The CRR was established in 2017 and since then it has made considerable headway in laying the foundation for reparation studies in academia. Some of the achievements of the CRR include considerable public engagement and advocacy as well as, support to the development of the UWI / University of Glasgow joint MA/MSc. in Reparatory Justice which accepted its first cohort in 2023.
