## Introduction

The University of the West Indies is a five-campus tertiary education institution supported by 17 contributing countries. It offers undergraduate and postgraduate degrees in various fields of study to students from around the region and internationally. The St. Augustine Campus in Trinidad was born in 1960 out of the Imperial College of Tropical Agriculture (ICTA) and typically provides higher education to over 16,000 students. The St. Augustine Campus houses eight faculties: Humanities & Education, Social Sciences, Medical Sciences, Law, Science and Technology, Food and Agriculture, Engineering and Sport. It also hosts a range of research units, centres, and institutes. The UWI, St. Augustine continues to be dedicated to teaching and learning, research, and innovation and to the development of the Caribbean region.

This report is a presentation to the St. Augustine Campus Council for the academic year 2024/2025. The statistical information presented provides quantitative measures and utilises descriptive statistics to illustrate current and historical data on student participation and performance for the period 2020/2021 to 2024/2025. It also provides a snapshot of student statistics for Semester 1 of the current academic year, 2024/2025. This report delivers information on the following areas:

- a. Student statistics over a five-year period in respect of Student Applications, Admissions, Enrolment and Graduation
- b. Faculty statistical comparisons
- c. A demographic profile of students by nationality, age and sex
- d. Highlights obtained from the annual Graduate Tracer survey
- e. Student enrolment at the programme level.

This document was produced with Enrolment data generated on December 1st, 2025 and Graduation data generated on November 28th, 2025. As such, any updates made to the data after the dates mentioned would not be reflected in the statistics presented.



## Definitions of Key Terms and Concepts

<b>Acceptance Rate</b>	The percentage of applicants who received official offers from the St. Augustine Campus.
<b>Applications</b>	The number of completed applications submitted by individuals (head count).
<b>Certificate of Achievement</b>	The certificate received after completing short courses administered by the faculty of Food & Agriculture and the CPE Unit.
<b>Contributing Countries</b>	Countries included in the UWI 17 + 1 as well as Barbados, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago.
<b>Continuing Professional Education (CPE)</b>	Continuing and Professional Education (CPE) is a range of credit and non-credit courses located within a lifelong learning and workforce development framework.
<b>Evening</b>	Students registered in Certificate/Diploma or Degree programmes offered specifically at the Evening University.
<b>Bachelor's Degree First Year Retention</b>	The percentage of students from a specific entry cohort at the undergraduate level who re-enrol for a second year of study.
<b>Full-Time (FT)</b>	Registered students who carry the complete load of course credits associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year.
<b>Student Full Time Equivalent (FTE)</b>	Student Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) is a standardized measure of student enrolment based on study workload. FTE is calculated as the number of full-time students plus one-half of the number of part-time students, using the formula: <b>FTE = Full-Time Students + (0.5 × Part-Time Students)</b> . Under this methodology, a full-time student represents 1.0 FTE (100% workload), and a part-time student represents 0.5 FTE (50% workload).
<b>Nationals</b>	Students whose country of nationality is Trinidad & Tobago.
<b>New Admissions</b>	Registered students who are new first-time entrants and new first-time transfers to the University.
<b>No College Designated</b>	Students who are enrolled in Summer Programmes and who are registered with a particular faculty.
<b>Non-Contributing Countries</b>	All nations other than the UWI 17 + 1, Barbados, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago.
<b>Not Identifiable (NI)</b>	No data is available in the data repository.
<b>Offers</b>	The number of applicants (head count) given institutional acceptance (offers).
<b>Off Campus</b>	Students enrolled in programmes that are administered at UWI-affiliated institutions and are not located in the host country, that is Trinidad & Tobago.
<b>On Campus</b>	On Campus students who attend classes on the St. Augustine or Mt. Hope campuses and are in pursuit of an undergraduate, and postgraduate degree, certificate, or diploma programme.
<b>On-Time Graduation Rates</b>	The percentage of graduands that completed their undergraduate first-degree programme within the minimum time frame allotted by the University.
<b>Other Students</b>	Students enrolled in undeclared courses, summer programmes, pre-university programmes, certificates of achievement, and CPE short courses.
<b>Part-Time (PT)</b>	Registered students who carry less than the complete load of courses associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year.
<b>Postgraduate (PG)</b>	Students enrolled in Higher Degree programmes at the St. Augustine Campus which lead to the acquisition of a qualification beyond a first degree such as the PG Diploma, Taught Masters, Master of Philosophy, Doctorate etc.
<b>Pre-University Students</b>	Students enrolled in the Pre-Science, Pre-Health, and Pre-Engineering programmes.
<b>Programme</b>	The course of study for which the student has been admitted into the University. This pertains to Certificates, Diplomas, Undergraduate (BSc, BA, BEd), Postgraduate Diplomas and Higher Degrees (MA, MSc, MPhil, PhD, etc.).
<b>Qualifying</b>	A student pursuing courses to qualify for entry to a postgraduate programme.
<b>Registration/Enrolment</b>	The process by which students, upon acceptance into a given faculty and programme at the University, give written notification of the courses which they wish to pursue during the current semester/academic year. For this document, this includes both on and off campus students. Students categorised as Other (see definition above) are represented in separate tables.
<b>Specially Admitted/Specially Admitted (Stand Alone)</b>	Persons may register to read a course or courses within The UWI, without being registered in an Undergraduate or Postgraduate degree programme. These persons are considered for entry as "Specially Admitted students". Under the University's rules, such persons may read up to a total of 24 credits in this category or registration. A maximum of nine (9) relevant credits obtained through special admission can be counted towards UWI certification and Graduate Diplomas and Degrees of The UWI.
<b>Student Session</b>	Students enrolled on a full-time, part-time, evening, or summer basis.
<b>Summer</b>	Students enrolled to pursue courses during the summer semester, which occurs, from June to July of the academic year.
<b>Undergraduate (UG)</b>	Students enrolled at the St. Augustine Campus in programmes, which lead to the award of a Certificate, UG Diploma or First Degree.
<b>Undeclared</b>	At The UWI 'Undeclared' is a level, in addition to UG, PG, Cert., etc. used to differentiate students in a non-degree or certificate programme, such as the Pre-University students.
<b>UG/PG Credit Bearing Certificate</b>	The Certificate received upon completion of courses administered by the CPE Unit.
<b>Yield Rate</b>	The percentage of students who, upon receipt of an offer, enroll at the St. Augustine Campus. The rate is commonly used as a measure of selectivity indicating interest in a particular institution.

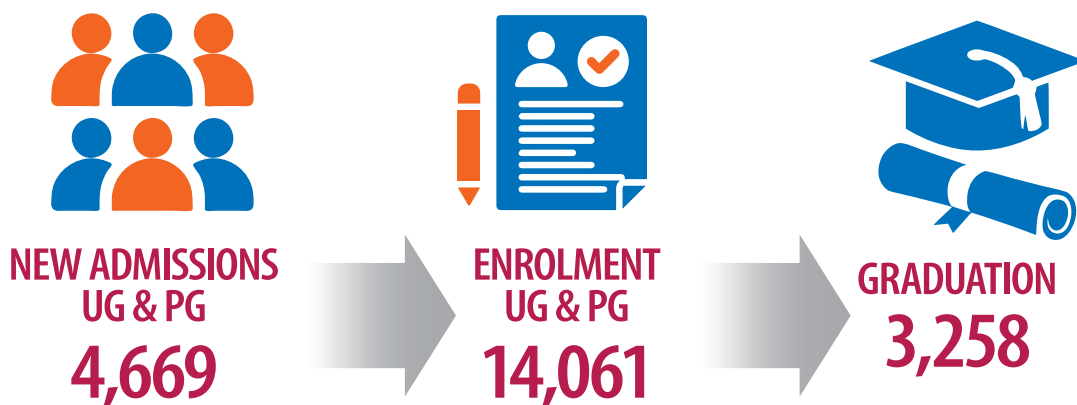
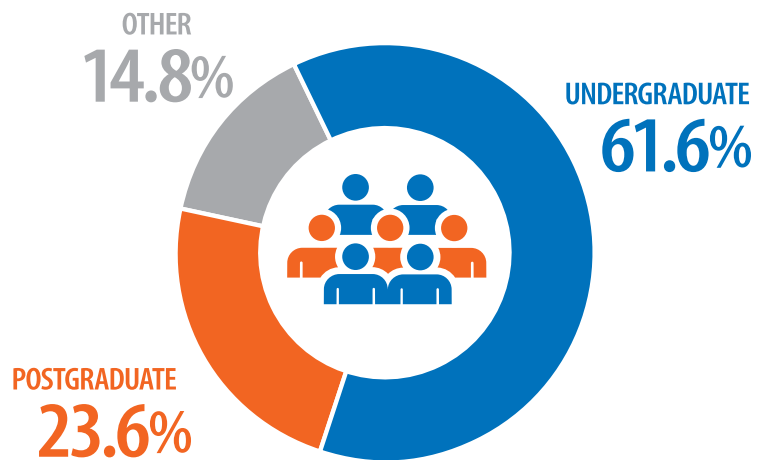

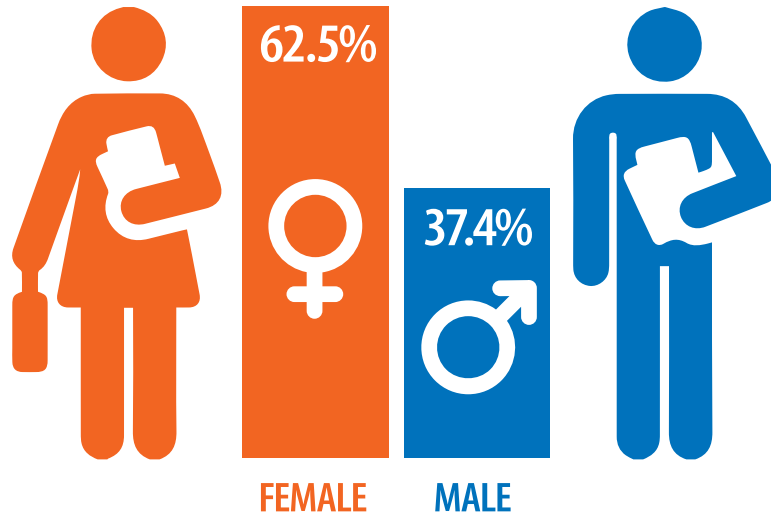

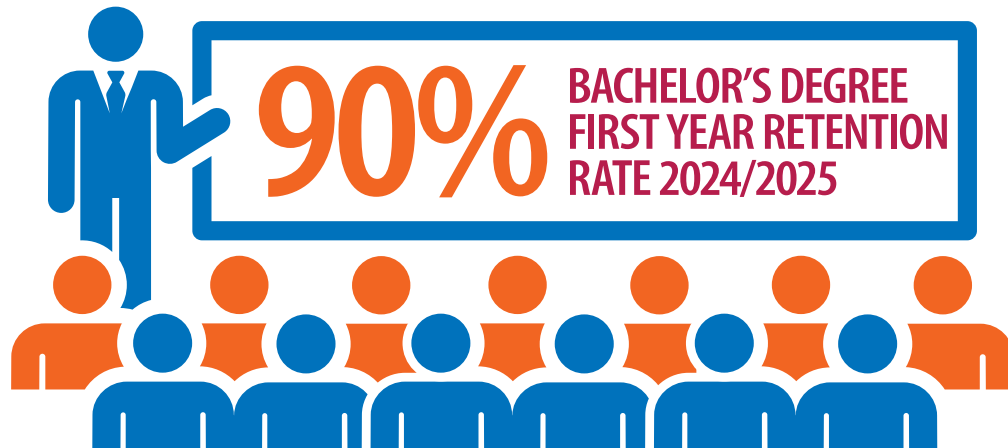
### UG & PG ENROLMENT BY SEX



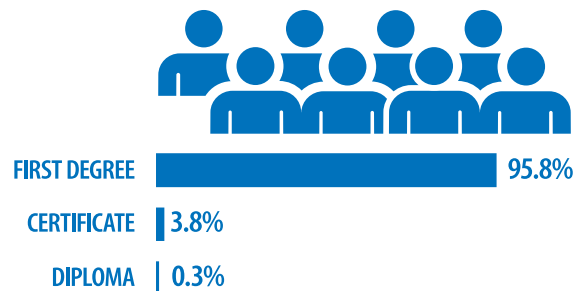
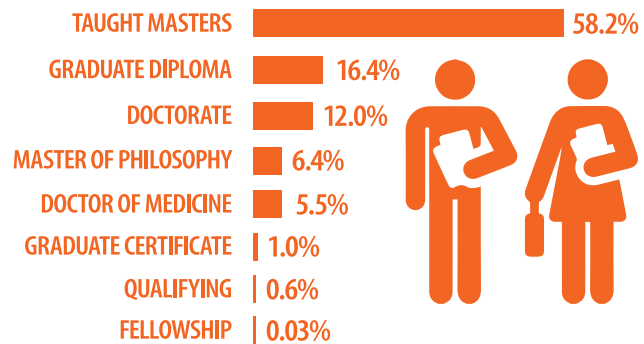
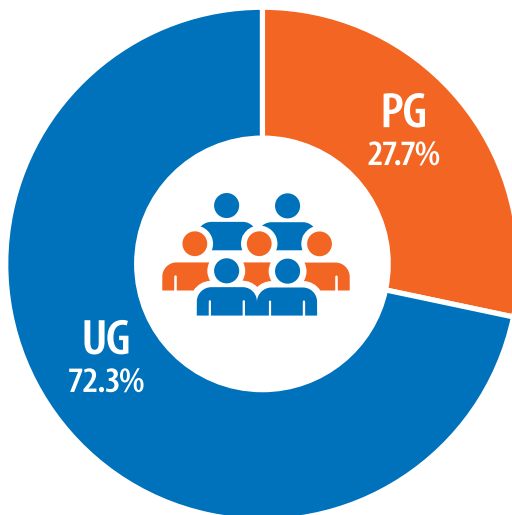
### UG & PG ENROLMENT BY FACULTY & SEX



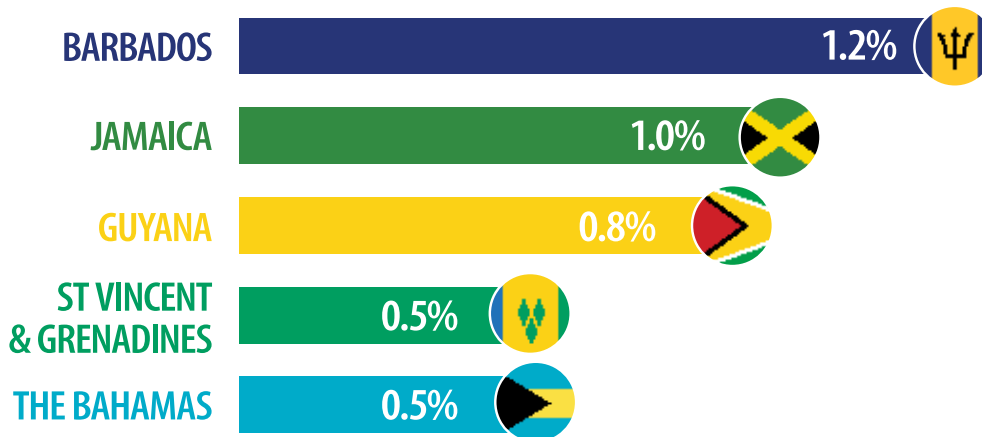




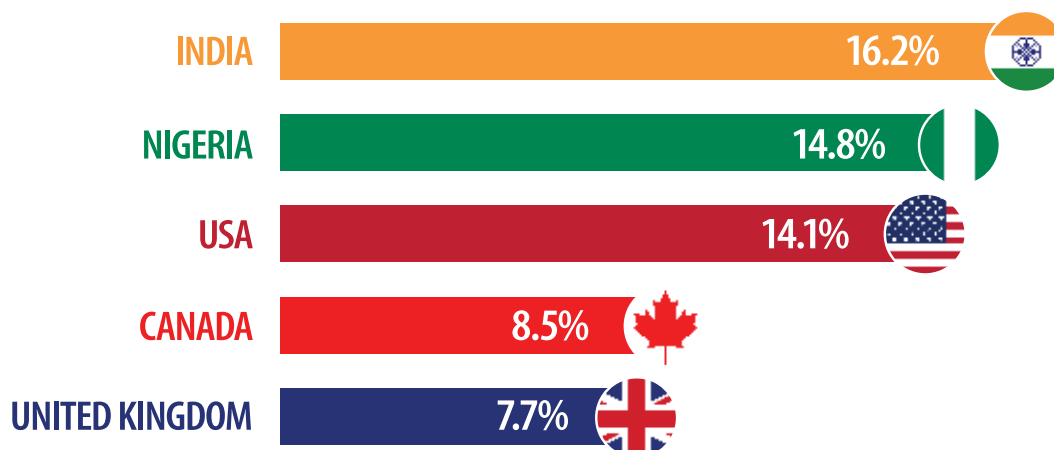

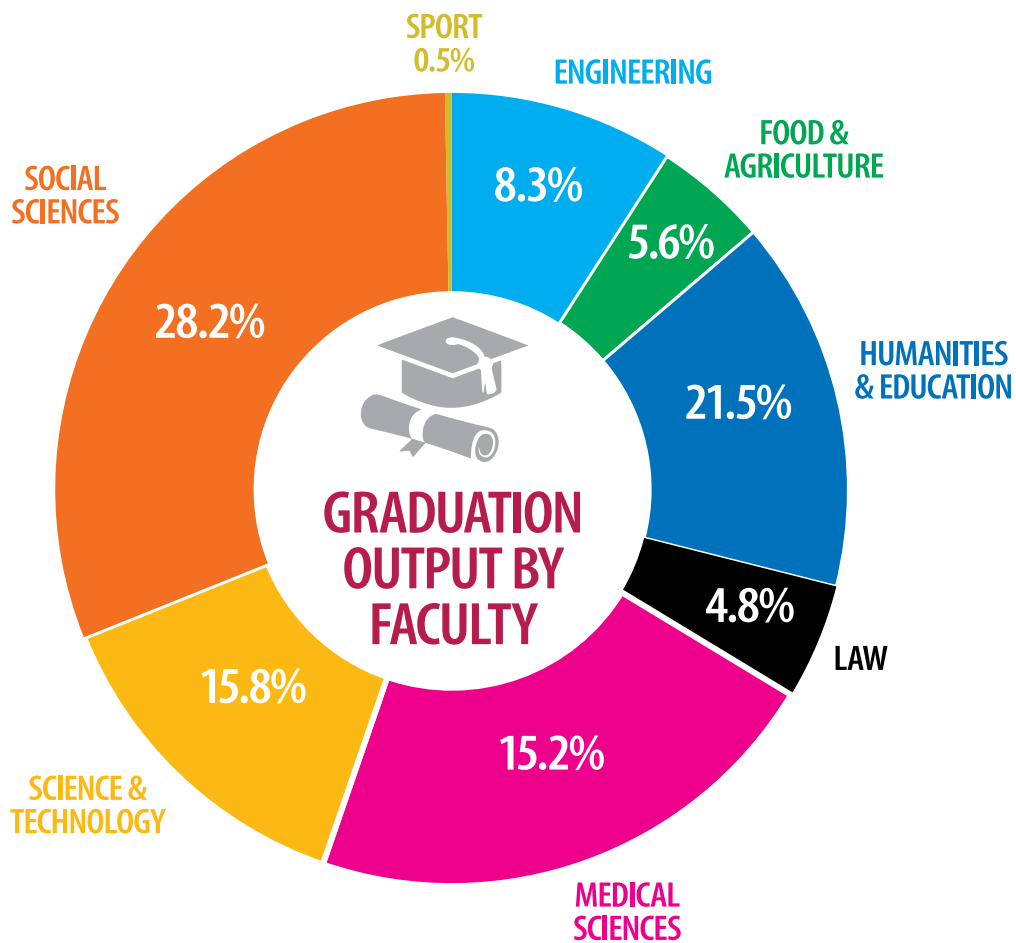
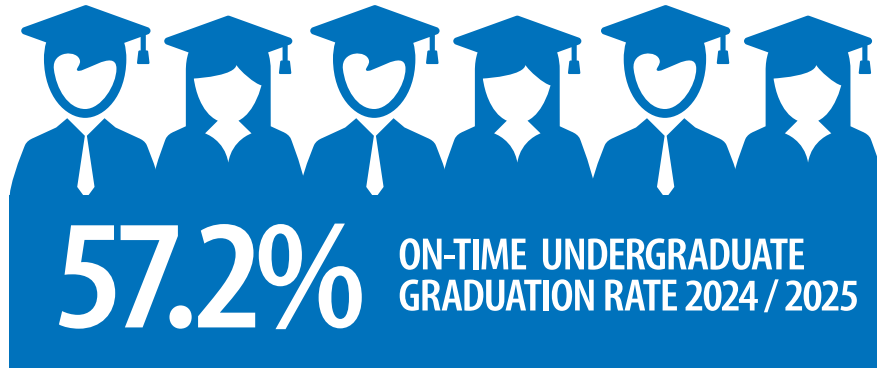

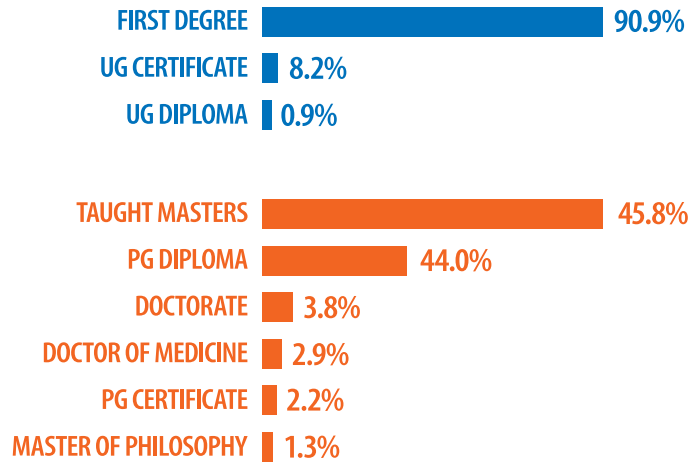
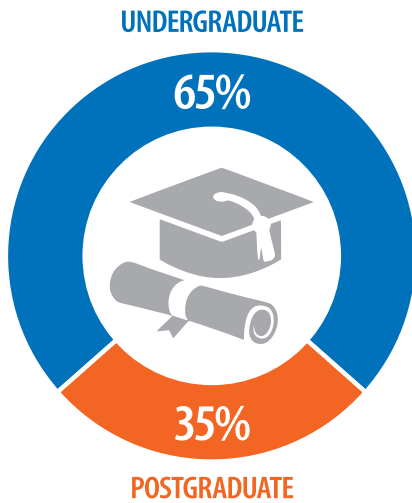
## HIGHEST ENROLMENT AMONG INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (NON-CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES)



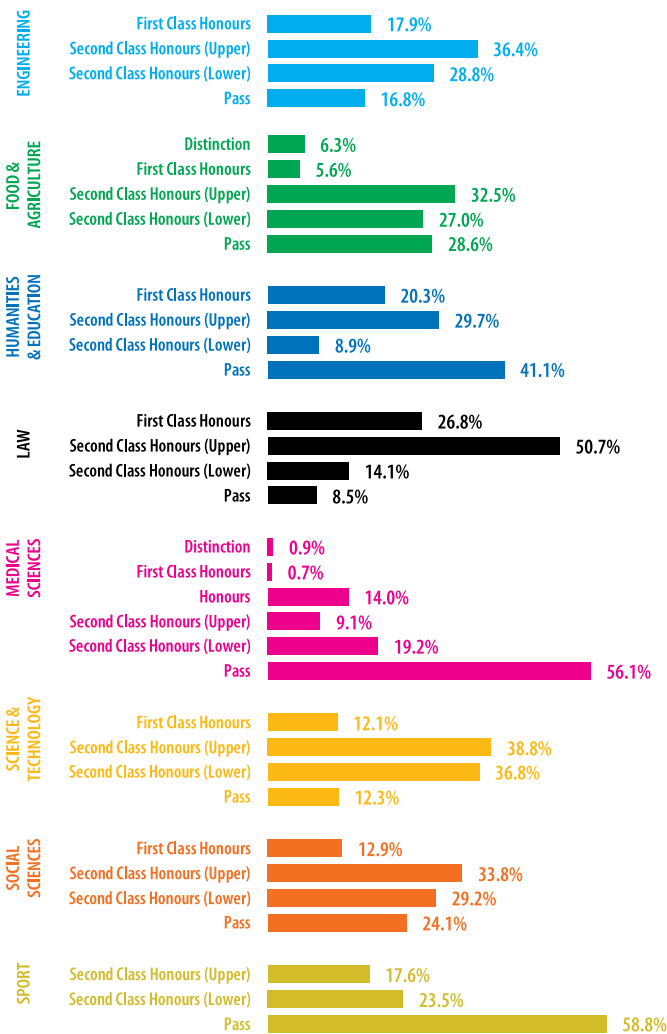

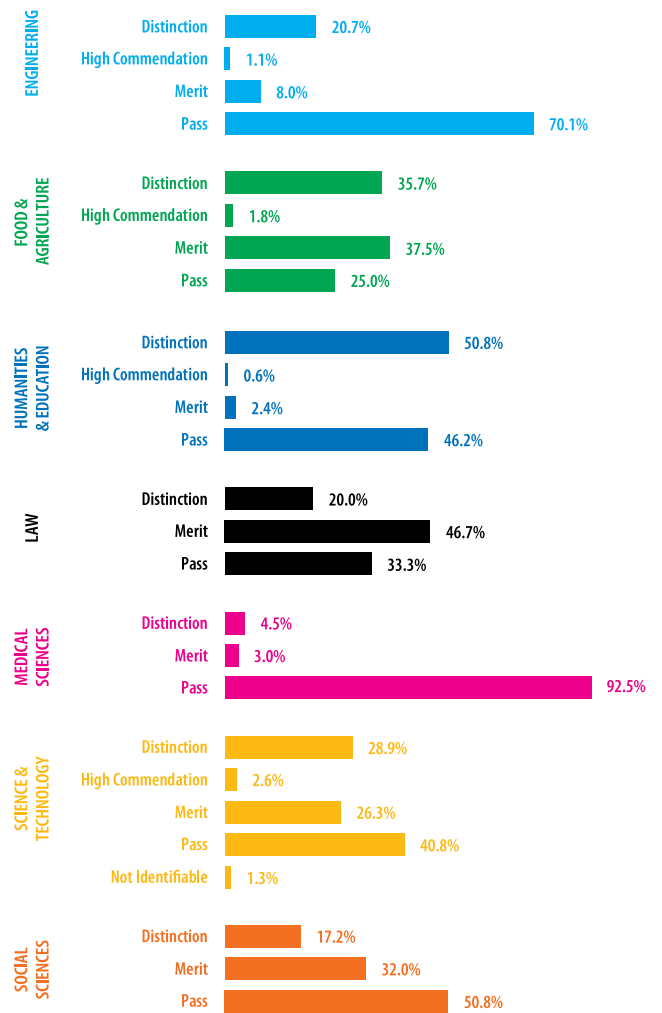

## UG GRADUATES BY FACULTY AND HONOURS 2024/2025



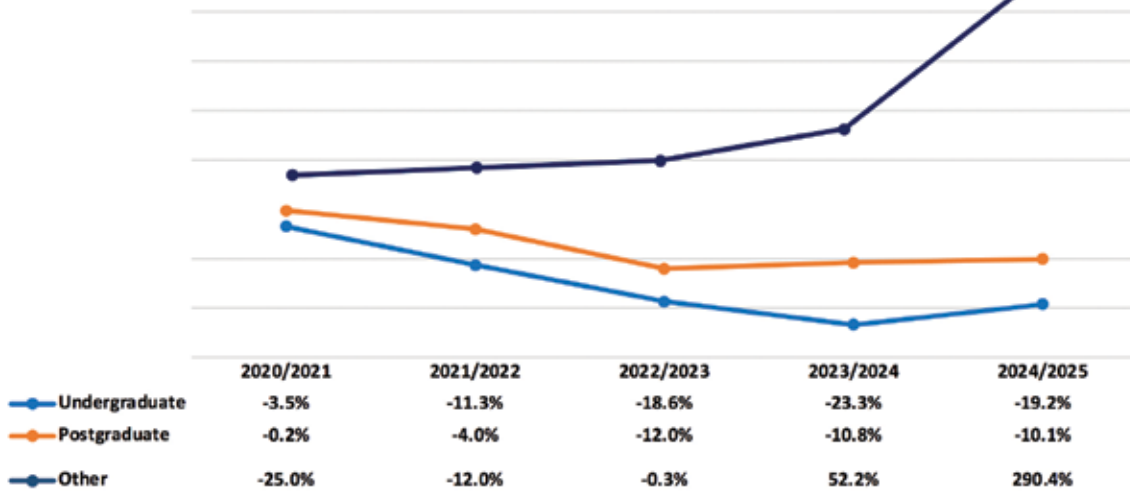

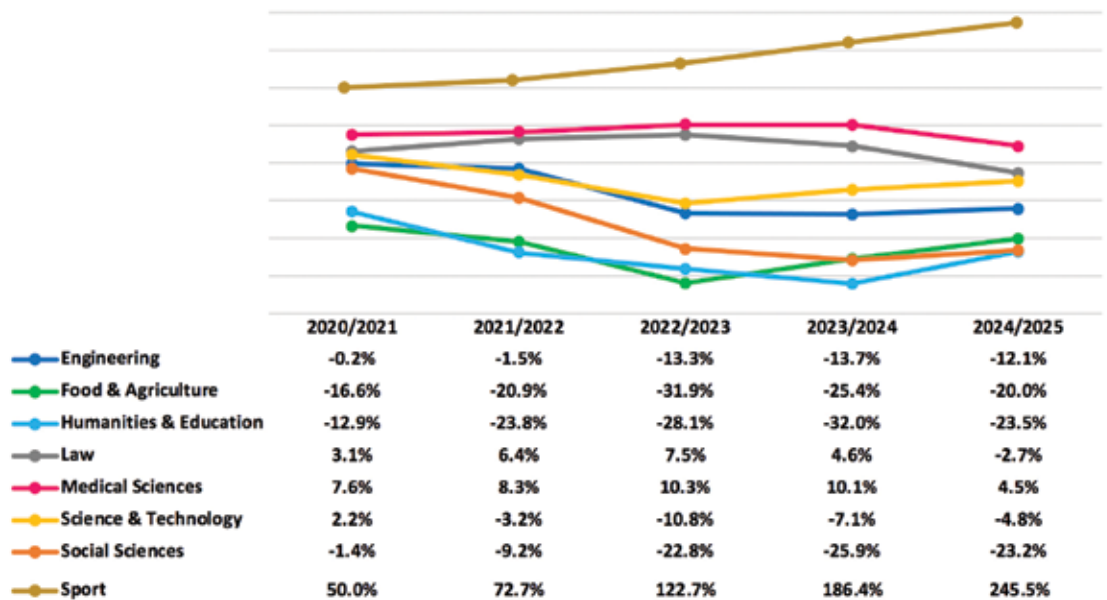

Figure C: Growth in UG & PG Enrolment by Sex 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

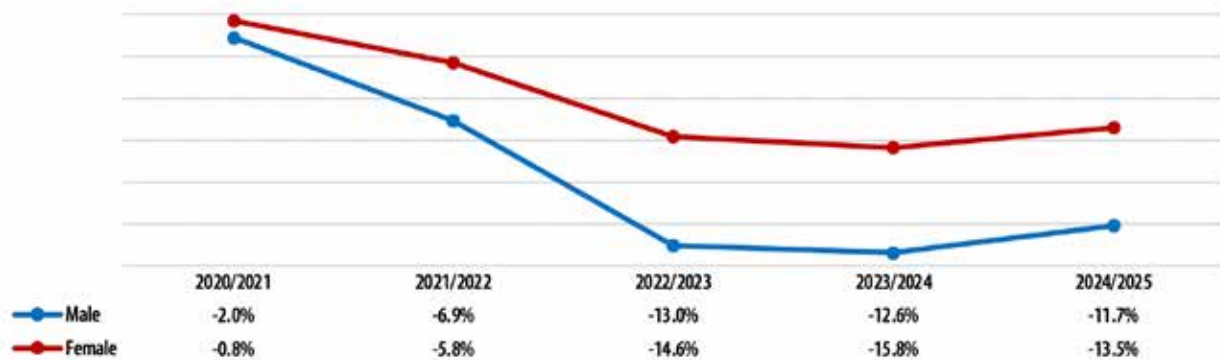


Figure D: Growth in UG & PG Enrolment by Age Group 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

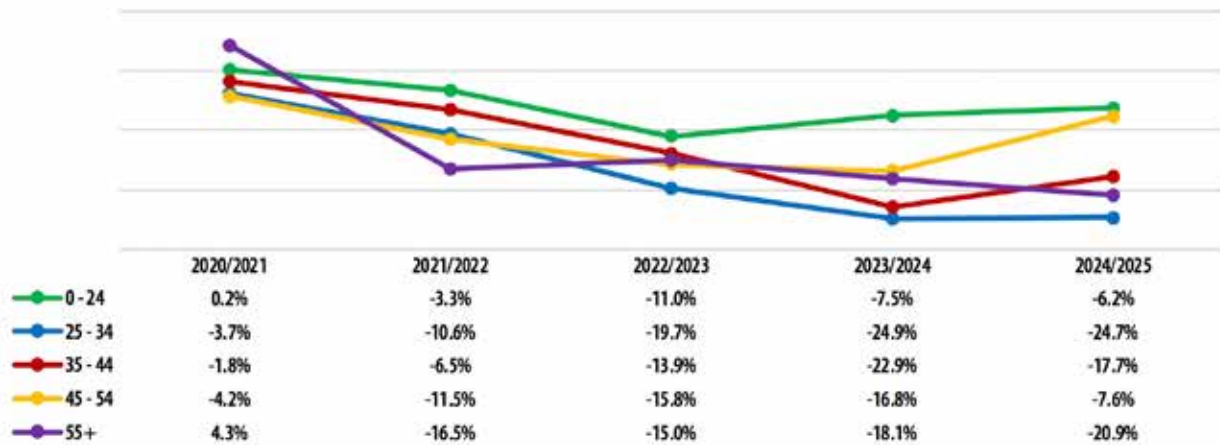
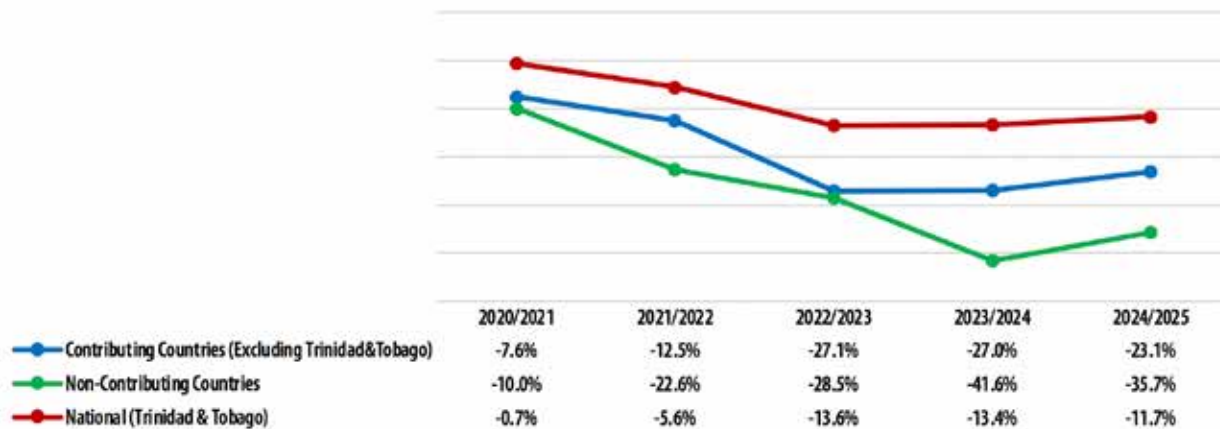


Figure E: Growth in UG & PG Enrolment by Nationality 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

Figure F: Growth in UG Enrolment by Degree Type 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

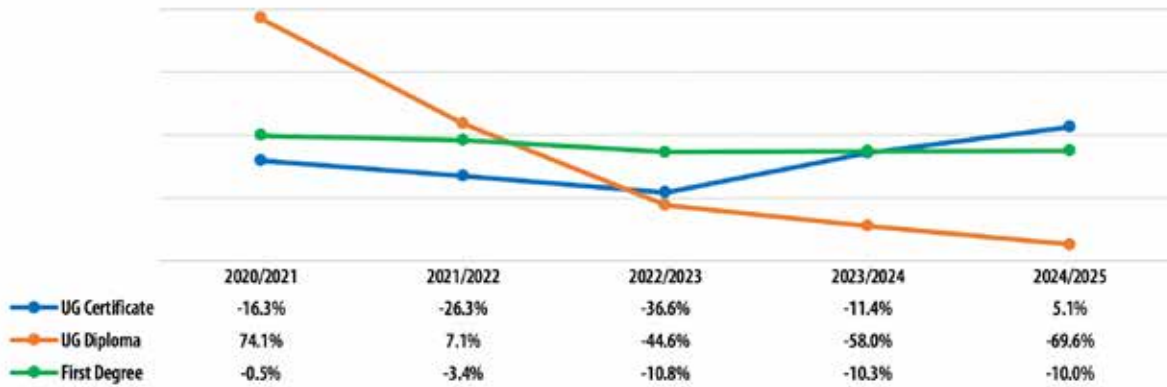
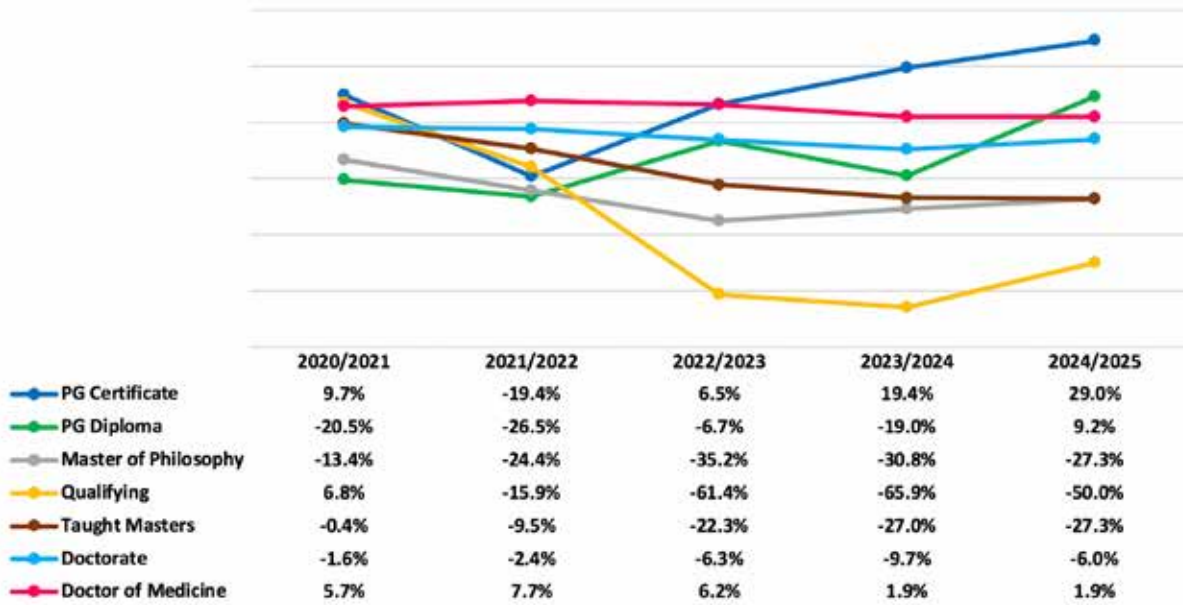


Figure G: Growth in PG Enrolment by Degree Type 2020/2021 to 2024/2025





## Section 1: Trends in the Number of Applications, Offers and New Admissions

The data in Figure 1.1 presents trends in the total number of applications, offers, and new admissions over a ten-year period. Overall applications declined by 36% between 2016/2017 and 2025/2026, reflecting a downward trend until 2024/2025 when applications rebounded to 9,020, representing a 17% increase from the previous year. Offers followed a similar downward trend, falling by 37% from 8,624 to 5,405. New admissions also declined by 37% between 2016/2017 and 2021/2022, though the past two years indicate a modest recovery.

Figure 1.2 shows acceptance rates (offers as a proportion of applications) over the same period. Acceptance rates fluctuated within a relatively narrow range, from a moderate 65.3% to a high of 74.2%. After peaking in 2019/2020, acceptance rates declined steadily to their lowest point in 2022/2023. Since then, there has been some improvement at 72.2% in 2025/2026. Overall, acceptance rates demonstrated modest variability with recent improvement.

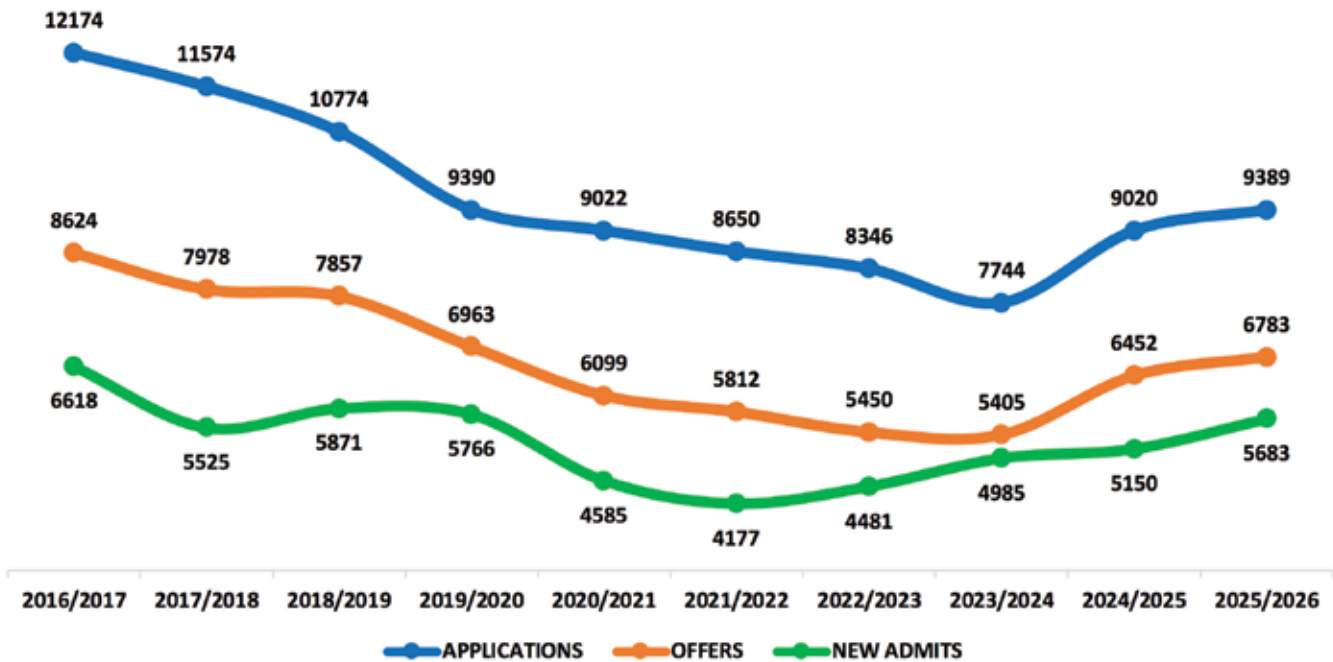

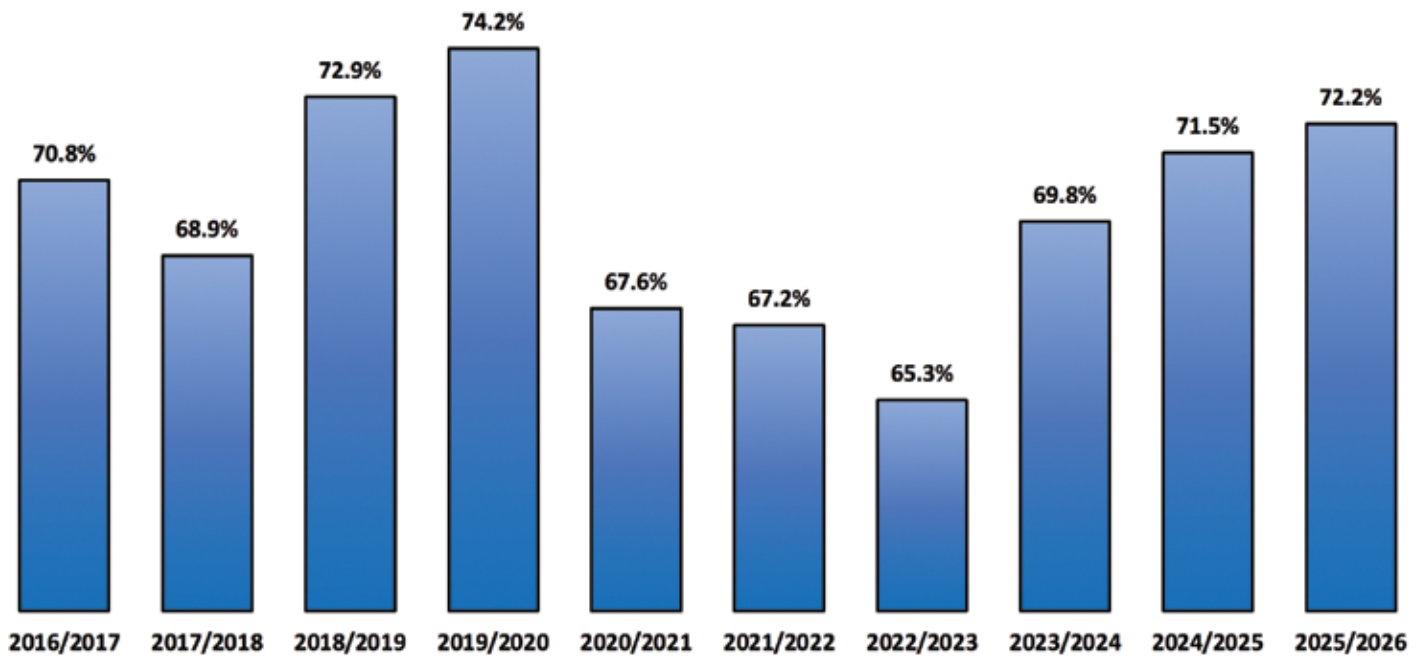
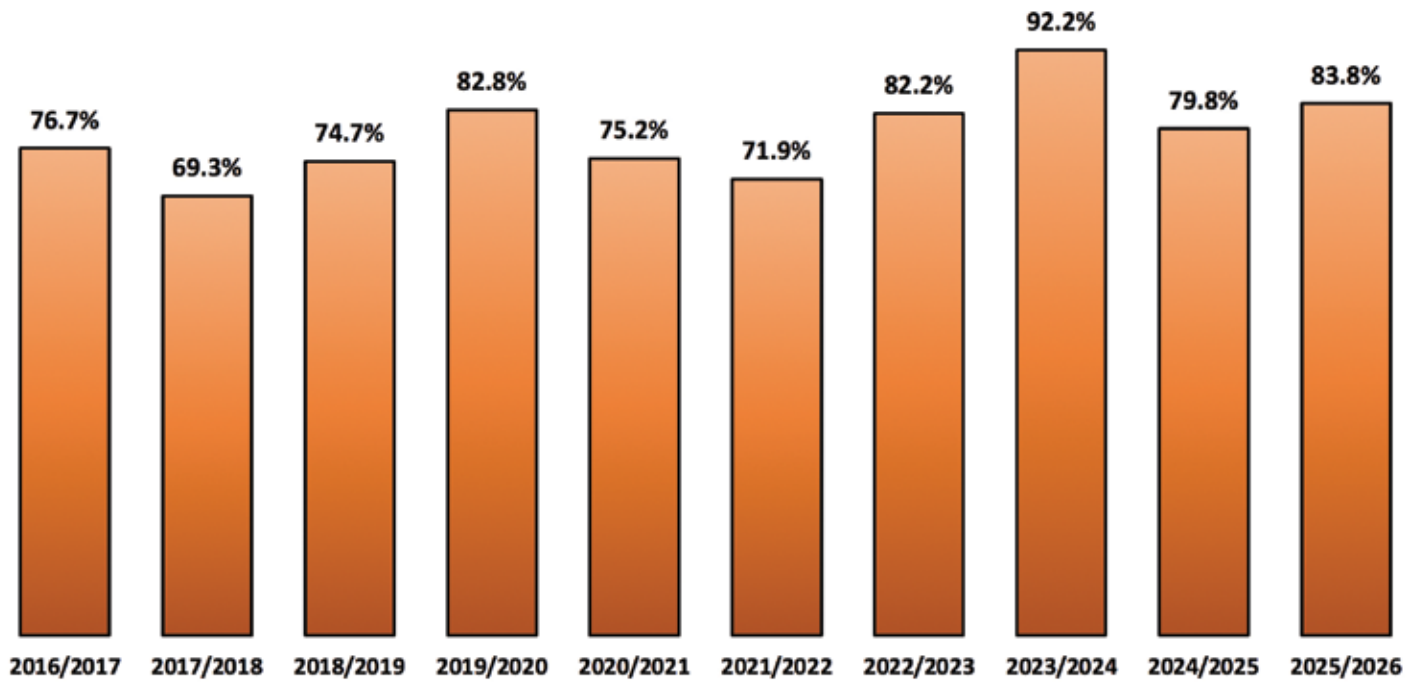


Figure 1.3 Trends in Yield Rates 2016/2017 to 2025/2026

As illustrated in Figure 1.3, Yield Rates (New Admissions as a proportion of Offers) remained consistently strong over the ten (10) year period, averaging 78% despite year-to-year fluctuations. During the period 2019/2020 to 2021/2022, yield rates declined by approximately 11%. However, this downward trend changed trajectory, and yield rates peaked at 92.2% in 2023/2024, the highest level in the period, before returning to more typical levels in the following years.

Figure 1.2 Trends in Acceptance Rates 2016/2017 to 2025/2026

## Section 2: Total Enrolment Trends for UG, PG and Other Students 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

In 2024/2025, undergraduate and postgraduate students comprised 61.6% and 23.6% of total enrolment, respectively. Across the eight faculties—Engineering, Food & Agriculture, Humanities & Education, Law, Medical Sciences, Science & Technology, Social Sciences, and Sport, total enrolment reflects both new and continuing students, as well as Other Students. The Other Students category includes individuals enrolled in pre-university programmes, summer programmes, undeclared programmes, and continuing professional education programmes.

Between 2022/2023 and 2024/2025, total enrolment increased by 13.8%. This was driven primarily by growth in undergraduate enrolment, as well as in the Other students category. This signals

a demand for undergraduate offerings and alternative academic pathways. In contrast, postgraduate enrolment declined consistently between 2020/2021 and 2023/2024, suggesting demand side challenges. This fallout coincided with the removal of GATE funding for postgraduate students. However, some recovery was observed in 2024/2025 with a 5.3% increase at the postgraduate level as compared to the previous year.

New student admissions rose by approximately 13% in 2024/2025. This growth was supported by a moderate increase at the undergraduate level (5.2%), and the stronger gains at the postgraduate level (27.5%), and among other students (19.9%) relative to 2023/2024, suggesting improving recruitment effectiveness.

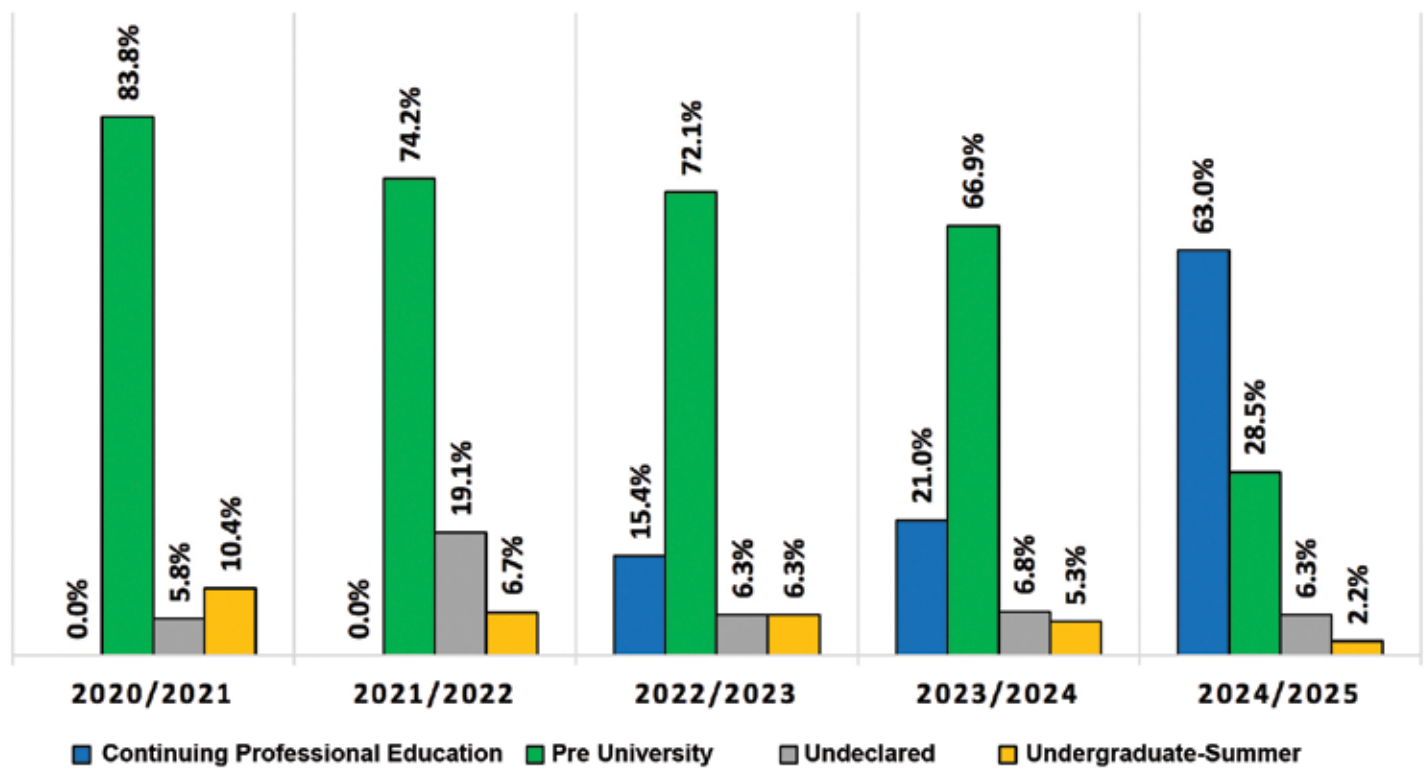

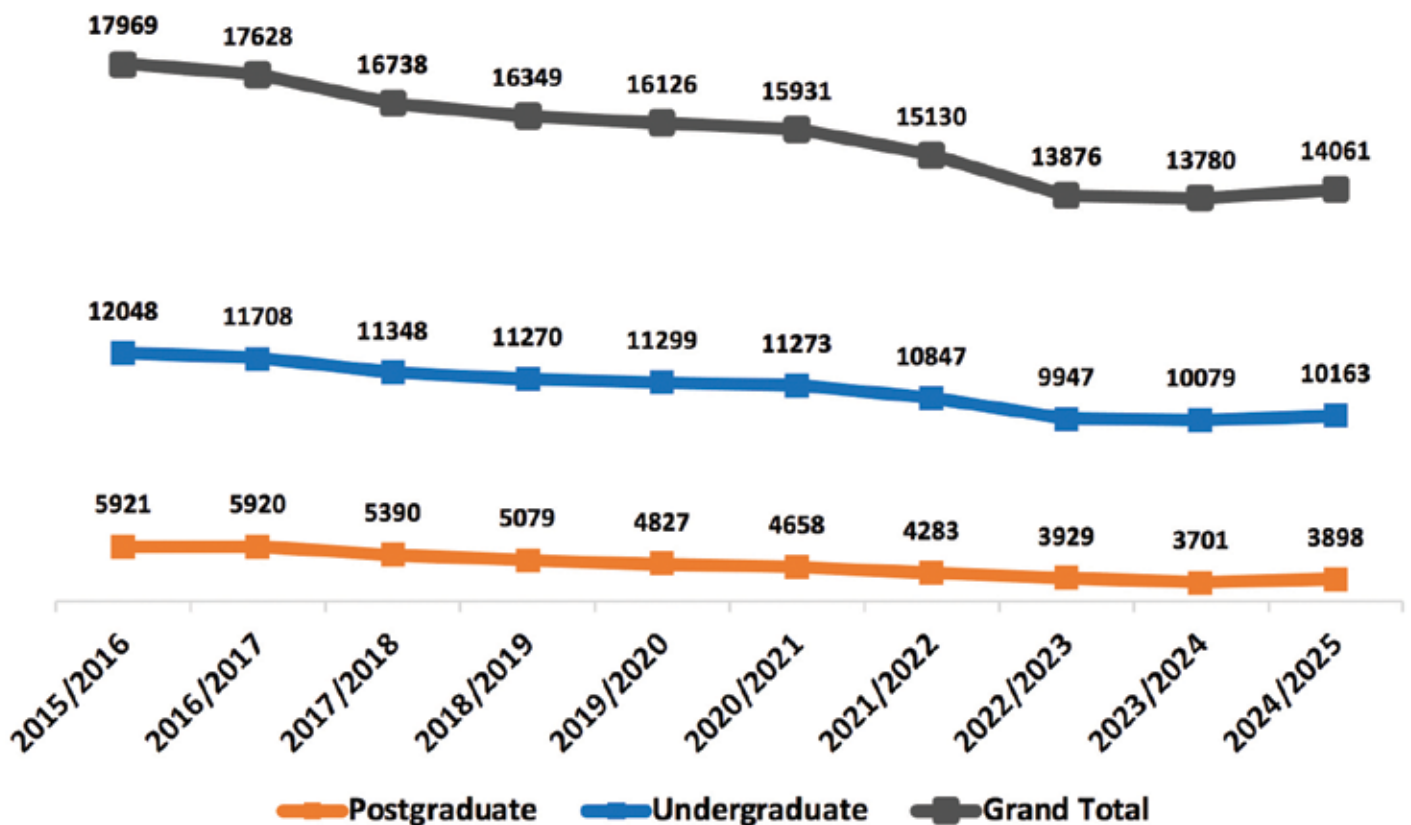

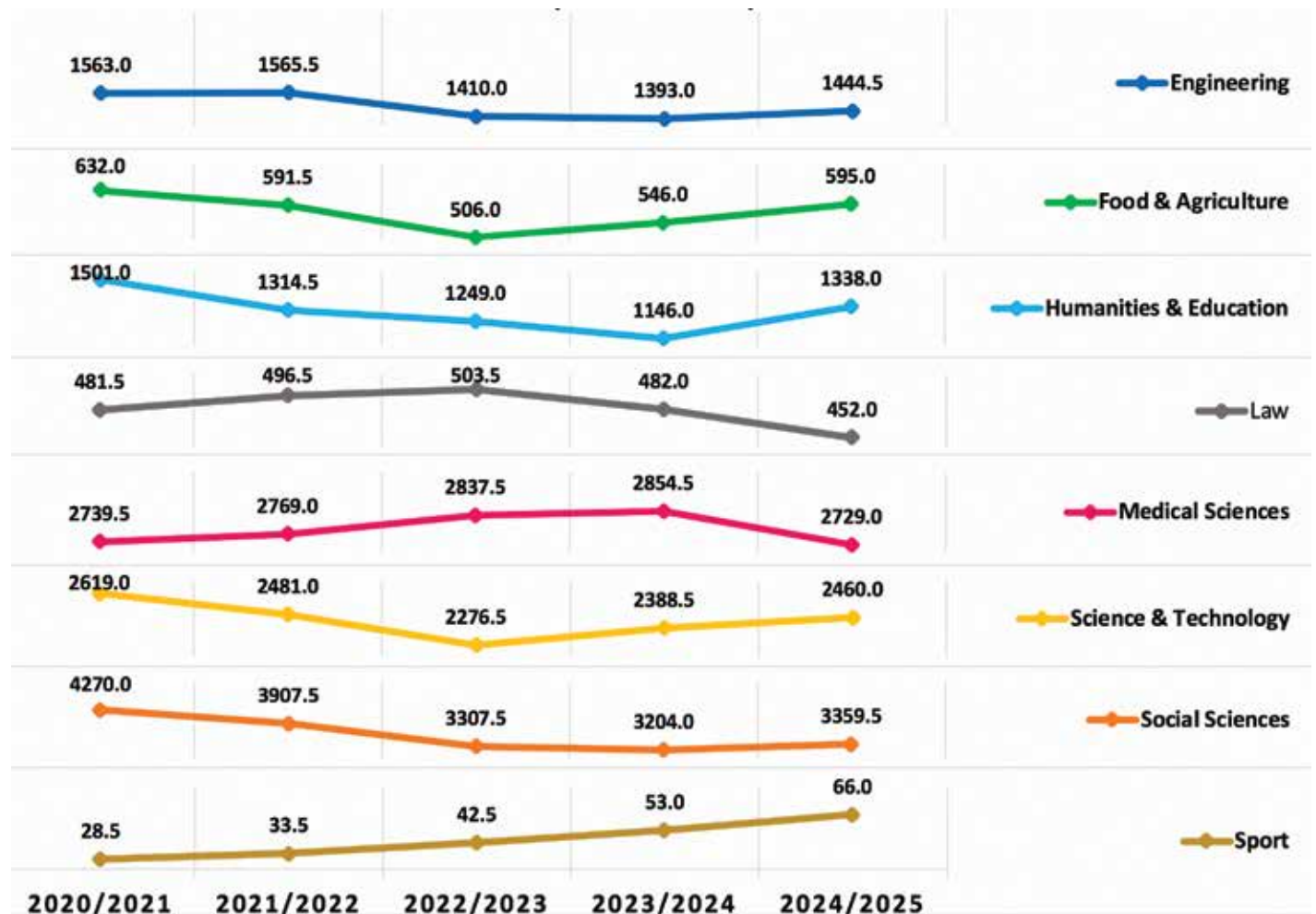
Figure 3.1: Enrolment Trends for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Students 2015/2016 to 2024/2025

The total student population remained predominantly female. In the 2024/2025 academic year, females comprised 63.3% of students, compared to 36.3% males reflecting a persistent imbalance between the sexes across the campus. This pattern may impact the workforce particularly in historically male dominated disciplines (e.g. Medical Sciences). Postgraduate enrolment was concentrated in the 25–34 age group (42.2%), followed by the 35–44 age group (34.2%). Undergraduate enrolment, by contrast, was dominated by the 18–24 age group, representing 80.0% of undergraduates. Overall, younger students primarily pursue undergraduate studies, while postgraduate programmes attract early- to mid-career adults.

In terms of nationality, 93.8% of the student population in 2024/2025 were largely nationals of Trinidad and Tobago, 5.0% were from contributing countries, and 1.2% were from non-contributing countries. Among non-contributing territories,

postgraduate enrolment primarily came from nationals of the United States of America (18.0%), India (14.8%), and Suriname (14.8%). At the undergraduate level, the largest non-contributing groups were India (17.3%), Nigeria (17.3%), and the United States of America (11.1%).

Among contributing territories outside of Trinidad and Tobago, postgraduate enrolment was mainly from Guyana (21.6%), Jamaica (21.0%), and Barbados (12.9%). At the undergraduate level, the largest contributing nationality groups were Barbados (27.4%), Jamaica (15.1%), and St. Vincent and the Grenadines (9.7%). The trend reflects continued regional uptake which however is not of significant growth.

In Table 4.1 below, Total Enrolment includes all undergraduate, postgraduate and other students. All other tables in this section will show analysis for the Undergraduate and Postgraduate student populations only.

Figure 4.1: Percentage Distribution of Postgraduate Enrolment by Age Group at Admission 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

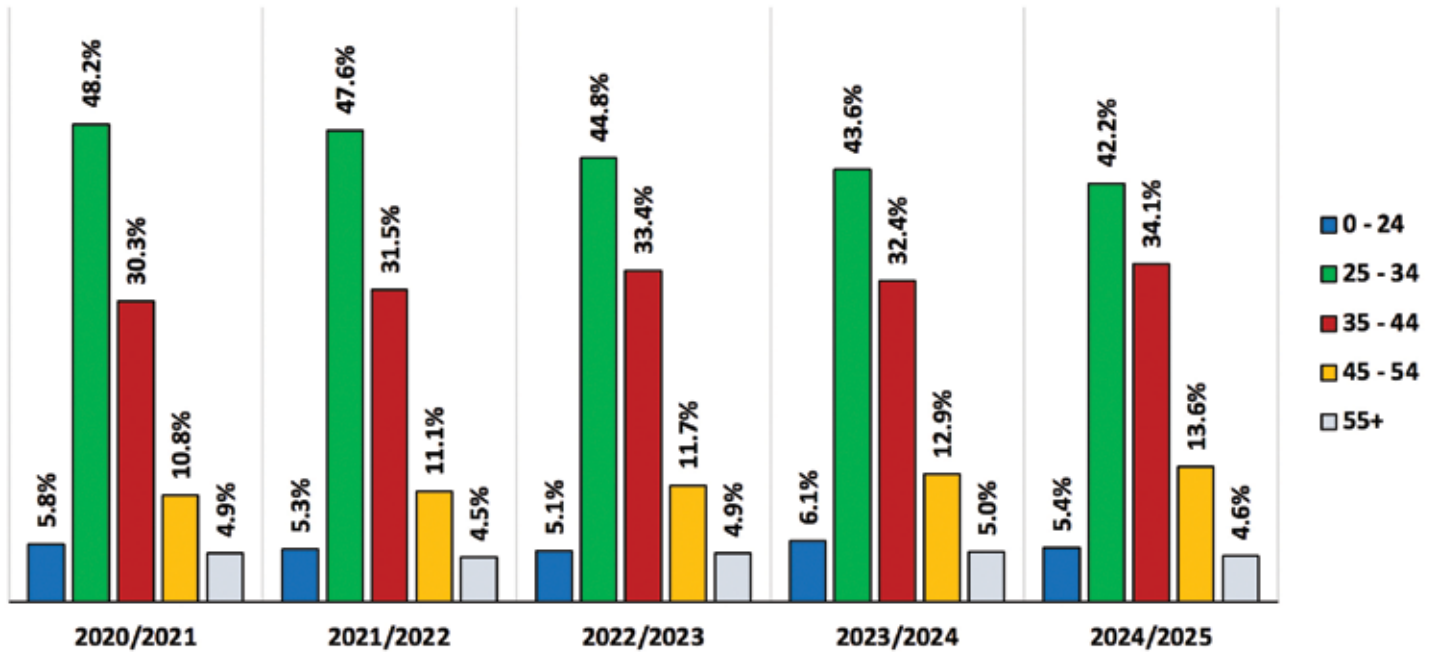
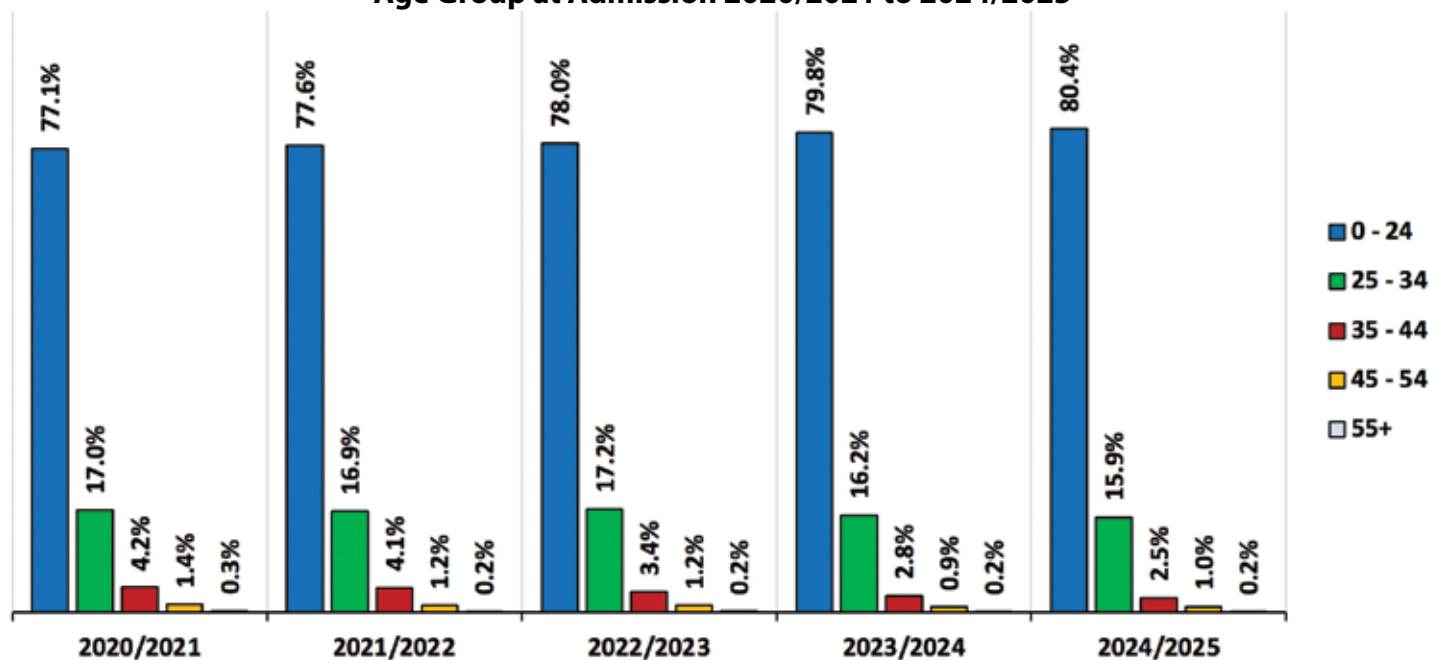


Figure 4.2: Percentage Distribution of Undergraduate Enrolment by Age Group at Admission 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

Figure 4.3: Postgraduate Enrolment by Nationality 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

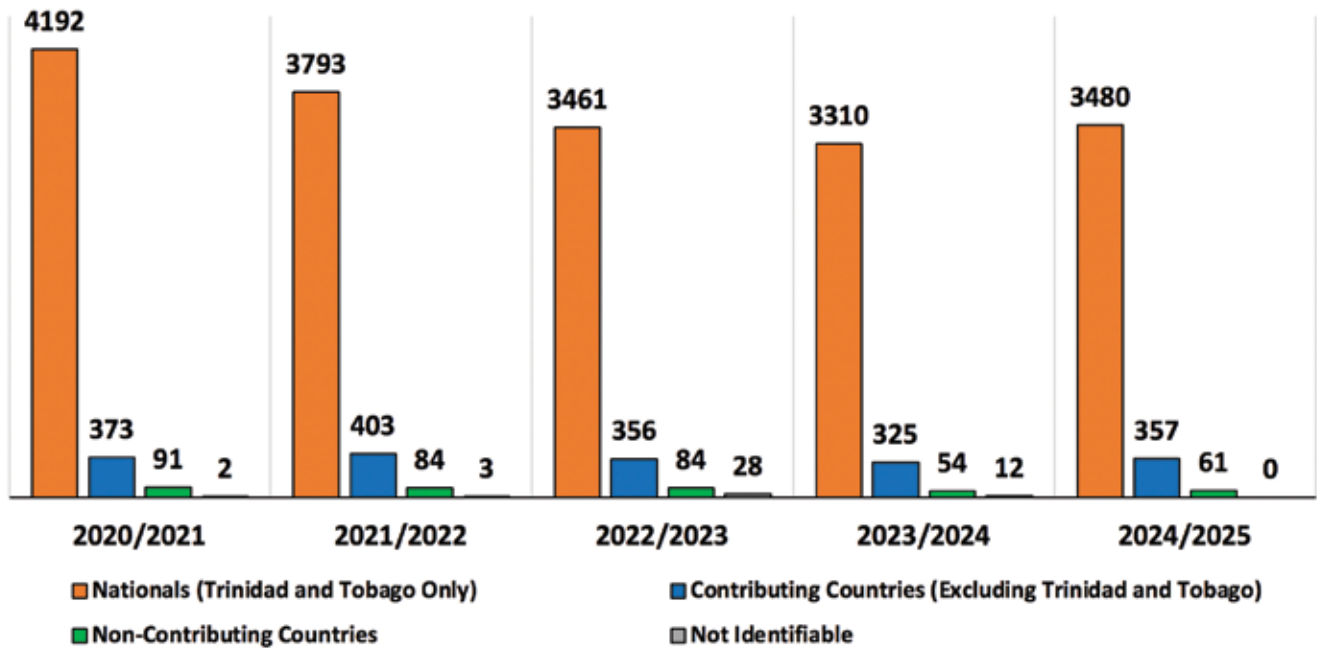
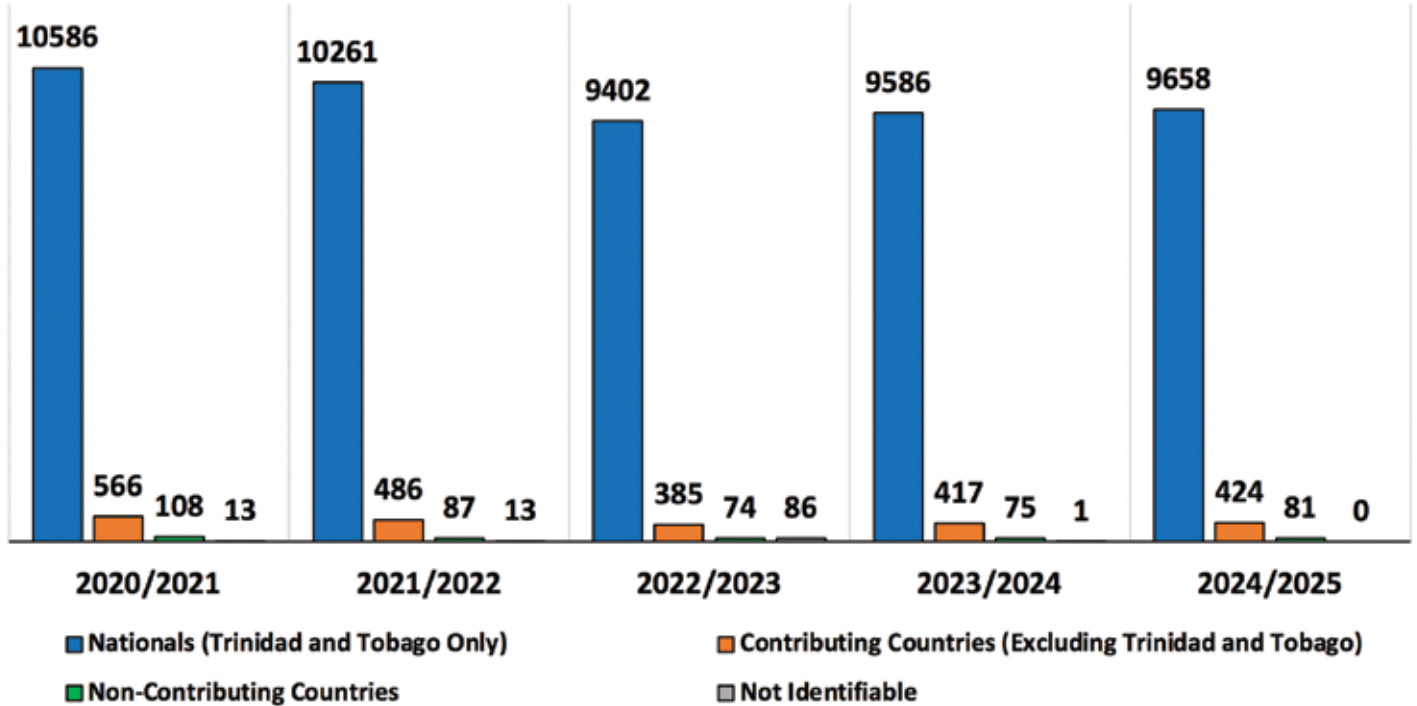


Figure 4.4: Undergraduate Enrolment by Nationality 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

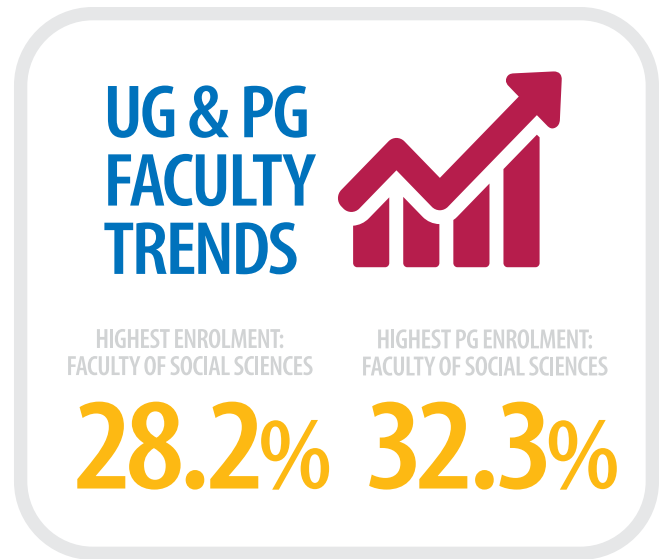

## Section 5: Undergraduate and Postgraduate Faculty Trends 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

The distribution in faculty enrolment trends indicated that Social Sciences remained the largest faculty, accounting for 28.2% of the UG & PG student population. The faculties which followed were Medical Sciences and Science & Technology at 20.7% and 19.0% respectively. However, an analysis of the trends in enrolment growth by faculty over the period 2020/2021 to 2024/2025, revealed that the faculties of Social Sciences and Humanities & Education have experienced the most significant decline in total enrolment of 22.1% and 12.2% respectively.

In 2024/2025, most postgraduate students were enrolled in the Faculty of Social Sciences (32.3%), followed by the Faculty of Humanities and Education (22.2%) and the Faculty of Engineering (14.3%). This shows continued interest in postgraduate programmes in social sciences, education, and other professional fields. However, despite having the largest share of enrolment, Social Sciences and Engineering experienced the biggest year-on-year declines in postgraduate numbers, falling by 30.1% and 29.6%, respectively. Looking at longer-term trends since 2020/2021, postgraduate enrolment has grown strongly in the Faculty of Food and Agriculture (71.7%), while Humanities and Education has also shown steady growth of 16.1% which was influenced by growth in programmes delivered by the School of Education.

At the undergraduate level, the new Faculty of Sport has continued to have an increase in enrolment numbers, reaching 2.3 times the 2020/2021 enrolment figure. In contrast, the faculties of Humanities &



Education and Food & Agriculture have experienced the most significant decline at the undergraduate level of 31.4% and 27.2% respectively. These trends point to shifting patterns in student demand across disciplines, with implications for further strategic enrolment planning and management.

Figure 5.1: Postgraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

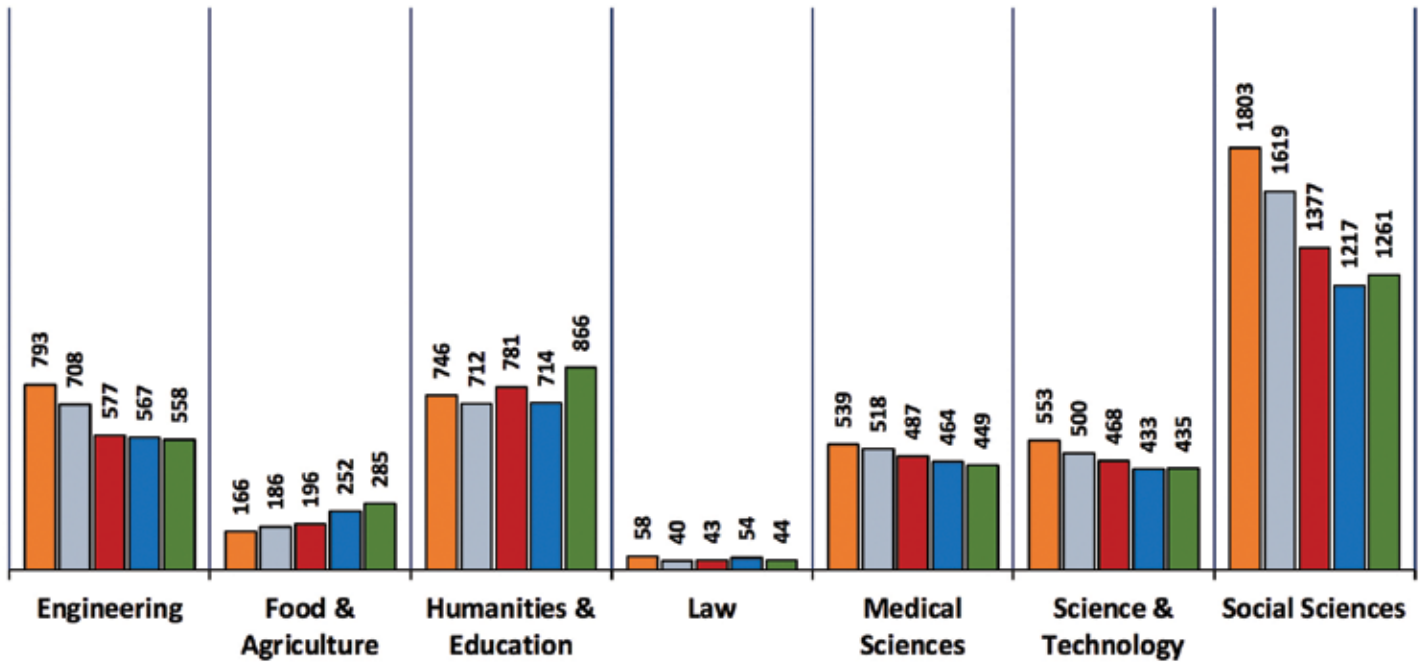
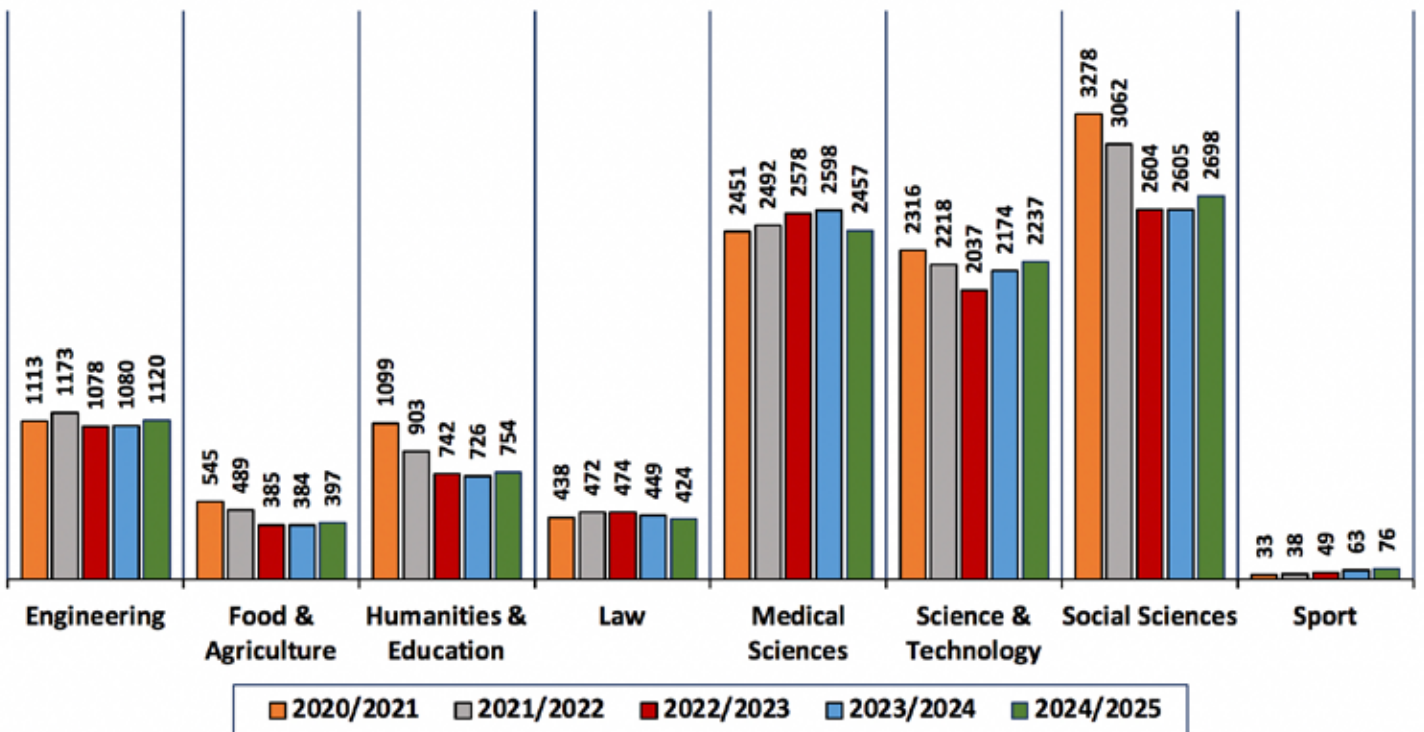


Figure 5.2: Undergraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

## Section 6: Undergraduate and Postgraduate Graduation Trends 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

This section presents data on graduate output in respect of demographics, faculty, degree honours and graduate throughput. A total of 3258 persons graduated in 2024/2025, of whom 65.3% were awarded undergraduate qualifications and 34.7% postgraduate qualifications. This reflects a majority of graduate output at the undergraduate level.

In respect of the type of degrees awarded, in 2024/2025 at least 59.3% represented first degrees and 18.4% were higher degree awards, which represented a decrease of approximately 13% and 4% respectively when compared to 2023/2024. However, the number of graduates receiving postgraduate diplomas doubled when compared to 2023/2024, suggesting that students may be opting for shorter term postgraduate training.

The highest number of degrees awarded at the undergraduate level were in the following programmes: MBBS Medicine & Surgery, Bachelor of Law, BSc. Management Studies, BSc. Computer Science and BSc. Nursing. At the postgraduate level, graduates were mostly awarded taught masters degrees in the following programmes: MBA Business Administration, MSc Renewable Energy Technology, MSc Strategic Leadership & Innovation, MED Education, MSc Management. These patterns reflect sustained student demand and completion in applied and professional fields which are responsive to the labour market needs.

Data has been calculated in respect of on-time graduation at the undergraduate level. It showed that over the period 2020/2021 to 2024/2025, on-time graduation has been at an average of 58% with some decline to 53% in 2024/2025.

Figure 6.1 Graduation Trends for UG and PG Students 2015/2016 to 2024/2025

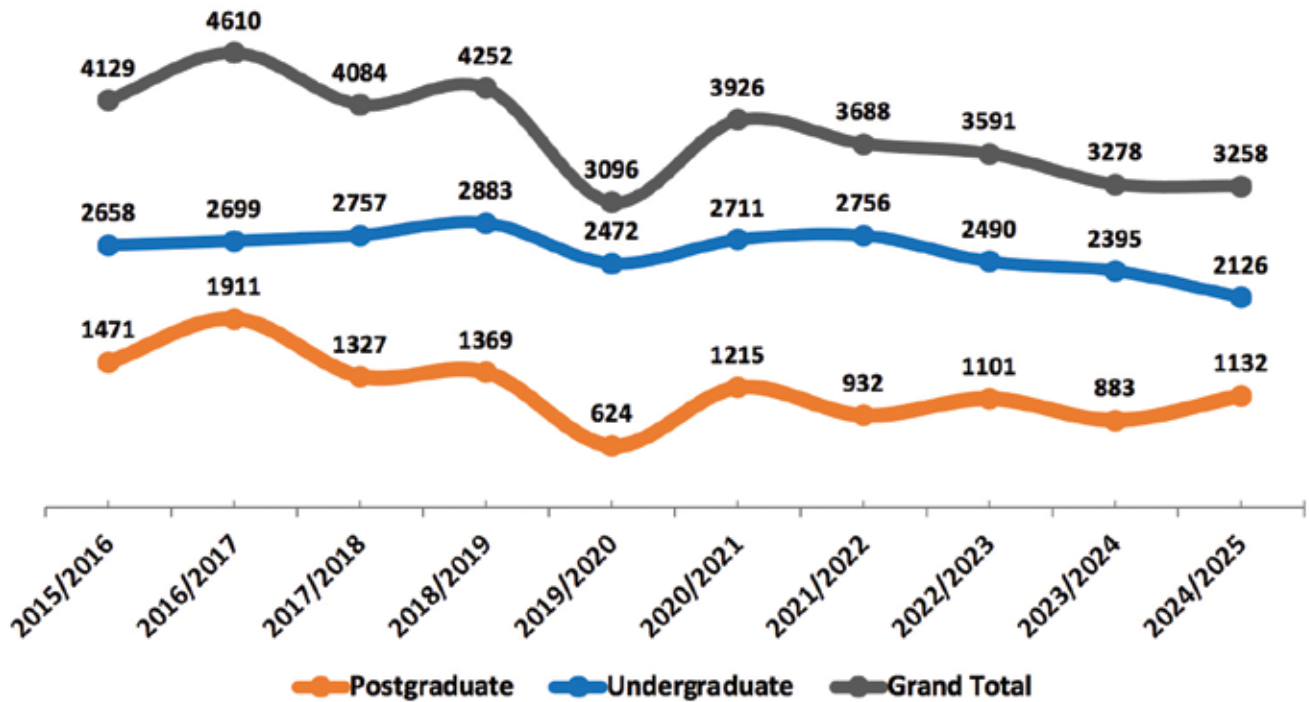
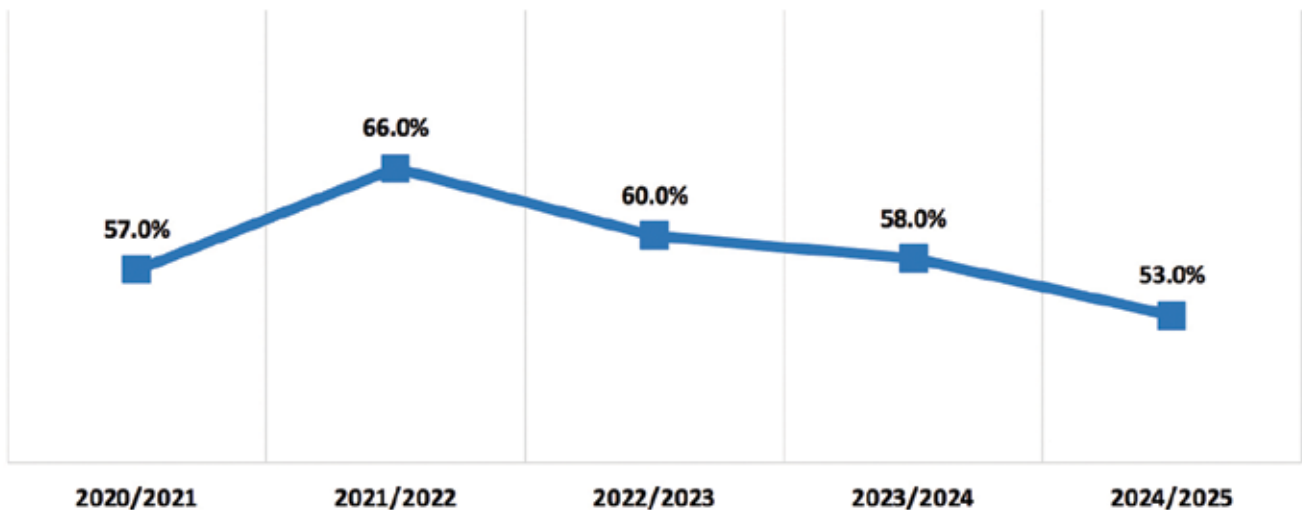


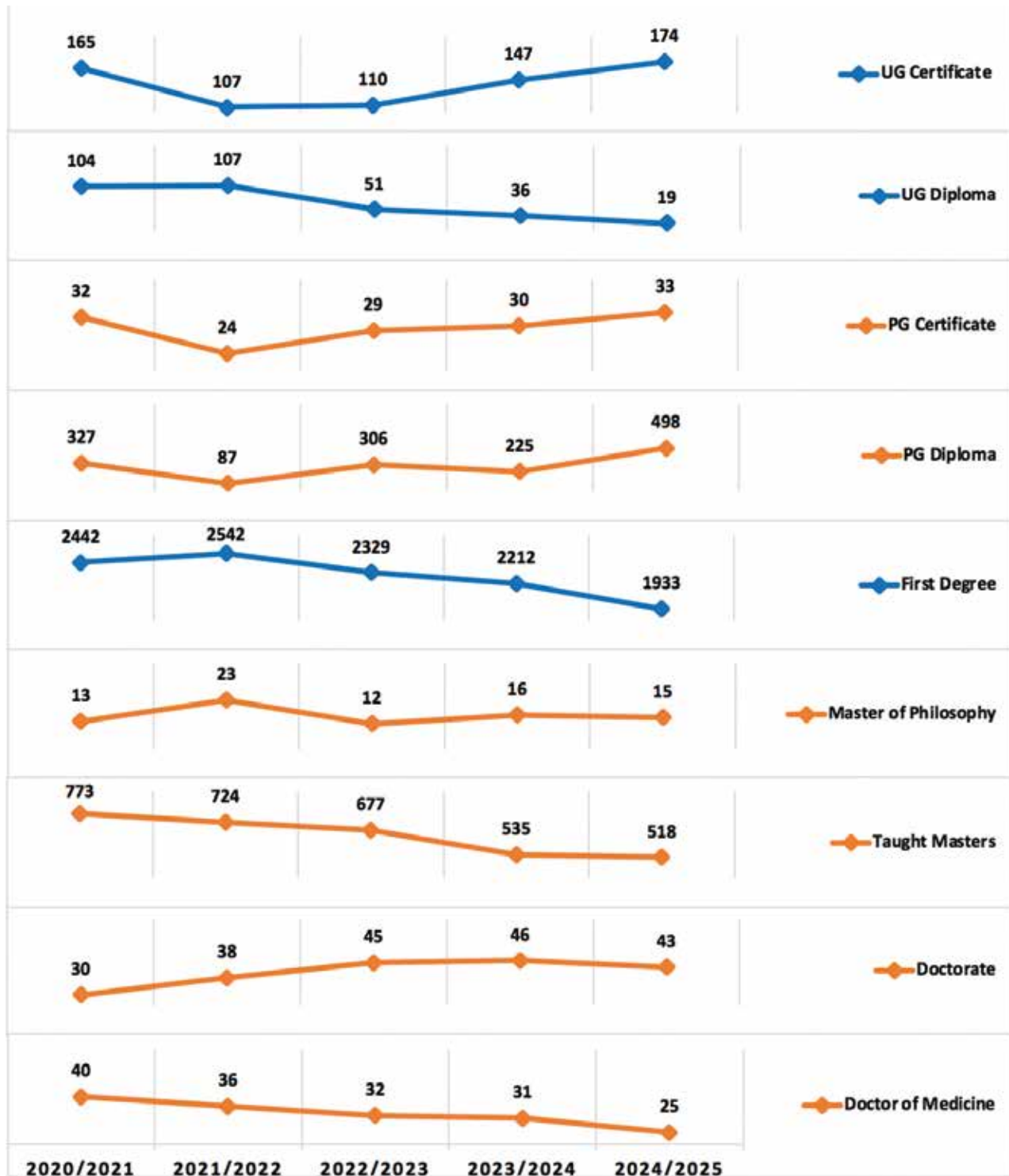
Figure 6.2: UG On-Time Graduation Rate 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

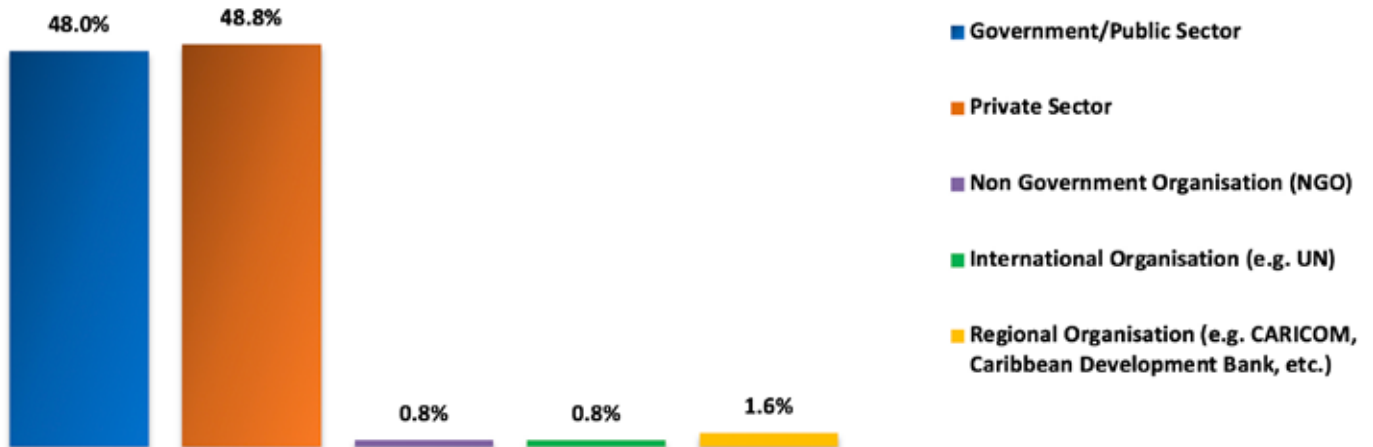
Figure 6.3 Graduate Output Trends by Degree Type 2020/2021 to 2024/2025

Figure 6.6: UG Graduate Tracer Respondents' Current Job Status 2023/2024

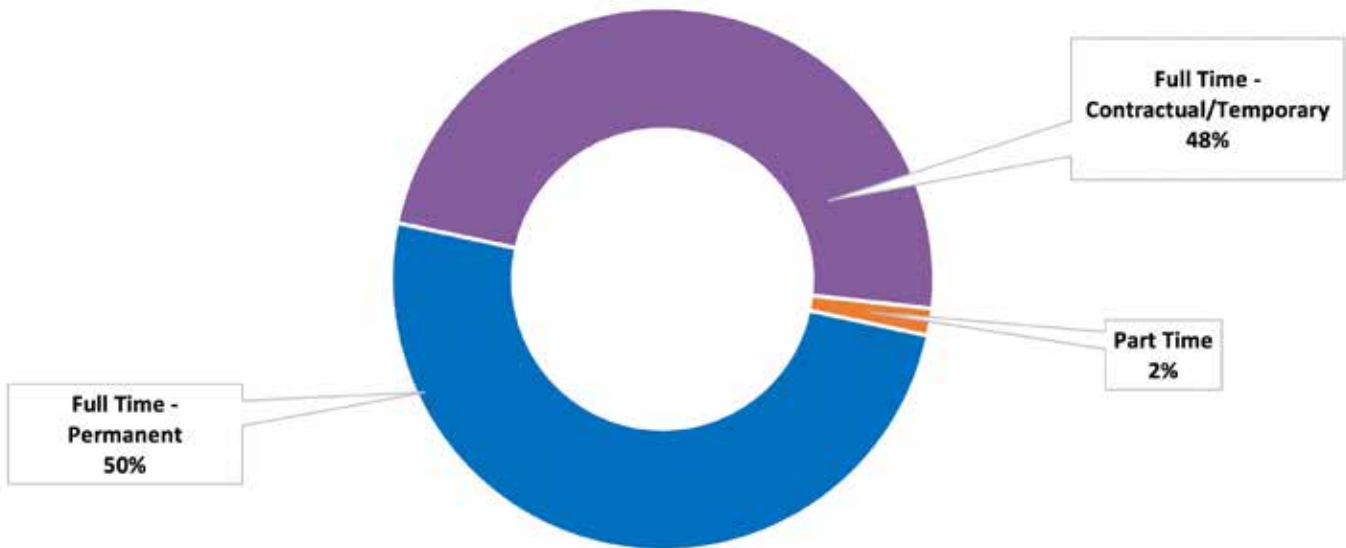
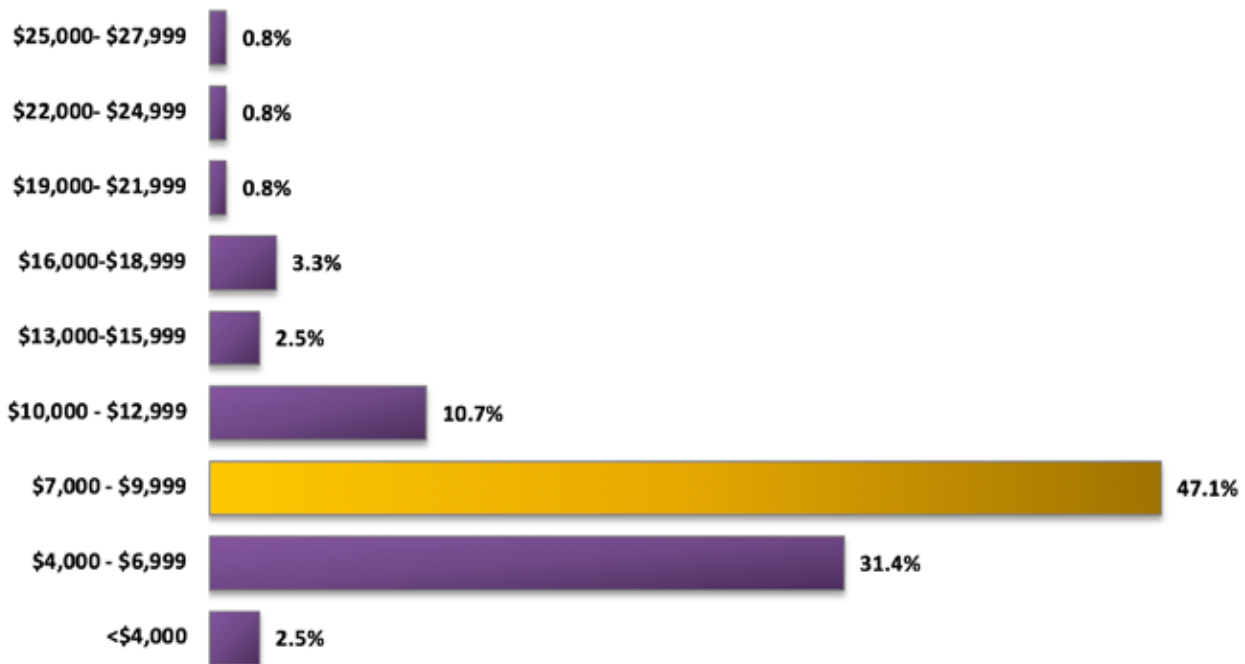


Figure 6.7: UG Graduate Tracer Respondents' Salary Range (TT\$) for 2023/2024
