program emphasizes practical skills, introducing techniques such as coral reef restoration and marine ranching, and discussing Hainan's successful experiences and future plans.
