OVERVIEW

The newly refurbished Canada Hall is a traditional-styled Male only hall. It consists primarily of two 3-storey dormitory blocks (North Block and South Block). The hall boasts spacious grounds and is ideally located in close proximity to the Sir Frank Worrell playing field and the Student Activity Centre. The Hall attracts a diverse population of students from all over the Caribbean. Canada Hall is best suited for young men at the undergraduate level, who enjoy being part of a close community and are seeking to join a hall with lots of joint



FACILITIES

Canada Hall was the first hall of residence constructed for the St. Augustine Campus in 1963. There was a major renovation exercise undertaken between 2011 and 2016. The refurbishment involved the modernisation and extension of the dormitories. In addition to the room upgrades the Hall now boasts kitchen appliances (refrigerators, gas ranges and microwaves), a new lobby and common areas, new furniture and fittings as well as the introduction of solar water heating facilities..

Residents enjoy complimentary Wi-Fi service and other facilities such as a central laundry area, computer lab and one large Common Room equipped with cable TV, VCR, and sporting equipment.



ROOMS

Canada Hall has a total of 168 single rooms arranged in groups of 5 or 6. Each group of rooms has its own kitchen, dining and common room, as well as shared bathroom and toilet facilities. The rooms offer each resident privacy, comfort and wonderful views of the main campus and the hills overlooking the St. Augustine area through large windows. The Bedrooms are furnished with desks, beds, chairs, closets, book shelves and ceiling fans; while the bathrooms have brand new shower and washroom facilities.

HALL ACTIVITIES

C-Hall or "the Hermitage" (as it is commonly referred to on Campus) has a long history of brotherhood, academic and sporting excellence. There is a strong bond amongst Hall members or "Hermits". This close knit group of young men believe that "Unity is Strength" and live out this motto by supporting their brothers to ensure that everyone succeeds. Typical Hall activities include an annual concert, sporting activities and a valedictory dinner.
