Seminar Content	<p>Sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of the P. R. C., the program is as follow: Over the past 40 years of reform and opening up, China has proactively responded to the trend of the times by launching reforms internally and opening up externally, thereby promoting its own development through the interaction of reform and opening up. Chinese President Xi Jinping pointed out in the report of the 19th Party Congress that "Openness brings progress, while closure is bound to lag behind. China's door to openness will not be closed, but will only open wider and wider." This profound statement is a scientific summary of the development trend of economic globalisation in the contemporary world, as well as a scientific summary of the practical experience of economic development and opening up since the founding of New China. In the future, China will continue to play its role as a responsible big country, actively participate in the reform and construction of the global governance system, and continuously contribute Chinese wisdom and strength.</p> <p>Therefore, China is willing to organize this workshop to enhance exchanges and cooperation with developing countries on the field of reform and opening up through expert lectures, experience exchanges and enterprises visits. In addition to a rich course schedule, we will also lead students to visit two representative Chinese cities, Guangzhou and Shenzhen. Guangzhou is one of the first national historical and cultural cities, one of the starting points of the Maritime Silk Road, the central city of the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area and the hub city of the Belt and Road Initiative. Known as the "Silicon Valley of China", Shenzhen is one of the four central cities in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area and one of the three national financial centers in China.
