Seminar Content	<p>Project content:</p> <p>Revolving around the theme of "Island Climate Change and Economic Development", the seminar covers the economic development opportunities related to "blue carbon" and marine ranch construction, with a specific focus on the carbon sink potential of the Hainan coastal ecosystem. Participants will gain an understanding of the significance of blue carbon and the potential for economic development through marine ranch construction. In addition, the program introduces China's climate change policies and actions, as well as its green and low-carbon development experience. Participants will learn about China's efforts to achieve carbon peaking and carbon neutrality, including the measures taken to achieve these goals. The program will also use examples such as Tesla and China's BYD to analyze the opportunities for low-carbon development for enterprises, providing practical insights into how businesses can contribute to environmental sustainability. Furthermore, as Hainan is positioned as the world's largest free trade port, the program provides an introduction to the relevant development policies and achievements that have been accomplished in the region.
