The Non-Profit Organisations Act, 2019 ("NPO Act"), which came into operation on 14th June 2019, governs the registration and supervision of non-profit organisations ("NPO's") in Trinidad and Tobago. The Act is now fundamental to the operation of all NPOs in Trinidad & Tobago.

- What's NGOS need to know about the Non-profit Organisation Act 2019?
- How does the act influence organizing of NPOs?
- How do we make sense of the Act? This is of concern to every civil society organization in Trinidad and Tobago.

This seminar will explore and explain the legal requirements of the 2019 Non-Profit Organisation Act. It will facilitate an understanding of how registered NPOs comply with the law in a cost-effective manner, whilst ensuring they are not used as vehicles for money laundering or financing of terrorism.
